

New Brunswick's lonster fisheries were valued at \$74,3,859. Prince Edward Island at \$331,519. and Quebee's at \$56,832 during the same year. The lobster is also the most valuable of all the provincial fisheries, totalling one third of the entire fish cries value thereof, while in the Dominion its position is surpassed only by almon. 
