## THE ANNUAL MEETING

of the Society was held on Sunday and Monday, June 11th and 12th, in the Bible Christian Church, Port Hope. On Sunday at 10:30 a.m., a sermon was preached by Rev. W. Kenner. At 2:30 p. m., a Sabbath-school service was held and addresses were delivered by Revs. W. Ayers and S. J. Allin. At 6:30 a sermon was preached by Rev. G. Webber. On Monday at 2:30, the public meeting commenced, Mr. J. P. Clarke occupied the chair. The Missionary Secretary, R. T. Courtice, presented the Report, and the following resolution was moved by Rev. W. C. Beer, seconded by Rev. J. Greenway, and carried unanimously:

That the Report, extracts of which have been read, be adopted, printed and circulated under the direction of the Missionary Committee. We gratefully recognize the increasing interest taken in this department of Christian toil, and we trust the cheering reports from our several mission fields in Prince Edward Island, Ontario, United States and Manitoba, will encourage both collectors and contributors even more vigorously to engage in this work of faith and labor of love.

The meeting then adjourned for tea. The evening meeting was called to order in the usual manner, at 7:30 p. m. Mr. John Hull occupied the chair. Rev. J. J. Rice moved, Rev. J. Kenner seconded, and Rev. F. W. Bourne supported the following resolution, which was carried unanimously:

Whereas the blessings of Christ's redemption are in their application universal as the requirements of humanity, and the tidings of His Salvation are to be spread by the pious benevolence of the church, as taught in the Word of God; and whereas by blood-cleansing and Holy-Ghost-baptisms, the church is prepared for and empowered to secure the great successes this Gospel is worthy to achieve; and whereas, the Bible Christian church, wherever engaged in Mission work, has prospered according as the faith, hope and trial of a Christ-like Missionary-spirit has characterized her life; resolved that we do hereby renew our consecration vows to pray, work and give, in delightful confidence of present usefulness and the final triumph of our Saviour's Kingdom.

## INTRODUCTORY REMARKS.

"I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God unto Salvation to everyone that believeth."  
 "I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord."

These bold words spoken by the Apostle Paul, and endorsed by all possessed of like precious faith, attest the blessed change wrought by the Holy Spirit when the love of Christ overcomes the selfishness of the human heart. The beautiful graces of humility and gratitude have developed into Christ-like strength, and as a reasonable service, bodies are presented unto God as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable. Blessings of Providence and redemption are recognized as the gifts of God, and the most grateful means are sought and employed to acknowledge the Giver of all good in his own appointed way, *i. e.*, by doing good to others. "Freely ye have received, freely give. As ye do it unto the least of these, ye do it unto me. Thus the written word and the Spirit's voice accord in teaching man the nature and extent of his responsibility to God, as the foundation of his duty both to God and man.

In this light, labors of love are viewed as delightful worship, and in this field of intellectual and emotional religion, personal interests grow into relationships whose spirit of brotherhood ever cheers and strengthens with the following years. Baker, whose growth in ministerial power was gradual but sure, in the midst of usefulness received their welcome to the Master's presence.

Pastors' reports present encouraging features. A spirit of hopefulness generally prevails. Receipts, both as quarterage on Mission Stations, and Missionary money throughout our work, are considerably increased. Revivals have increased the members and refreshed the spirits of our membership. Sabbath schools give promise of increasing usefulness.

Manitoba has not presented the returns so earnestly desired. Nevertheless, with zeal renewed, we resolve to increase our staff of laborers there, and toil on

## MISSIONS.

---

Our Mission fields are reported as follows :

**WHEATLEY RIVER**—J. A. Dafeo, Pastor.—The year has been one of hard toil and not a little anxiety, yet under the blessing of God a measure of success has attended our efforts for His glory. Congregations have continued good, and many appear to be attentive listeners to the word preached. Thirteen persons have united with our societies. Our Sabbath Schools continue in a healthy condition; what we need most is a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit.

