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CASE OF CHINESE LIQUOR DEALERS

ACCUSED CONVICTED--SENTENCE SUSPENDED

Magistrate Warmly Condemns Granting of Licenses - His Summing Up in Full.

When the case of the three Chinamen charged with selling liquor without having licenses was resumed in the police court on Wednesday, ex-Mayor McCandless was examined.

The evidence shows that there was a complete understanding between the Mayor and the Chinamen.

"It is a violation of law in my opinion of the grossest kind. The then Mayor of Victoria admits that it was a complete understanding between the Mayor and the Chinamen.

"In that respect it is the most serious liquor case that has ever occurred before me. It is not an attempt on the part of a private citizen to commit a violation of the law, but it is a contract by the Mayor which he cannot set aside and treated as no effect.

"It is impossible for me to express my condemnation of this transaction in terms that are too strong. In reference to the defendants themselves, Mr. Higgins has said that the prosecution has no vindictiveness. It would hardly seem just, as sworn to by the ex-Mayor, to have their names put in the papers, and for the Court to find them guilty.

"I have no power to declare the licenses cancelled. There is a tribunal that can do so. Whatever we do in this case is not to be taken as a precedent, and if another case is brought up, force the law and to punish them, in lieu of the heaviest penalty.

"Still another feature in these cases which may nearly be as serious, and that is that the revenue derived from this source sinks into insignificance when we consider the violation of law that has been permitted.

"The way in which these applications are signed is to say the least peculiar. They are not signed by the individual parties, but by others, and if this is not forgery, it comes pretty close to it, and from the evidence it seems that this transaction comes pretty close to a conspiracy.

"I think the ends of justice would be met, and upon the suggestion of counsel for the prosecution, I convict these defendants, but allow them to go on suspended sentence.
