REPORT.

To the Friends and Supporters of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada.

DEAR FRIENDS.—It is as we take it, not necessary to use argument to convince you that the Missionary Cause is a good one. Of that you are fully satisfied. To many of you it would be painful even to suppose that any person thinks you doubt this. So firmly has the truth of the unspeakable blessedness of Christian Missions taken root in your hearts, that you have not a shadow of doubt on that question. There are no doubt, many people who do not think and feel thus; but few into whose hands this Report will come, will have doubts on this question. Think of the nature of the work of Christian Missions: and how beautiful, attractive and blessed in its results. There is nothing so glorious and blessed as the life of our Lord Jesus Christ. The work of Christian Missions is the most like the life work of Christ of anything on earth. He came to seek and save the lost. That is the work of Christian Missions. And when this work is done, no matter where, by whom or under what circumstances, the work of Christ is done. In his work, Christ not only saved the lost, but when saved, He sent them to save other lost people. To the man from the Tombs, out of whom He cast the devils, He said, "go show to thy friends how great things the Lord hath done for thee." The disciples he sent to "teach all nations." They had been blessed themselves and He sent them to bless others, in turning them away from their sins, and bringing them to a knowledge of salvation. The same commission is in force still, and the same principles, impulses and motives rule in the souls of Christ's disciples still.

The following illustrates this work:—

A Zulu lad in Natal had become leader to a farmer on his journey to Verulam, when they were overtaken by the heavy mists so common on those hills. The mists very shortly became pouring rain, and darkness came upon them. The Zulu lad overcome by the cold, dropped the thong with which he led the oxen, stood still, speedily the eyes closed and he could not move, and he became silent. The farmer stripping himself of his great-coat, and taking everything he had available for covering, laid him down in the waggon and covered him up, hoping by that means to revive him; but it was all in vain, life seemed slowly ebbing out. Then laying himself down beside the little lad, and opening his coat and stretching out his broad arms, he drew the boy to his warm, strong heart, and kept him there. Very soon the eyes opened and the heart began to beat, and the boy spoke, and life returned. Years afterwards, that Zulu lad said to the farmer, "Sir, tell me what it was that made your heart so warm towards me, and brought me back from death." And then with his heart as warm as ever, the Colonist told the "old, old story of Jesus and His love." And it warmed another heart; and speedily the boy from penitence, was led to rapture; and now he is on those same hills a native preacher, preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This is the way Christian work is extended and perpetuated. Those who have felt the power of Christ's love, may be heard saying,

"The love of Christ doth me constrain,
To seek the wandering souls of men."

And not only do they say it, but acting it out in daily life, still more impresses men's minds. It was the influence of Christ's love which prompted the farmer to save the Zulu boy; and the knowledge of this fact which made him first a Christian, then a Christian preacher. The spirit of Christ's teaching says to each of us, "Go thou and do likewise." If no Zulus within our

reach, there are unsaved people everywhere. The society whose Missionary Report is now presented to you, has, by its agents and friends, been the means, in the hands of God, of leading thousands of souls from Spiritual darkness to the Sun of Righteousness, and to the enjoyment of Salvation. There are thousands in heaven now, as well as thousands on the way there, who were led to Christ by the united efforts of the Society's agents, and those who have been fellow-helpers with them. And still the good work progresses, God is with His servants. His word is made a blessing to the people.

During the past year on our Canadian Mission Stations alone, 849 persons have been gathered into the Church. To do this has required a large amount of work and self-denial. There have been large losses to our Missions by removals and other causes during the year. So that the reported increase is not large, still it is gratifying that during so much unsettlement, and times so trying, we should be in a position to report an increase in our Mission field. Notwithstanding the hardness of times, (which it is hoped by the blessing of Providence will soon pass away,) five new Churches have been added to the previous number, and considerable added to the value of the Church property, while the value of the property has been increased, the debt on it has been decreased.

