



A slip-a-none" is placed over his head and he is launched into the water. If alive he awims about unsided, but if dead the fisherman resorts to artificed methods by dangling the line. The water is very clear, and the bottom of the day is easily discernible. Attached to another string is the speary which has seven prongs. A nail in the side of the handle enables it to be hung on the edge of the hele in the floor, from whence it is quickly taken and thrown wish lightning-like rapidity and accuracy whenever the fish appreach the decoy. The fisherman never misses his aim, and consequently every throw of the spear counts for one or more fish. The fish run best early in the morning and after 4 o'clock in the afternoon, after dark a lamp with a reflector is used, and fishing is prosecuted as well as in the dayrime. They run in "schools" and she hole is fairly black with them at times.

The catch in the central and southern portions of the city is principally pickerel—there being a few white fish and some trout. The fish are sold at from 44 to 7 and 8 cents a pound in the bay, being purchased by buyers who go entit daily from the city, bring the fish back, and pack them for shipment to all parts of the world.
