

All truit growers know that potash in large amounts is necessary for besting fruit trees. But they are very apt to delay its application until take in apring or sometimes until midsummer, when the young fruit is fast salling from the trees for lack of the material to form its seeds. Dr. Lewsy has just made a communication to the Berlin Physiological Society-regarding the latest application of the Roentgen rays.
