It is difficult for a resident of a comparatively sparsely settled country like the Dominion of Canada, to realize how so many human beings can live, and breathe in such narrow limits as that of the City of London.

London with its teeming millions, in all ways an object and study of interest and wonder. This city being the chief metropolis of our Empire, has for its naturally a greater interest, apart from all other considerations, than any other of the great world centres of commerce and population combined.

Let us glance at some of the wonderful facts of population, within its area of 122 square miles lives a population exceeding four millions, about equal to that of our whole Dominion, whose territory extends from the Atlantic to the Pacific, comprising over four millions of geographical square miles, or a square mile of territory for every man, woman and child within our borders.

London has thirty thousand miles of streets, employs twelve thousand policemen, spends every hour, and a hundred and eighty thousand pounds, and nearly twenty thousand vehicles pass over London bridge, daily, to say nothing of the numbers that pass over the Blackfriars, Chesham, Southwark and the other passenger bridges, eleven in all.

Eleven great railway companies, have their terminal lines in the city, besides the minor railways, and the two companies despatch together, five hundred trains a day. Over one hundred vessels enter her ports daily, and seven million tons of coal are required every year to feed her fires.

London has over one thousand schools, two hundred hospitals, seventy almshouses and four hundred workhouses. The city is surrounded by magnificent front public and private buildings. The Houses of Parliament contain over a million of dollars.
