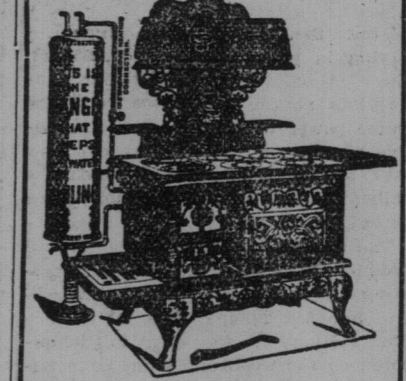

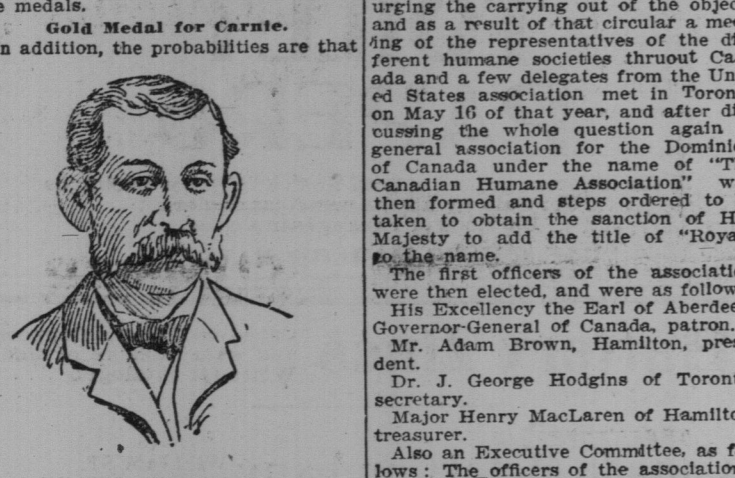

The medals to be awarded by the society to the heroes of Paris will be more numerous than issued in commemoration of any other single life-saving affair in the history of the association.

George Blanchard. The gold medal of the association will be awarded to the leading factor in the rescue of the well-digger. This means John Carmie. This medal is known as the "Sanford" medal, being the annual gift of the society from the late Hon. Senator Sanford of Hamilton. This medal is an exceedingly handsome affair, and is bestowed upon "the bravest of the brave," selected from the list of those receiving bronze medals from the society for each year. Thus far Carmie's case is the one involving the most conspicuous bravery in the knowledge of the Board of Investigating Governors.

The medal described. The bronze medal to be awarded to the Paris heroes is a very handsome thing. It is delicate in design, nearly as large as a silver dollar. The name of the recipient is engraved on one side, together with the date and details of the affair for which the same is awarded. On the reverse side the medal shows the royal crown, beneath which are the words "Royal Canadian Humane Association," surrounded by an embossed wreath of maple and laurel leaves. The medal is attached to a beautifully chosen pendant and hung from blue silk ribbon. This forms a striking emblem, which has become typical of the highest degree of courage the world over.