At the last Conference, Orangeville Mission applied, under the provisions of rule, to be taken off the list of Missions, and placed on that of Circuits, which relieved the Missionary Committee of some financial responsibility. Some other Missions are preparing to follow this good example, which they are anxious to do as soon as possible. This will put the Committee in a position to take up and cultivate new fields, if our people generally render that financial aid which they are able to do. The total amount of disbursements for the year is

The amount of disbursements over income is \$9165 94.

The total Income from all sources is \$9042 00.

Difference, \$123 94.

But for the strictest economy in everything, this deficit, or difference between income and out-go must have been very much larger than it is. But for the depression in trade, and the indebtedness of our English Missionary Society, our Grant from the English Conference would have been larger; but we must express our appreciation of their kindness for their appropriation of £550 for our Canadian work. For a full financial statement, see the balance sheet at the end of this report.

The Report it is believed may in the circumstances, be considered an encouraging one. As a sample of the work done, and the results of that work, our readers are referred to a few extracts from the reports from the Stations.

There is one draw back to the Report. The Missionary Income is not near as much as is necessary to prosecute the work which is before us, with that vigour which should characterise Mission work. Because of the limited amount of money at the disposal of the last Conference, the Grants to fully three-fourths of the Missions were lowered much below what they ought to be. As a result, the probability is that the ministers labouring on them will at the end of the year have large deficiencies. Another result of deficient funds is this, places which have been waiting some time for ministers, are obliged still to wait. Stations needing additional labourers, in order to push the work as vigorously as it ought to be done, are unable to receive them. Thus, for want of money the work of God is retarded. How is this? We regret to say that the Missionary Income is about \$2,000 less than it was a few years ago. To have carried on the work of God amongst us as it should have been done, required an increase of at least \$2,000. A falling off to that amount makes a serious difference. A question arises, how is it that there has been this falling off, instead of an increase? No doubt the depression in trade, etc., as urged by some friends as a reason; and also local changes in some of the Circuits; and the improvement of church property on their own Stations as urged by others, may to some extent account for the falling off. But these are but secondary causes, there are no doubt others. But it may be more profitable to ask what can be done to increase our Missionary Income, than to

further enquire into the causes of the falling off. At a meeting of the Ministerial Association of Toronto, held in July, this subject was discussed, and the following resolutions passed. "That we pledge ourselves to use our utmost endeavours to increase our Missionary revenue, and to secure a revival of the Missionary spirit amongst our people." Now this resolution acted upon by our ministers and people in Toronto, will result in hundreds of dollars advance, and if all our Stations take up the work in the same spirit, thousands of dollars in advance of last year will be the happy result. Then those ministers now discouraged by large deficiencies will be relieved; new openings—some of which have waited long—will be entered, and a future of prosperity and increasing membership will be before us. That this is a desirable thing all will agree. That as a Church we are able to do it, with the blessing of God, there is no doubt whatever. Only let all our Ministers and Stations engage to do their best, and we shall hear of no more declining Missionary revenue. Twenty years ago our revenue amounted on an average to about 75c. per member; it was talked over among a number of ministers; it was written about in the *Christian Journal*; and spoken of at the Missionary meetings; the aim was to raise the Income to the average of \$1 00 per member. In course of time that was exceeded, now we are back to about 75c a member; though our people are better able to give \$1 50 per member now than they were to give 75c. then. An effort as hearty, persevering and united as the other would, with-out doubt, result in raising the Income higher than it has ever been before.

A great deal depends upon the collectors securing the usual large subscriptions, but also a good deal depends upon them getting in the small subscriptions. A leading layman once said 'he would rather have \$100 from one hundred persons, than \$100 from one person, because in the former case he had one hundred hearts.' There is sound philosophy in that. Will our collectors look after the small sums? In looking over the report, it will be found that there has been a large falling off in the small sums, some large sums have dropped off, where it is believed they should not, while these are looked after, and secured, in the small sums a large increase may be realized. It may take more time and labour, but it will pay in many ways. In the juvenile department too, there is room for large improvement. After the adult collectors have been round, which for many reasons should be early in the season, then let the ministers set the children to work on all the stations and at every preaching appointment, and in this way an extra thousand dollars may be raised, over what has been done the past few years.

