## TERMS USED TO DEFINE THE VARIOUS PARTS OF A COIN.

THE front or face of a coin is called the *obverse*.

The back is called the *reverse*.

The principal device or object represented on a coin is called the *type*.

The area or space between the type and the circumference is called the *field*.

The lower portion of the area of a coin beneath the type, and separated from the rest of the field by a horizontal line, is called the *exergue*, *Ex.* This particular place on coins, with or without the separating line, is commonly referred to as the *Ex.*

Small objects represented either in the field or the exergue, as adjuncts to the main type, are called *symbols*.

Portions of a coin which are sunk below the level of the surface are said to be *incuse*.

ABBREVIATIONS. *Var.* Varieties. *O.* *Obv.* Obverse. *R.* *Rev.* Reverse.

RESTRICKES are pieces struck from the original dies, but at some time subsequent to the original issue.

OVER-DATES. When a die made in one year is used in a later year, by engraving one figure over another, the piece struck therefrom is said to be an "over-date." For instance the same die from which the half dollars of 1813 were struck was used in 1817, by sinking a 7 over the 3, and portions of the latter figure are plainly visible. Hence the variety "1817 over 13."

PROOF PIECES are struck by hand-press, upon burnished planchets from dies specially prepared, giving the coins a mirror-like appearance; they are furnished by the Mint authorities only during the current year, and at about 25 per cent. above face value. Since 1869, all coin dies used by the United States Mints are destroyed at the end of each year.

## WORTH READING.

I never purchase Coins without seeing them. The state of preservation, which requires long experience to pass upon, has much to do with value; hence \$3.50 to \$5.00 means what I will pay according to the condition of the piece. Mutilated, pierced or badly worn Coins I do not purchase.

BEWARE of altered dates, electrotypes, casts and counterfeits. Many rare pieces are imitated by some of these methods.

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DO NOT clean or brighten any Coin or Medal you desire to sell.

COINS not mentioned in these pages may be regarded as common, yet some of the earlier dates command a premium when perfectly new and sharp.

---

Examine the List of Coins I do not buy, on page 19, it may save you correspondence.

---

You must distinguish silver three-cent pieces from nickel. Of the latter, I buy but one date.