**STURGEON AND MONTAGUE**—W. Down, Pastor.—Manuscript mislaid. R. T. Courtice.

**SUMMERSIDE**—J. H. Collins, Pastor.—We rejoice over homes renovated, hearts renewed and lives regulated by the pure principles of our holy Christianity. We have been gratified with increased congregations, marked attention to the Word preached, a deepening piety, and more thorough consecration to God. A new society has been formed and regularly officered, and the members are manifesting commendable zeal. Our finances are healthy and our hearts are hopeful. The Sabbath School is prosperous, and the social means of grace are appreciated and enjoyed. May the God of all grace continue to be gracious to this mission.

**PORT HOPE**—W. H. Butt, Pastor.—In closing up another year's work and reviewing a four years' pastorate, we desire to record our thanks to God for the measureable success which has attended our efforts. That God has smiled upon us and blessed the united efforts of His people, appears quite evident from the fact that Port Hope society was never in a better position either financially, numerically or spiritually, than it is now. Every department of church work is in a satisfactory condition and well manned with efficient and devoted workers, whom we trust God will honor with still greater success. The outlook for the future is bright and encouraging.

**CAMPBELLFORD**—J. Kestle, S. W. Muxworthy, Pastors.—Although our experiences during the past year have been of the ordinary type, we have no reason to conclude that therefore it has been one of failure only. The accession of Wilson's appointment has been mutually helpful and satisfactory. The S. S. in the village and at Zion are fairly prosperous, but the other two suffer sadly the lack of efficient and consecrated workers. The number in church fellowship stands about the same as last year. Our spiritual prosperity has not been commensurate with our privileges, still we are grateful for a measure of success realized, and for the hope we cherish of greater prosperity in the future.

**BELLEVILLE**—D. Williams, Pastor.—We cannot say as much of an encouraging character as could be desired or as should be looked for. Spiritually we have been blessed. Many refreshing seasons we have enjoyed while peace has prevailed throughout the year, yet there is need of a deeper work of grace among us. Public and social means of grace have received increased attendance. Our membership has slightly increased. The Sabbath School is doing a good work. Our outlook is more hopeful than it was a year ago.



**PRINCE ALBERT**—W. Kenner, Pastor.—The state of this Mission we regard as being far from satisfactory, as the five places cannot be worked efficiently with one preacher, and the friends are too few to sustain two ministers. We cannot expect to be aggressive at Prince Albert, as it has ceased to exist as a business place, and the friends coming into Port Perry, who have been connected with us in other places, fail, as a rule, to attend our Church here. Our Sabbath school is small, and congregation not large, though a few have professed faith in Christ during the year. At Bethany and Bethel, through special efforts, the Church has been quickened and souls saved. At Salem and on the Island we very much need a revival of religion.

**PERRYTOWN**—G. Smith, Pastor.—The special meetings at Providence were rather barren of apparent results. At the week-night appointment taken up last June, the congregations have been good and attentive. A few profess to be seeking the Lord, and they have been a little help to us financially. Another new appointment has been taken up three miles north of Eden. The neighborhood is a good one, congregations large and prospects fair, that, with the blessings of God on faithful labor, it may soon be one of the best places on the Mission.

**PETERBORO'**—W. Jolliffe, Pastor.—We have not been without seasons of spiritual quickening. A few have taken higher ground in Christian life, and a few more have penitently and believingly sought the Lord. Two of our members have passed away to their heavenly rest. Our congregations continue much the same; fluctuating at times, however, according to circumstances. The prayer and fellowship means of grace, though on the whole fairly attended, yet a fuller and more regular attendance is desirable. Our Sabbath School department needs to receive prompt, energetic attention on the part of efficient and devoted workers, so that it may become a factor in the building up of the Societies and the Church at large. We crave, above all, that the Spirit of the great Head of the Church may rest on the Societies.

