MORNING AND EVENING STARS.

MERCURY will be morning star about January 16, May 15, September 9, and December 28; and evening star about March 29, July 27, and November 20.

VENUS will be evening star till September 23; then morning star for the rest of the year.

JUPITER will be evening star till February 8; then morning star till August 31; and evening star again the rest of the year.

ECLIPSES FOR 1879.

In the year 1879 there will be three Eclipses—two of the Sun and one of the Moon.

I. An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, January 22d. Invisible. Visible to portions of South America and Africa.

II. An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, July 19th. Invisible. Visible to Africa, and to small portions of Europe and Asia.

III. A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, December 28th. Invisible to the greater part of North America. To places on the Pacific Slope, the Moon will set in the morning slightly tinged with the advancing penumbral shade. Invisible also to South America. Visible more or less to the rest of the world. Magnitude of Eclipse = 0.164 (Moon's diameter = 1).

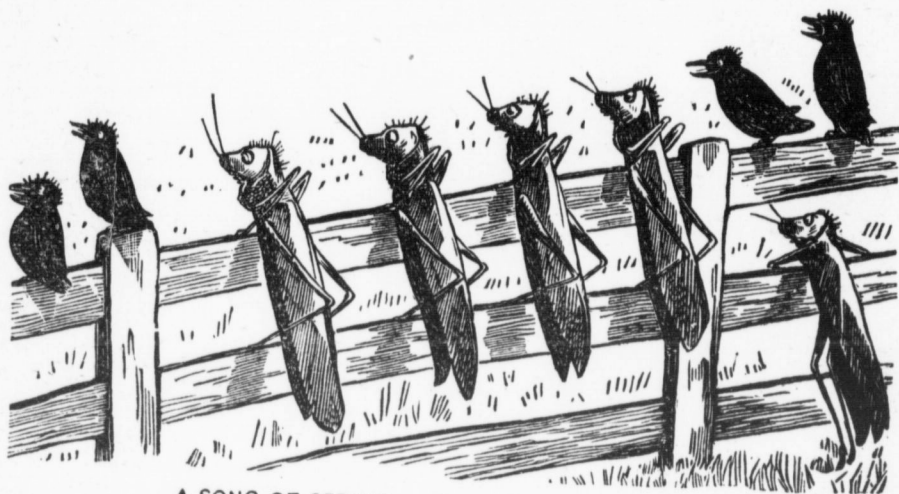

CORN DODGERS.

TAKE three teacups of Indian meal, one teaspoonful of salt, one tablespoonful of sugar, and pour on boiling water enough to wet it, nearly one quart; then make into small, flat cakes about an inch thick, and fry in boiling fat until brown. They will fry in fifteen or twenty minutes. To be eaten very hot.

BAKED CORN CAKE.

Three teacups of Indian meal, one teaspoonful of salt, one tablespoonful of sugar, one of butter; wet this with boiling water, and then beat in one egg. Spread half an inch deep on buttered tin sheets, and bake brown in quick oven. This is delicious.

OAT-MEAL.

Have about two quarts of boiling water in a large stewpan, and into it stir one cup of oatmeal, which you have already wet with cold water; boil this an hour, stirring often, and then add half a spoonful of salt, and boil an hour longer. If it should get too stiff, add more boiling water; or if too thin, boil a little longer. You cannot boil it too much.

The only trouble there is about cooking oatmeal is, that it takes a long time; and surely no one will let that stand in the way when it is so much better for having the extra time.

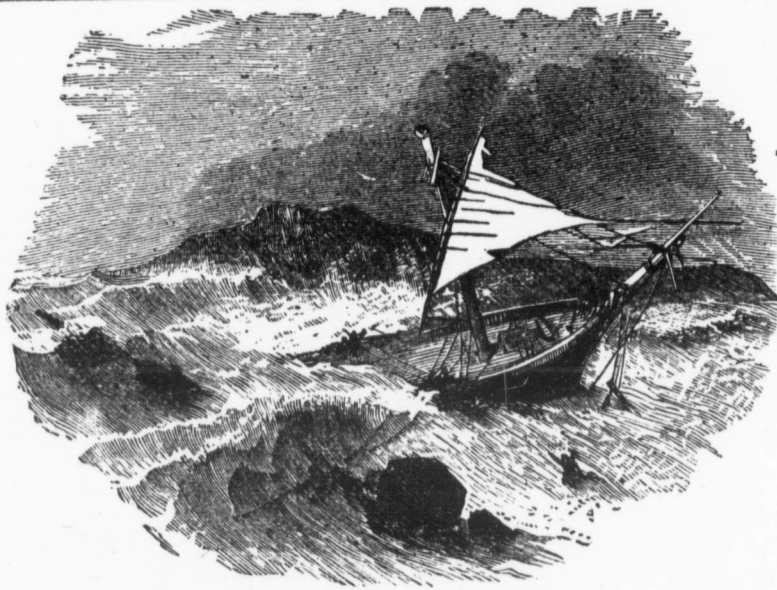

HARD TIMES.

