An Important Decision in Favor of the United States Government.

Boston, Jan. 19.—Judge Carpenter in the United States circuit court today, gave his decision in the case of the United States vs. Alexander McCallum and others, holding the defendants constituting the firm of McCallum, Constable & Co., of Holyoke, Mass. liable for a violation of the contract labor law and judgment for the plaintiff is ordered in \$100 and costs.