**FENELON**—M. Metherell, Pastor.—The public services are well attended. Congregations have considerably increased in some of the places. Good attention is generally paid to the preached word; several souls have professed conversion during the year. At some of the appointments the social means of grace are pretty well attended, and prove to be seasons of rich spiritual enjoyment. There is a manifest improvement financially throughout the mission. We are sorry that our labors have not resulted in the conversion of more souls, but we are by no means discouraged.

**LINDSAY**—W. Limbert, Pastor.—There is a perceptible increase in our congregations. Special services were held during the winter for nearly four weeks, but did not result in very great success. We see everywhere great need of more zeal for the Lord of Hosts, and more thorough consecration to His service. Our social means of grace have been seasons of great blessing to those who have attended. The Sabbath School is about the same as last year, more laborers are needed in this department of our church work. Considerable improvement has been made and paid for in the parsonage in the shape of additional furniture, paint and paper. On the whole we think the prospects are favorable.

**MANVERS AND CARTWRIGHT**—J. Whitlock, Pastor.—We have learned to put our trust in the Lord, and have carried all our wants to Him in faith and prayer. All our congregations continue good. Our Sabbath Schools are in better working order than they were last year. We have had many refreshing seasons coming from God while waiting on him in the means of grace. Two of

ASHBURNHAM—T. Brown, Pastor.—Conversions, which is success in its  
 very essence, have been unknown, and there has not been that interest taken in  
 the workings of the church there ought to have been. This difficulty would be  
 removed in part if we were relieved from the heavy church debt which presses  
 sorely on our small society. The present state of our Sabbath School is far from  
 encouraging. This no doubt results from a lack of efficient workers. Congrega-  
 tions have been as large as ordinarily, and a very worthy attention has been paid  
 to the ministrations of the word. The social means of grace, on the whole, have  
 been very well attended, and seasons of blessedness have been real-  
 ized. The young folks, not only of the church, but of the congregation, have  
 manifested an interest in those services not to be everywhere seen. We thank  
 God and take courage.

TORONTO—E. Roberts, Pastor.—In presenting our annual report, we have  
 mingled feelings of disappointment, regret and thankfulness. All the good we  
 had hoped to effect has not been accomplished, yet we are thankful that peace  
 has reigned within our borders, and we have been favored with some tokens of  
 Divine presence and blessings, and a few have united with the Church of God.  
 The year has been one of great anxiety, as the change of pastors in this church  
 has always been attended with more or less dispersion and loss of membership  
 and congregation, leading our friends to desire as long a pastorate as possible;  
 nor have we realized that increase to the congregation that we desired. It is too  
 fluctuating and uncertain to give the real lovers of our Zion joy and hope.  
 During the year, death has removed our only local preacher, and in the demise  
 of Bro. John Y. Varcoe, we have lost one of our oldest members and one of our  
 most talented officials, but his end was triumphant; our Sabbath School,  
 under the efficient management of Bro. Binsted and a devoted band of teachers,  
 has improved in numbers and presents a very hopeful aspect. What we want  
 here is a better attendance on the social means of grace, a fuller consecration of  
 the entire church to God and His service, and a richer outpouring of the Holy  
 Spirit.

HAMILTON—J. J. Rice, Pastor.—This Mission has passed through another  
 year, and it has been one of at least average toil and anxiety; not, however,  
 without some rays of sunshine to inspire and cheer. The Sunday congregations  
 have kept up fairly. The Sabbath-school reports increase, both as to names on  
 the roll and average attendance, and is a most promising feature in an otherwise  
 fluctuating cause. The improvement made in the church, costing nearly \$100,  
 add much to the appearance and convenience of the edifice, and the cost has  
 been provided for. A devoted, judicious and energetic pastorate, with the hearty  
 co-operation of the membership, will soon place Hamilton Mission in such a  
 state as to make satisfactory return for labor and money in the past so liberally  
 spent upon it.

