THE CROW'S NEST EPISODE
The Globe yesterday admitted the facts cited by The World in reference to Mr. Jaffray and Senator Cox's connection with the coal fields of British Columbia, and their sale to the C.P.R. of the charter of the British Columbia Southern Railway.

The issue in regard to the Crow's Nest Railway is whether the Government should build the line itself, or whether it should assist the C.P.R. in building it and hand it over exclusively to that company under certain conditions as to freight charges. The sentiment of the country, as well as the decision of common sense, is overwhelmingly in favor of Government control.

All of which clinches our point: The Globe and Messrs. Cox and Jaffray have been doing their best to get the C. P. R. in grabbing the coal fields, monopolizing the Pass. The Globe and Mr. Jaffray have done their best—and we believe have failed to break down Mr. Blair in his stand. R. have swarmed about the Government for the past three weeks. It is all coming out and there is much more to come.