Brethren shall that effort be made? Friends will you help your ministers in making it? Will you, as societies and individuals, join in prayer that the collectors may be successful, that God may give us as a people, a large measure of the missionary spirit, and send us prosperity? Will you also resolve on giving a subscription if you have not done so, and on increasing it, if in the past you have given? If such be the resolutions of our ministers and people combined, there need be no doubt about the result. If such shall be the case when another Report is to be issued, we shall have united and general rejoicing. Thus saith the Lord. "Bring ye all the tithes unto the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it." Mal. III. 10. Spiritual blessing God makes, in many instances to depend upon our returning to Him obediently offering what is his due, the pouring out of His spirit often depends upon the pouring out of our tithes before God, thus we may have heaven's windows opened to us, by opening our hands in liberal gifts at Gods altar.

"BRACEBRIDGE.—The past year has been one of considerable toil, but, through God's blessing, one of considerable success. Missionary work here is very laborious on account of sparseness of the population in the country and the roughness of the roads. Our congregation in the village of Bracebridge has

increased encouragingly during the year, and the Spirit of God has been graciously poured out upon it, producing a quickening of the religious life of the membership and an increase of members. We have taken up a new appointment in the township of Draper. Here we have a good church in course of erection, mostly the gift of one gentleman in the neighborhood, a large and increasing congregation, and, although our society is yet small, our prospects are good. As we review the past year we find that we have much reason to thank God and to take courage. After filling up about forty vacancies in our membership, caused by removals, death, etc., we are able to report fourteen of an increase for the year, besides keeping a good reserve. We think that the liberality of the people on this Station is unsurpassed, if equalled, in any part of our Connexion in Canada. Although the times have been very hard during the past year on account of the almost total failure of crops throughout the Muskoka District, most of our people have contributed nobly to the support of the gospel amongst them.—N. WELLWOOD.

BRADFORD.—*Dear Brother.*—Forward is our battle cry. On this Station last year we had a good work of grace in the *ordinary services* of the church. A good number of souls were saved and united with us. We had a good increase in finances. The congregations were never better. A new appointment has been taken up since Conference. The prospects of success are good. The Sabbath schools are doing well. Arrangements are now in progress to beautify and otherwise improve one of our churches. May this our fourth year be the best one.—THOS. BOYD.

CARADOC.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—We have had a busy and successful year. *Five months and three weeks* were spent in Special Meetings, at which sixty-five persons sought and found the Lord. The year has been made sacred by the hallowed memories of souls won for Christ. We reported to the Conference an increase of forty members. Financially too we have done well. The debt on Parsonage we have reduced \$100, Missionary money, 25 per cent. in advance of last year. We are now building a beautiful frame church in the village of Komoka, worth \$1000; all of which we hope to provide for at the opening in October, that we may present it to God *free of debt*. We have missioned the important town of *Strathroy*: our prospects upon the whole are very encouraging. We now enter upon another Connexional year, strong in faith, expecting immediate results.—J. E. MOORE.

CATHCART.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—We are thankful to the Giver of all good that we are able again to report progress. God has not forgotten to be gracious. Showers of blessing have fallen, and the "Garden of the Lord" abundantly refreshed. We held two protracted meetings during the winter, and thirty precious souls were added to the Church. We have also taken up another appointment during the year, which promises to be a source of strength, having good congregations and a society of twenty-six members. We are now taking steps for the erection of a good brick Church, 28x40, which will give us the needed facility for working. We have also improved our Cathcart and Falkland Churches by painting, furnishing &c., and all expenses are fully met. Praying for still greater blessings to rest upon our work generally.—Yours truly, A. W. TONGE.