A PHYSICIAN'S RULES OF HEALTH FOR THE HEATED TERM.

Rise early ; the morning air is pure and cool. Take a hand bath, going over the whole person with water at its natural temperature ; any one can do this who can command the use of a basin and one or two quarts of water. Use nothing but the hand ; once or twice a week put a few drops of ammonia in the water to cleanse the skin, or use white castile soap : avoid all others. Do this all the year round, no matter what the temperature of the weather is ; beginning now, the skin will become accustomed to it, and cold will not affect, but tone up the system, bringing the blood to the surface, and preventing colds from sudden changes ; besides, not half the clothing will be needed. At this season do not discard flannels altogether, but wear thin ones without sleeves ; the best are made from white bunting, which is not heating, and yet absorbs the perspiration, and will last well if properly shrunk before being made up. On rising, if feeling faint with loss of appetite, take a teaspoonful of charcoal stirred in a little water, and repeat the same at bedtime ; it must be the fine willow charcoal, and can be found (with twenty-five cents) at all apothecaries. This absorbs the gas from undigested food, and sweetens the stomach and prepares it for food, and should be taken at any time when there is an unpleasant fulness in the stomach before eating. Avoid ice water, except one or two swallows ; its habitual use lowers the temperature of the stomach, and prevents digestion. Soda water in immoderate quantities should also be avoided, certainly not more than a single glass per day. Let the diet be a generous one, but avoid mixtures ; never more than two or three dishes at each meal. Pastry of all kinds should be especially avoided in hot weather.

SUMMER PRUNING.—It is very useful to give a little attention, at the proper season, to the summer pruning of fruit trees and bushes. The too rampant growth should be pinched back and the too crowded branches thinned, which will give increased strength to what is allowed to remain. Raspberry bushes have been sending up their sprouts which are to bear the fruit of next year; only as many should be allowed to grow as are wanted for the next year's crop, and these should be pinched back at the ends to ensure ripening of the wood. Pear trees can also be pruned in summer, and apple trees, and will suffer much less than if the limbs are allowed to grow large and then sawed off, leaving a large wound to be healed. Stone fruit will not bear the saw so well as the apple and pear, and will be especially benefited by judicious pinching of the green wood.

TREATMENT OF SCARLATINA.

HAVASSE has had great experience of practice among children. The result of his treatment of scarlet fever has been so uniformly successful that he has not lost a single case for upwards of seven years. He says :

The system I adopt, in a case of scarlet fever, is to keep the bedroom cool—I may say cold—and to have a thorough ventilation through it ; I, therefore, throw open the windows, be it winter or summer, and have the curtains and valances of the bed removed. If it be winter time, I allow the patient to have one blanket and a sheet ; if it be summer, a sheet only to cover him. If the throat be not seriously affected, I merely order a narrow strip of flannel once around the throat. If the tonsils be much enlarged, I apply a barm and oatmeal poultice to the throat changing it night and morning. I prescribe an acidulated infusion, say lemonade or similar drink, quite sour, to be taken as often as the patient chooses. This is the only medicine I give. Where the child is old enough, I find roasted apples, mixed with raw sugar, very grateful to the patient.

Now with regard to food. If the infant be at the breast keep him entirely to it. If he be weaned, and under two years old, give him milk and water, and cold water to drink. If he be older, give him toast and water, and plain water from the pump, as much as he chooses ; let it be quite cold—the colder the better. Weak black tea, or thin gruel, may be given, but caring little if he take nothing but cold water, unless he be an infant at the breast. Avoid broths and stimulants of every kind.

Now, you must warily watch for a change of temperature of the skin. As long as the skin is hot, the above plan I steadily follow ; but the moment the skin of the patient becomes cool, which it will do probably in five or seven days, instantly close the window, and immediately put more clothes on the bed. But still do not purge.

When the appetite returns, you may consider the patient to be safe. The diet must now be gradually improved.

Another very important regulation is never to allow the patient to leave the house under a month in the summer, and under six weeks in the winter.—[BRAITHWAITE'S EPITOME.

