Orange Cream Sponge Cake—Mix five sifting three teaspoons of baking powder with one and a half cups of flour. In separate bowl beat three eggs until light, add one and a half cups of white sugar, one half cup of butter, and grated rind of half a lemon. For the cream use half a pint of milk, one egg, one teaspoon of vanilla, and beat over ingredients together. Add to milk and egg mixture, and mix thoroughly.

Spanish Sandwiches—Cut white bread in strips three and a half inches long and an inch wide. Butter slightly and toast after the usual way for your attention. But I know what I think.

Chocolate Bavarian Cream—A refreshing dessert for a hot day is Bavarian cream with chocolate. Beat four eggs, add one cup of simple Borden's together a pint of cream, or rich milk, and two tablespoons of chocolate. Fill the center with vanilla, and add the yolks of four eggs well beaten, and two sticks of butter, which has been whipped to a stiff froth.

Sewers Flushed With It and Streets Sprinkled.
Several years ago the city council of London, England, tried the experiment of employing sea water for flushing the streets and dusting the pavements. The experiment was followed by the local authorities of a number of other towns on the coast. The water, it is said, is very soft, and is used for all purposes where a high degree of purity is not required.

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NEW SMOKELESS POWDER

IT IS CALLED "VELOXITE" AND IS VERY EFFICIENT.
Inventions of Col. Vm. Hope, a Veteran of the Crimean War.
One of the few surviving Crimean veterans, Colonel William Hope, has invented a new smokeless powder, which he calls "veloxite," and which he claims to be both simpler in manufacture and more efficient than any yet introduced.

It was in 1884 when he took out a patent for improvements in gunpowder, that Colonel Hope began the series of experiments which have now resulted in the production of "veloxite." For the last ten years he has practically lived in the laboratory which he has built on the top floor of his house in Fulham. He has made about 10,000 carefully recorded and calculated experiments, in which he has tested powders made of almost every substance containing carbon and hydrogen, and has used nearly every possible oxidizing agent in combination with them.

From the first," he says, "I was determined to eschew all dangerous and unstable substances, such as sulphur, phosphorus, the chlorates, and the nitro-compounds of potassium and cordite and smokeless powders are composed. Thus I have at last succeeded in producing 'veloxite,' as I call it, which is made of two simple and stable substances, which flash at a low temperature, and whose burning point is about 1,200 degrees Fahrenheit—double that of ordinary powder, and more than three times that of cordite and all nitro-powders.

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DIRECTS RUSSIA'S ARMY

GEN. KOUROPATKIN IS A GALLANT SOLDIER.
Has Made a Glorious Record in Every Russian War Since 1860.

General Alexei Nikolaevich Kourapatkin, who has just been appointed to the supreme military command of the Russian forces in the Far East, has since 1860 been Minister of War in the Russian Empire. He was educated in the theory of arms at the best of the Russian military schools, trained to practice under the aegis of modern Russian warriors, General Mikhail Skobelev, made a glorious record in every important Russian war since his appointment in that year to the command of the army in 1867. His executive abilities have been put to the severest and most successful tests in the governorship of the Trans-Caspian district, and in the obnoxious office which is occupied at present, and he has worn more decorations than any one breast could hold.

Like most Russian officers, he comes from the ancient nobility. For centuries his family has played a prominent part in the local government of Fokov, where their ancestral estates are situated.

He was born on March 17, 1848, after completing the course of the Cadet Corps School in St. Petersburg, he obtained a commission as sub-lieutenant in the Russian Rifles. He was then only eighteen.

The various tribes and nations which occupied the vast territory, were known simply as Turkestan, and were in a condition of lawlessness and were united only in a common hatred for the Christians.

In 1876, an expedition under General Cherniaev had been sent into that portion of what is now West Turkestan, which had been overrun by the borders of Asiatic Russia. Tashkend had fallen in June, 1865. Just before Kourapatkin's arrival on the scene the important victory of Irtysh had been won by 8,000 Russian, over 100,000 of the Bohemian and the Emir. Kourapatkin participated in all the subsequent hostilities which culminated in the capture of Samarkand, the Emir's capital. A treaty was concluded, which left Bokhara a tributary to the Russian Empire, and Kourapatkin returned to St. Petersburg with the rank of lieutenant, to continue his military studies, the Academy of the General Staff, and to study military conditions in the various European countries. In France President MacMahon invited him to take part in the manoeuvres of 1877, as the most brilliant of the materials for his first brilliant career.

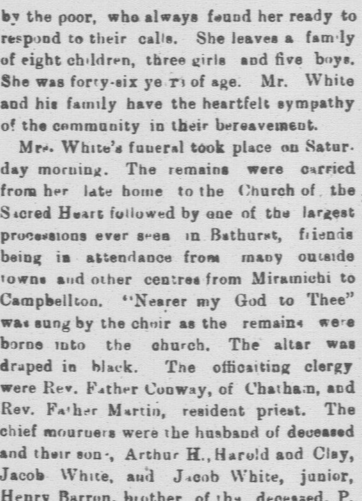