CHATHAM.—*Dear Bro. Bee.*—The work of God on this Mission has tried the faith and courage of the Missionaries very much. The journeys were long and many, and for six months the roads were almost impassable with mud, making it difficult to hold any Special Services. However, about forty souls were converted during the year, most of whom joined our church. Our congregations have increased, church property improved, debts lessened, and the general Spiritual outlook of the Station is much brighter. May the coming year be covered with many conversions to God.—J. DYKE.

FOREST.—*My dear Brother Bee.*—The past year on the whole has been one of success and blessing. Although we have not been favoured with any very special work of Grace, yet several souls have been led to Christ, and the Spiritual life of the Societies quickened, as the result of three protracted meetings held during the winter. same as last year, after filling up 32 blanks caused by removals, deaths &c. The financial record is an improvement on any previous year of the Station's history. \$450 has been paid off the Forest Church debt, besides the interest for the year, and a neat and commodious gallery erected in the South end of the church for the use of the Choir. The Missionary money is in advance at all the appointments, and the ordinary income \$50 in advance of last year. The Station raised for every purpose during the year \$1217 25, which we think is very creditable, especially considering the hard times. The Sabbath schools are all in active operation. The Forest School is rapidly improving. With peace in our borders, and a cheering outlook for the future, we enter upon another year of earnest work for God. May Heaven favour us with gales of mercy and tides of saving grace.—Yours fraternally, W. A. RODWELL.

“KINGSTON.—The past year has been one of constant effort to advance the interests of our Zion in this city, and the master has not left us without signs of his approval. Other denominations not represented here for years have re-entered the city and depending largely on connexional effort have erected places of worship, hence the competition in church matters has been stronger than ever; before many have left through scarcity of work, still our congregations have kept up very well. After filling up a loss of twenty we are still able to report a small increase. The income from envelopes and collections is \$522,92. Extra effort \$21,55, total \$544,97. Our missionary money is \$168,19, being an advance of \$40,22 on the previous year and more than double the amount raised four years since. During the year we have re-shingled the church at a cost of \$164,50. Put a new coal furnace in the basement \$125,00. Renovated the S. School room \$33,00, and supplied the parsonage with storm sashes at a cost of \$28,00, and these things are all paid for. Our people here evinced their gratitude for past help by contributing over \$200 to the public fund, this we think speaks well for the liberality of a congregation composed almost entirely of working people. We are very anxious to become a circuit, our parsonage debt has prevented us, but with returning prosperity to the city a strong effort will be made to provide for its payment. Your agent here preaches to the same congregation twice each Sabbath, superintends the S. School, teaches the Bible class and takes charge of two week night meetings. With careful management Kingston will be one of our most desirable stations.—Yours for the Master, THOS. W. JOLLIFFE.”

“LONDON.—The past year has been an exceedingly trying one to this station and to the ministers thereon. Our loss of members by removals and deaths amounted to thirty four, and by other causes to thirty three. Twenty six persons were received. We have a small increase of ordinary income but a decrease in Missionary money. Early in the year efforts were directed towards relieving our church property from its serious embarrassment. In this we were partially successful, but still the debt on this property is considerable, and some of it is in great need of outside help.—W. HERRIDGE”

“ORILLIA.—This Mission has its difficulties and discouragements, but after all it is a comfortable field on which to labor. The members here are few in number and work financially, but they are united and hearty. During the year we have had plenty of work and the Lord has blessed us with a measure of success. Over forty have united with us in church fellowship, several of whom have been of great help to us financially, socially and spiritually. Our financial position is not all that could be desired, still it is improving: We are looking forward to the time, no distant day, when we shall ask the conference to grant us the privilege of becoming a self-sustaining circuit. We enter upon another year believing that the Lord's blessing will rest upon faithful toil, and crown it with abundant success.—Yours in the hope of the Gospel.—R. MCKEE.”

