BUTTERFLY CHOPS 6 servings

- 6 butterfly pork chops, ½ to ¾ inch thick Salt, pepper, curry powder
- cube chicken bouillon
- cup hot water
- 6 slices side bacon ½ cup chopped onion ½ lb fresh mushrooms
- or use 10 oz. can mushrooms

¾ cup grated Cheddar cheese

Sprinkle chops with seas-oned salt, freshly ground pepper, and a little curry pow-der. Brown well on both sides in a frying pan. Pour off any excess fat. Dissolve the bouil-lon cube in hot water. Pour over chops. Cover. Simmer

over low heat until fork-ten-der — 35 to 40 minutes. Meanwhile, cut bacon into strips about ½ inch wide. In a frying pan place bacon, onion and mushrooms. Cook about 10 minutes. Keep warm. LOWERING THE BOOM - - A 150-foot floating steel ice deflector has been installed at Sarnia by Canadian National to protect its docks and rail barge equipment from ice drifting down the St. Clair River. The 100-ton "boom" will be anchored at an angle to the current to catch and deflect floating ice during the Spring breakup on Lake Huron. CN officials expect the deflector will handle ice up to 600 feet in diameter and nine inches thick. Because it is floating, the boom will not affect the ecology of the river. small onions, chopped. cups shredded cabbage.

Davis Trial Seen As Test Of System

PALO ALTO, Calif. (AP)—Black revolutionary Angela Davis says if she is aequitted of murder-kidnap charges it will be a victory for the people, not the judicial system. However, she said: "If I am convicted, I will see the jurors as having been willing or unwilling accomplices in a conspiracy presented by the state."

As she prepares for trial Jan. 31, she worries that some people are supporting her only because they believe she had nothing to do with the state."

In an interview in a jail visiting room, Miss Davis said "People have to realize, they had nothing to do with August 7th," she said.



As one of the few broadcasting outlets for "the black man with a black viewpoint," Black Journal can be valuable for both black and white viewers.