PICKERING—W. R. Roach, Pastor.—The special services held at Bethel  
 and Pickering resulted in showers of blessings on the people of God, and in the  
 conversion of many precious souls. Sunday-schools are prospering favorably  
 under the care of judicious, pious and devoted teachers. Most of the converts  
 of last year are faithful, working and useful members. We have suffered loss from  
 the removal of Bro. Courtice and family from Ebenezer, and Bro. M. Harris and



family from Bethel. Financially, numerically and spiritually, we occupy higher ground than for many years.

UXBRIDGE—A. Gordon, Pastor.—The conflict between right and wrong, sin and holiness, is still persisted in by both sides with determination. We have longed to know the joy of victory, and for about eleven weeks we pressed the battle with special effort and earnestness; but we met with a most determined resistance, and to our frequent appeals the purpose of many a sinner's heart might have been expressed in the deathful words, "No surrender." A few resolved to be Christ's faithful servants unto their life's end. A goodly number of our members adorn the doctrines of God our Saviour by a life of devoted service. Others maintain an outward consistency, but fail to exhibit in their lives the love and zeal for Christ and His cause, to convince the world that there is a living reality in the religion of Jesus. While there are those who plainly say by their conduct they are dead whilst they profess to live; others may work and give, but they will do neither. If activity and liberality in the cause of religion are proofs of a living Christianity, then they have none. Our great need is more of the loving, self-denying spirit of Jesus.

PALMERSTON—T. J. Sabine, Pastor.—The past year, like its predecessors, has been fraught with experiences of alternate light and shade. In ourselves we see much to deplore. In our merciful God we see much to adore. While there are still among us the feeble and the halting, we are gladdened by the evidences which some give of growth in grace and Christ-likeness. In the Sabbath-school department the success in Palmerston has not been commensurate with the desires, the hopes and labors of the teachers; but in Maitland we have the pleasure of seeing an active and promising school established. We thank God and take courage.

SUTTON—J. Pooley, Pastor.—In looking over the year we have much cause for gratitude and joy. Our public services have been well attended, and great attention is paid to the word of truth. Sabbath-schools, on the whole, have improved, but suffer lack of teachers. What we most need on this Mission is, 1st, a higher tone of piety; 2nd, an increased liberality.

WIARTON—T. H. Dry, Pastor.—We tried to hold special meetings at Colpo's Bay and Wiarton, but failed to have the co-operation of the church members, and consequently had to abandon the undertaking. We held a week of special services at Kemble. The prospects were promising, but the sudden illness of the Pastor was the cause of their being closed. Class and Prayer Meetings are not as powerful for good as they ought to be. Our Sabbath congregations are usually good, except at Wiarton, where it has been greatly reduced, owing to increased number of congregations meeting at the same hour. Our Sabbath-schools are reported prosperous.

CLINTON—R. Thomas, S. T. Bartlett, Pastors.—The Societies are in a comparatively healthy, united and consolidated condition. Some souls have been converted and added to the church. Prayer and Class Meetings have been times of refreshing coming from the presence of the Lord, and the public services seasons of profit and power. The Sabbath-schools have increased both in numbers and interest, and peace and harmony obtain throughout the Circuit. We have longed and labored to save sinners from the error of their ways, to build up a nobler Christian manhood, and to make men, through the Gospel, fit temples for the Holy Ghost to dwell in; and still pray, May the Lord build up Zion.

LONDON SOUTH—A. C. Courtice, Pastor.—The opportunities for service and the means of spiritual growth necessarily connected therewith, presented during another year, have been offered and are now irrecoverably past. It becomes a solemn question to ask and even a more solemn one to answer: How have these opportunities been used? During the year, three persons have been persuaded to confess Christ. Many of the members have grown in grace. A few have been moved by God's Spirit, given in answer to prayer, and have stirred themselves from a partial indifference into a spiritual earnestness which is encouraging. We record thankfulness to God for all blessings and look to Him for yet more abundant blessings.

