President Promises Equality

Eisenhower pledged to work with all the skill, patience and influence at his command to assure all Americans an equal chance to make good.

The President's promise was included in a statement read by Labor Secretary James P. Mitchell at an Equal Opportunity Day dinner sponsored by the National Urban League. The President said the belief that all men are created equal under law is the foundation of U.S. Democracy.

Mitchell, speaking on his own, denounced as "treasonous" to the American spirit such men as Gov. Orval E. Faubus of Arkansas who, he said, have tried to make political capital out of racial prejudice.

In a world where colored people outnumber whites three to one, he said, "we can no longer hide our Faubuses."

Mitchell conceded that every man has a right to his own prejudices. But he said "No man in any office or position, but especially in an influential position has a right to in flict his prejudices upon the people at large.

"And to make political capital out of prejudice is to insult the American people," he declared. "To seek personal gain from other men's distress is treasonous to the spirit in which America was founded."







Beat 3 eggs whites until frothy, gradually add ½ cup sugar until whites are stiff and glossy. Beat egg yolks until thick and lemon colored Fold in egg whites. - Dissolve cherry jelly powder in 2 cups boiling water. Add 2 cups icecold water or pear juice.
- Set in refrigerator until cold. Prepare lime jelly powder in the
- same manner, adding pineapple juice instead of cold water, if desired. Allow to cool, but do not let the
- Prepare fruit, cutting cherries and grapes into halves and removing seeds from the grapes.

When cherry jelly is cool pour a small amount into an angel-food tin (enough to form a very thin film).

Arrange 5 pear halves, cut side down, on bottom of the tin with pointed ends toward the outer edge of tin, having first placed half a cherry in the centre of each pear

Arrange about 4 grape halves, cut side down, between the pears to form a design. Place in refrigerator till jelly is set.

Next pour in remainder of cherry

jelly and remaining grapes and cherries. If there are any pears left use them too. (Bananas may also be used if desired.) Plaze in freezing compartment of

your refrigerator until very firm. Now pour in lime jelly and pineapple pieces.

Place in refrigerator again, and when set unmold by dipping tin in

warm water for a few seconds. Serve with or without whipped cream either as a salad or a dessert. (Serves 12 to 16.)




