An Act to increase the the Representation of the United  
Counties of Richmond and Wolfe.

**WHEREAS** the population of the Counties of Richmond and Wolfe Preamble  
has, within the last few years, been greatly increased, and the  
said Counties are now only represented in the Legislative Assembly by  
one Member; and whereas it is expedient that each of said Counties  
5 should be represented therein by one Member: Therefore Her Majesty,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and  
Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Upon, from and after the passing of this Act, the said Counties Richmond  
of Richmond and Wolfe shall cease to be united for purposes of Repr- and Wolfe to  
10 sentation in the Legislative Assembly, and each of said Counties shall be each  
thereafter be entitled to be represented therein by one Member; and represented  
the Member who immediately before the passing of this Act represented by one  
the said United Counties in the said Legislative Assembly, shall, on member.  
the passing thereof, become and be the Member for the County of  
15 Richmond; and the Clerk of the Crown in Chancery shall forthwith  
issue a writ for the Election of a Member to represent the said County  
of Wolfe in the said Legislative Assembly.
