Flags Went to Masthead. Messages from Secretary of State Came Too Late to Have Order Well Enforced.

CITIZENS KNEW NOT WHAT IT MEANT. City Council in a Dilemma—General Proclamation by the Mayor May Be Issued.

Some one was yesterday responsible for making a slip of the instructions called from Ottawa were to remain at home, to-day, or immediately after, all flags to the masthead, and fire salute for His Majesty's accession; to-morrow they should be hoisted half-mast again, and remain so till the funeral, of the date of which you will be notified later.

It was after 12 when the Mayor got word from Government House. The flag was ordered to be run up to the masthead, and the salute to be fired.

At the Parliament Buildings the general salute was fired at 12 o'clock. The Council do not know what to do. No instructions for public display of the new flag have come from Government House.

The Local Government only issued putting a notice in the Ontario Gazette. The feeling of the Mayor is in favor of making a proclamation such as was made in London, New York, and other cities, but the time appears to be past for doing that.

The Council will meet on Monday as already arranged, and formally adjourn with the raising of the flag.
