An Act to amend the Act for the incorporation of the North West Navigation and Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Directors of the North West Navigation and Railway Company have, by their Petition, prayed that the period allowed them for commencing operations, surveying and locating the line of works may be extended; and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition: Therefore Her Majesty by and with the consent of the Senate and House of Commons of the Dominion of Canada, enacts as follows:—

I. The period limited by the twenty-first section of the Act 25 v., c. 67, for the incorporation of the said Company, passed in the twenty-fifth year of Her Majesty's reign, and chaptered sixty-seven, for the commencement of the Company's operations, shall be extended to the eighth day of June, eighteen hundred and seventy; and the time therein and thereby limited for the completion of the Company's works and improvements, shall be extended to the eighth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four.
