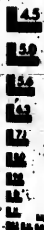

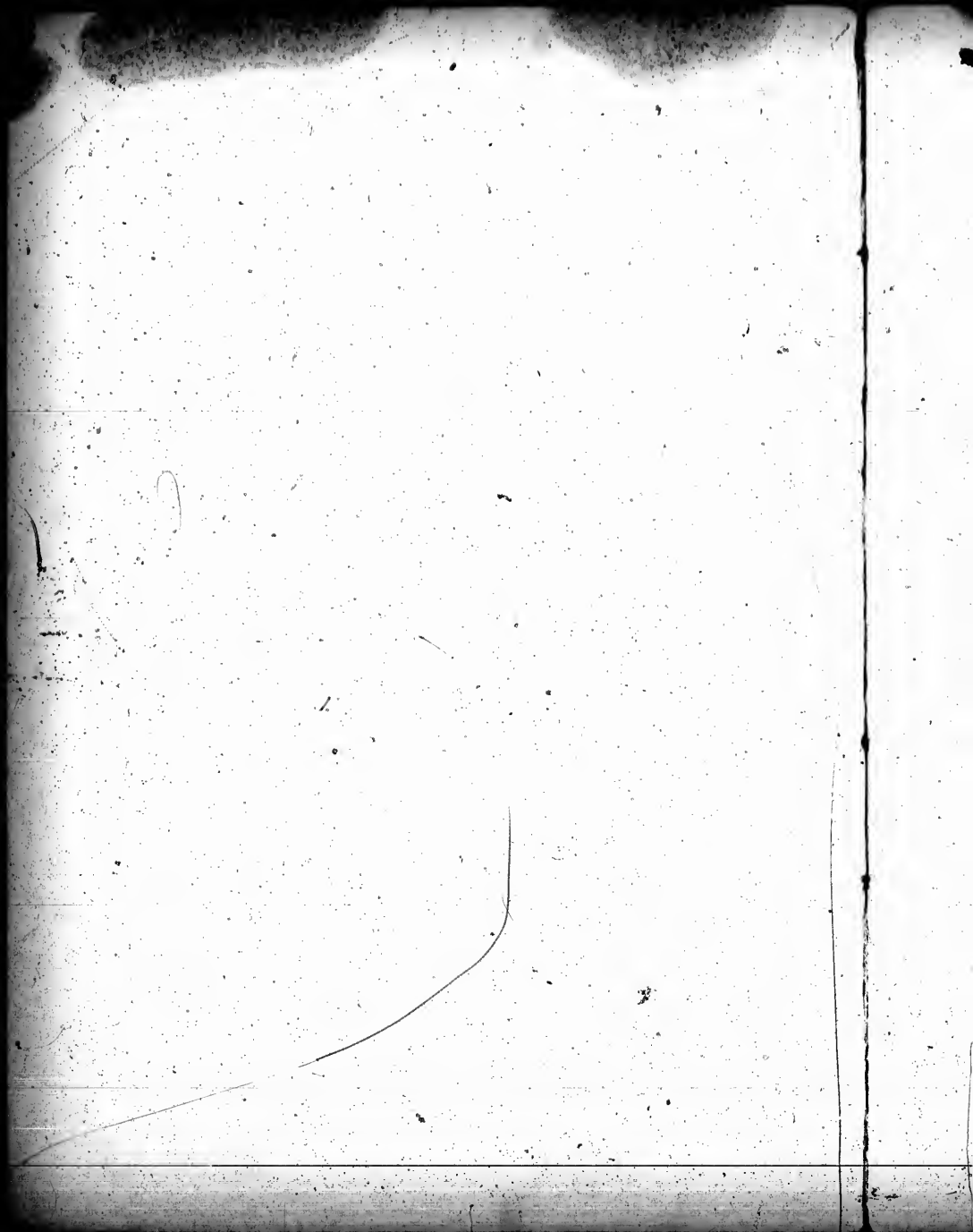

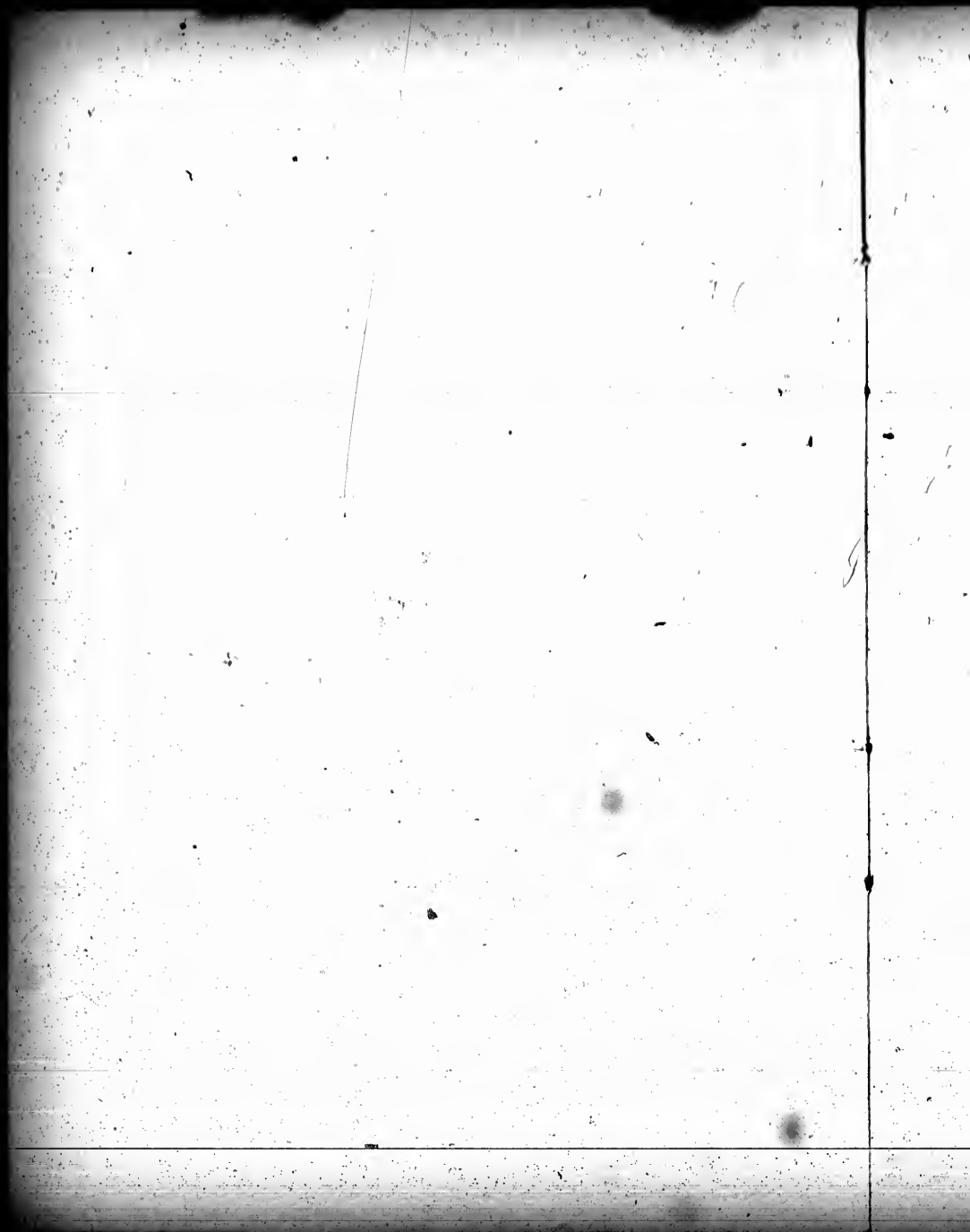

CONSTITUTION AND RULES.

NAME.

1. The Association, shall be known as "The Veterans of 1866 Association."

OBJECTS.

2. To honor and perpetuate the memory of those Canadian volunteers who served or fell while in action on service in the year 1866, or at other times.

To promote good fellowship amongst those old "comrades in arms" who so served.

MEMBERS.

3. All officers, non-commissioned officers and men who were enrolled as volunteers and on "active service" during the year 1866, or at other times, shall be qualified for membership in this Association on being proposed and approved of by the Association.

FEEs.

4. All veterans desiring to become members of the Association shall sign the declaration of service as above and pay the annual fee of fifty cents; said fee to be due at the annual meeting in May.

CONSTITUTION AND RULES

OFFICERS.

5. The officers of the Association shall consist of an Honorary President, Honorary Vice-President, President, Vice-President, Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeant-Major and two Sergeants, Treasurer and Secretary.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

6. There shall be an Executive Committee composed of the Officers of the Association and five other members. Five members shall form a quorum.

ELECTIONS.

7. All the officers and members of the Executive Committee, excepting the Honorary President and Honorary Vice-Presidents, shall be elected annually by ballot at the annual meeting.

MEETINGS.

8. The Association shall hold an annual meeting on the first Monday in May. Special meetings of the Association may be called by the President, or any five members of the Executive Committee. Twelve members shall form a quorum.

PARADES.

9. Parades of the Association shall take place for the funerals of members of the Association, and on all occasions of a national or patriotic character, when the Executive Committee shall deem it desirable. The

parades shall be officered by the Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeant-Major and Sergeants. In the absence of any of these, "officers of the day" shall be selected from those present.

DISCIPLINE.

10. The Captain or officer in command shall have the power to suspend any member of the Association who shall behave unbecomingly at any meeting or parade and report same at the next meeting of the Association for action thereon.

THE 3RD OF JUNE.

11. There shall be an annual celebration of some kind on the third day of June, being the anniversary of the day on which the Canadian Volunteers in this section of the country were called to active service in 1866. The character and day of the celebration shall be determined by the Association at its annual meeting.

CHANGES IN CONSTITUTION.

12. No changes shall be made in this constitution or rules except at the annual meeting on a vote of two-thirds of the members present.