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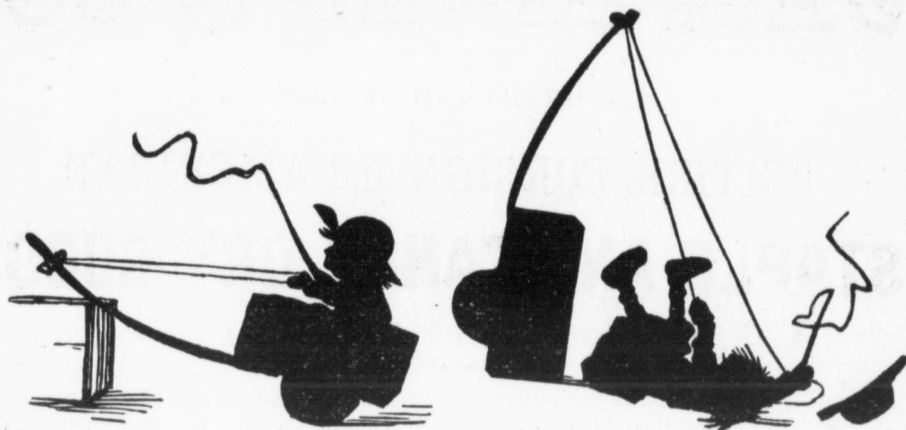

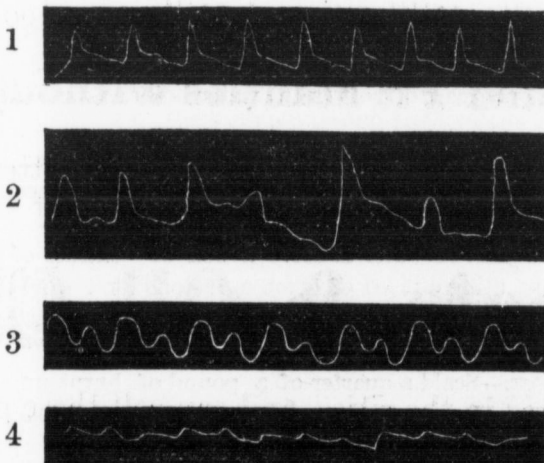


THE UPS AND DOWNS OF LIFE.

DID you ever hear of a Sphygmograph? Well, in its present improved state, it is something new and very wonderful. It takes its name from two Greek words, "sphugmos," the pulse, and "grapho," I describe. It is an implement to be used by physicians, and forces the patient's pulse to tell its own story, or, in other words, make a full confession of all its ups and downs and irregularities. Not only make a confession, but actually write it down in plain black and white!

So you see that a man's pulse in Maine may write a letter to a physician in Mexico, telling him just what it is about, and precisely in what manner its owner's heart beats—how fast or slow, and, in fact ever so much more.

Here are some specimens of pulse-writing:



No. 1, according to the doctors, writes that he is the pulse of a strong, healthy boy, and that his owner is getting on admirably. No. 2 writes that his proprietor has trouble with his heart. No. 3 tells a sad story of typhoid fever; and No. 4 says that his owner is dying.—[ST. NICHOLAS MAGAZINE.]

NO WOOD WITHOUT BARK.



MOSAIC DESIGNS IN COLORED WOODS.

BEAUTIFUL table-tops, panels for cabinet and book-case doors, etc., may be made by marking off any mosaic or geometrical pattern decided upon, and staining the blocks with various wood dyes. The best wood for this purpose is well-seasoned pine. Charming little tables may be made for one dollar, which when finished will look as if they might have cost a hundred, premising that the legs and rails of these little articles are to be stained in imitation of ebony, oak, walnut, or rosewood, or ornamented with lines of color.

We will give directions for making the various stains to be used for this purpose. Each one must be put on with a separate brush of small size, in order to touch all the fine lines, and not encroach beyond the edge.

TO STAIN WOOD A GOLDEN YELLOW.—Put a quarter of an ounce of powdered turmeric with five ounces of rectified spirits of wine (alcohol) in a stoppered bottle; allow it to stand for about a week in a warm place, during which time it must be occasionally shaken; then filter the clear solution. When this fluid is painted over the surface of new pine wood it produces a deep yellow stain. If the color is deeper than desired, it may be made lighter by the addition of more spirits of wine to the tincture.

PURPLE.—In one quart of soft (rain) water boil one ounce of logwood chips and two drams of Brazil-wood till the fluid is reduced to a pint, then strain. In another bottle dissolve a dram of pearl-ash in one pint of water. Use the colored wash first, and when dry, apply the clear wash, doing this repeatedly, until the desired shade is secured.

BLACK.—In a quart of water dissolve a box of "extract of logwood," wash the wood with this, using a piece of sponge fastened on a handle. When dry paint with vinegar in which a quantity of very rusty iron has been steeping for two days.

BLACK WALNUT.—Scald a quarter of a pound of burnt umber in one pint of vinegar or beer, and strain. Apply with a sponge or soft brush, and when dry, rub hard, and repeat the staining until sufficiently dark.

In using the above receipts it should be remembered that the wood must be dried after each successive application of the stain, and they should be applied hot. Dye woods must be rasped into fine shreds.

After staining, rub the wood off with a soft pad; then give several coats of varnish.—[HARPER'S BAZAR.]
