CURTAILING THE CREDITS.

THE DEPUTIES MAKE BIG REDUCTIONS IN THE FINANCIAL BUDGET.

PARIS, Oct. 24.—In the Chamber of Deputies today M. Rovery stated that the Budget Committee had accepted the proposed reduction in the budget, and accordingly blamed the Government for rejecting them when they were first suggested.

Prima Minister Doumergue said he regretted to hear of Doumergue's language which was intended to excite the Chamber against the Government. He said he was the ally of all true Republicans. He did not believe that those who voted against the bill, aimed at the overthrow of the Ministry, but thought they simply desired to reduce expenses. [Applause.]

The debate on the budget then resumed. M. Sadi-Carnot, Minister of Finance, refused to agree to a reduction of the budget, but the credit for the Finance Ministry. A division was taken and the reduction was approved by a vote of 385 to 114.

The result was announced amid the most intense excitement.

The Deputies agreed to consider a reduction of 12,000,000 francs in the commission of the Treasury General, and 500,000 francs in the commission of private collectors of revenue.

M. Sadi-Carnot and M. De Freycinet opposed the reduction of the ground tax, the objects sought only to be obtained by the production of a special bill.

The bill was rejected by a vote of 385 to 114.

KAULBARS AT CONSTANTINOPLE.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Nov. 24.—Gen. Kaulbars will visit M. Nelidoff, Russian Ambassador here, at all the details of the Bulgarian situation and will give him in regard to the election of a new Prince of Bulgaria. Nelidoff has not yet received authority from his government to close the question of an eventual Russian occupation of Bulgaria. The Turkish Government continues to send war material to Adrianople and to strengthen the fortifications.

THE PLOT AGAINST DAVITT.

Patrick Ryan Says There Are Good Grounds For the Report—Kossuth's Menace.

LONDON, Nov. 24.—Mr. Ryan, ex-president of the Irish National League, was interviewed today regarding the rumored conspiracy to assassinate Michael Davitt. He said he believed there were good grounds for the rumor, and that if evidence were forthcoming on the subject, it would be found in reading between the lines of a despatch from New York, which was dated the 17th of the month.

For example, it states that Mr. Davitt was badly received throughout the West of Ireland. "Everywhere he was known as a better man than he is," said Mr. Ryan, "and he was not personally mixed up in the plot, the conspirators are not very far removed from him. The difference between Davitt and Davitt M. Ryan regards as simply an honest difference of opinion between two good men as to policy and methods, but the attack of O'Donovan Rossa is characterized as mean and unscrupulous. He is said to have plotted for a considerable time and have been guilty of empty threats and drive of blank checks. He is said to have been a man of sense, level-headed Irish nationalist.
