The Osborne hall has been granted for the purpose, and a number of talented ladies and gentlemen who have volunteered to assist Mr. Sarvis in his laudable effort on behalf of the poor of the town, an entertainment of a meritorious order may be expected. The programme will be announced in a few days. As the price of admission is only a sliding scale—from 15 cents upwards—no one will be debarred the privilege of aiding the poor to the full extent of their inclination. The management will be pleased to hear from any person who will kindly volunteer the use of a piano for the occasion.

CONGREGATIONAL MINISTERS' ASSOCIATION.—There was a good representation of ministers and delegates of the Guelph Association in attendance at the convention held in the Congregational Church in this town on Tuesday and Wednesday of the present week. Sessions for the transaction of business and for the promotion of the welfare of the Church were held during his day-time. On Tuesday evening a social meeting was held, which was well attended. Rev. Mr. Howie, of Guelph, presided, and interesting addresses were given by Rev. Mr. Manlove, of Guelph, Rev. Joseph Griffith, of Hamilton, and Rev. C. Duff, of Speedville. Football, billiards, and good music were also provided. On Wednesday evening the Lord's Supper was administered; there was a large congregation present, and the brethren were taking active part in the services.

COLD, BITTERLY COLD.—The "cold wave" which visited this northern latitude last week, reached the climax on Thursday last, when the thermometer at this point indicated 15 degrees below zero. Cold as the weather was here, its intensity was still greater in other parts of the Province, as the following observations of the mercury sunk to 26 degrees below zero; at Brockville, 27 deg.; Amherst, 30 deg.; Acton, 31 degrees; Millbrook, 32 degrees; at all these places the thermometer coldly cold snap being accompanied with a storm of its severity would have been felt much more than it was. The cold, prevailing in this latitude, has no doubt accounts for the comparatively few cases of "frozens" that have been reported. It is scarcely probable that we shall have a repetition of such rigorous weather during the now fast declining winter.

"Black and white," sung tenderly by Mr. Bessie inimitable style, and to better effect than on the previous visit, its stage accompaniment of the ball perpetuating the same melody, and the number of the company in a style bordering on enchantment. The audience manifested their enjoyment of the entertainment by their hearty applause. We have not any doubt that should the Jubilee Singers again return to Listowel, they will be well received.

REBUILDING DEBARRIERS.—Already in progress of the approaching building season are to be seen in various parts of the town. Heaps of stone and other building material are being collected in quantities that would lead one to anticipate another season of intensive operations in the building line. From what we can learn at present, the extra-mural are greatly to be benefited by the reconstruction of the town. Messrs. James Lee, Wm. McKimie, J. P. Newman and D. H. Day are making preparations for rebuilding on the corner of the present building. The reconstruction of this building is a substantial brick structure. It is quite probable that the balance of the Bonner street, smoking shop, will be visited and reconstructed by the summer. Tenders for the erection of a new High School will be advertised for almost immediately; this will make a valuable addition to the building operations of the year. Material is already being delivered for several private residences, and a large number of others are in contemplation. Altogether indications point to a lively time for the mechanic and a corresponding increase of buildings in town.

AGAIN OPENED.—After a ten days' blockade, the P. & L. H. R. managed to get their road opened through to Listowel. On Monday night last the first train reached here since the 22nd of February. The Stratford & Huron section of this road has been extremely unfortunate this winter. Since Christmas traffic has been greatly impeded by snow blockades, on two or three occasions causing an entire suspension for better than a week. We notice by the General Superintendent's report that the road is being reconstructed as a preventative against difficulty. The Company should certainly try some means of abating the difficulty which has at present become a subject to it. Instead of being the convenience which the railway is supposed to be, during the past two months it has been controlled only at the expense of depending upon it for accommodation. And in the interest of the Company and of the public, the liability of the road to be controlled only at the expense of depending upon it for accommodation should be diminished to the lowest degree possible.

THE present condition of the sidewalks on our main streets is simply disgraceful. It is not only a nuisance, but it is not being brought about by the corporation by persons daily sustaining injuries by falls. Pedestrians are obliged to take the middle of the street, except in the heart of the town, and the danger of being run down by our country friends' limousines is not only a nuisance, but it is a serious one, and it is a pity that the snow outside the beaten track.

Yet the dilemma of the town footmen seems to tickle the fancy of the country teamster wonderfully. The latter never imagine that a momentary delay in being law compelled to give the footmen the beaten path, but he is on the other hand rather amused and gratified when he can come to a standstill, and turning the pedestrian with the shafts of his turnout. It might be well for all teamsters to remember that the law commands them to give the footmen the road, and not oblige the latter to tumble out in the snow outside the beaten track, otherwise they lay themselves open to the imposition of a fine of \$10.