“ORANGEVILLE.—It is with gratitude to the Head of the Church we read some tokens of progress on this Station. When we entered this field some two years ago we found our predecessor the Rev. J. Milner had laid a good foundation for future prosperity. Being cordially received we entered heartily upon our work and have met with very cheering co-operation and success. We found a debt on the church of about \$640,00 to be paid in five equal annual instalments. One of these had run behind in consequence of the enlarge-

ment of the church and other improvements. We have been able to meet the three payments in two years which leaves at present but \$251 debt on the church which will be met as it matures. The mission had been burdened for many years by paying high rent for a parsonage and as our grant had been greatly reduced we began to cast about in hope of obtaining a suitable property at a reasonable price. We purchased a rough cast house with about half an acre of land in a good situation for \$1050,00. We have veneered the house with brick and put a new roof upon it, which with other repairs cost about \$400 more. It is now one of the best and most desirable parsonages in our work. We have reduced this debt to \$1000, which at seven per cent. makes a large saving in our funds. Amid these secular operations we have not been unmindful of our chief mission to win men to Christ, nor have we toiled in vain. Each of the special services we have held has resulted in believers being added unto the Lord and often at our sabbath night services we have been cheered with conversions and testimonies to the power of the grace that saves. With increased numbers we resolved on increased responsibility and therefore requested the last conference to make us a Mission Circuit that the contributions heretofore given to us may go to new localities till the desert becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field a garden of the Lord. We have just held our first quarterly meeting as a circuit and have been able to report an increase in our membership, and a large increase in our income, and now feel more satisfied that God will honor those who honor Him, and assure the prosperity of a *noble Faith*. I have never met a more liberal people in the support of the ministry. We have one man who contributes \$75 a year as quarterage and others \$35, \$30, and \$20, who are by no means wealthy men. And I have ever found that those who give liberally co-operate generously in all church work while the miserly soul writes books of lamentation over the decline of modern piety and has neither a heart to give nor a hand to perform any good work: May the spirit of grace and of liberality come upon all our stations, so shall we have fewer deficiencies, more missionary money, new circuits, encouraged ministers, and a larger and more enthusiastic church! The Lord speed this much to be desired consummation.---THOS. GRIFFITH."

PLATTSVILLE.---During the past year on this Station we have been labouring earnestly to promote the work of God. In this respect we have not toiled in vain. Two protracted meetings were held for some considerable time, in which much good was done. Several accessions to our members as the result. Some of the young who were brought to Jesus are showing signs of usefulness in the Lord's vineyard. This is cheering. Our services as a rule are fairly attended. Finances on the whole somewhat improved. We have made some improvements in our Plattsville church, at Bethel we have put up a new shed, and paid for it, or nearly so. This is a material convenience, as well as an additional value to our church property at this place. We have much to thank God for. True we have had our trials and discouragements, though often cast down, we have not been forsaken. As our day has been, so have we had strength from our Heavenly Father. It is our prayer and wish, to see more spiritual results in holy consecration to God, on the part of our people, and *many, many* Souls brought to Jesus. We are hopeful for the future. Our cry is, "O Lord revive thy work."---THOS. BRYANT.

"ST. CATHARINES.--Our course in this city is at present prosperous. During the past year \$1,350 have been raised towards the debt on our church property \$1,100 throughout the denomination, and \$250 by the society here. The lot on which the church stands is now connexional property. The church has been enlarged and improved. The congregation has more than doubled within the last seven months. Our Sabbath School has increased in number in the same length of time from 25 to 75. Our ordinary income has also risen from \$45 to \$90 per quarter. Port Dalhousie is also hopeful. One great need here is a church. We have a Sabbath School of 60 a congregation of 100 and a membership of 20 all meeting in a Temperance Hall. A lot is offered on one of the main streets but we have no means to build with. With a little timely aid this place would become strong. Praying that God may prosper our Mission work and workers.---I am yours, C. O. JOHNSON."