LONDON EAST—G. H. Copeland, Pastor.—The year has been one of anxious toil. Our people have been visited with an unusual amount of sickness during the greater part of the year. Two of our members, Sisters Heaman and Barnes, have exchanged the pilgrimage of earth for the rest of heaven. Our Class and Prayer Meetings are not so well attended as desirable. Our "Ladies' Aid" is still rendering valuable service. Our School is well sustained, and is encouraging. What is needed most of all is a blessed baptism of the Holy Spirit.

LAMBETH—J. G. Yelland, Pastor.—It gives us unspeakable pleasure to notice the deep interest and holy zeal manifested by our Class Leaders and Stewards in the cause of the Lord Jesus among us. Our congregations are good and the spirit of hearing is very encouraging. During a series of union revival meetings held in Lambeth, the power and presence of the Master were blessedly enjoyed. Saints and sinners felt the force of truth, and a few persons were added to the Society. Our Sabbath-schools are in good condition, and worked by persons deeply interested in their work.

INGERSOLL—J. Archer, Pastor.—"O Lord, we will praise Thee, for hitherto Thou hast helped us." The voice of the great Master hath called some of our dear fathers and fellow-laborers home to rest. We are spared to realize His assistance in our loved work. Quite a number have professed conversion, both in regular means of grace and in special services held at Centreville, where we have taken up a week-night appointment. The converts at this place have united with our church in town. Our congregations are steadily improving, the evening congregation comfortably filling the church. Our social means are fairly attended and are seasons of great refreshing. A Sabbath-school has been organized at Putnamville, with an average attendance of 51. The town school is doing pretty well. God's work is reviving. We generally have some amongst us who are seeking, and others who have recently found the Saviour. To God be all the praise. May His work still revive.

ST. THOMAS—J. Holmes, Pastor.—Our congregations have considerably increased. The Sabbath-school has made substantial improvement, is thoroughly equipped, and is doing a splendid work. Our Prayer Meetings have been well attended; Class Meetings rather poorly attended. The members are living in peace, and many are adorning the doctrines of Jesus Christ by a blameless life. Of a few "we fear lest we have bestowed on them labor in vain." We have had many indications, in our ordinary services, of the power of the gospel leading people to say, "Men and brethren, what must I do to be saved?" Only a slight breeze or two which soon passed off, have arisen to ruffle the surface of our otherwise tranquil year. To God be all the praise.

ALBOTVILLE—S. H. Rice, Pastor.—The public services have frequently been seasons of great power and blessing, and we have often been led to ex-



claim, "A day in thy courts is better than a thousand." Several names have been added to the roll of membership, but owing to the large number of removals we return 7 less than last year. Class Meetings are well sustained, but Prayer Meetings are not so well attended. The Sabbath-school department is very fairly sustained. **WINDSOR**—T. Mason, Pastor.—The past year has been, to many of us, a vale of tears. The child of infant days has been snatched from the parents' arms, the wife called to sever the tenderest of all bonds, and the Pastor and his wife summoned to surrender an only child, just blooming into womanhood—a child whose every hour on earth was sanctified by a pious mother's faith and prayers. Our Missionary Society in Wisconsin does not present so favorable an aspect as we could wish, although in some departments the work has been well sustained. Last year there was a small debt of \$180 contracted by the opening of a new mission. During the present year this has been reduced about \$100. Some few souls have been saved and some have passed away in the triumph of faith to their eternal home.

One has been added to the society at La Grange, and gives good evidence of piety and devotedness to God. The church at Little Prairie has been repaired, at a cost of \$30. May the Lord send us prosperity.

BURLINGTON—R. Davidson, Pastor.—The year has not been so prosperous as we could have desired, but still we feel there is cause for gratitude to God, and much to stimulate us to labor with renewed diligence in the future. At Burlington Road, the congregation is small, but the Lord is with us, both in the public and social means of grace.
