Shortly after 5 p.m. and after that the result of the Esquimalt poll had been handed to the Sheriff, that officer mounted the platform and declared the result to the anxious crowd as follows:

Dr. Powell was next to address the large audience; he thanked the four hundred and fifty who voted for him. The Confederation issue was voted against and he bowed to the wishes of the majority...
