


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

CAP. XXVI.

An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the Study and Practice of Physic and Surgery therein.

[28th July, 1847.]

Whereas the laws now in force in Lower Canada, Preamble. for regulating the Practice of Medicine, Surgery and Midwifery, require amendment; And whereas it is highly desirable that the Medical Profession of Lower Canada aforesaid be placed on a more respectable and efficient footing, and that better means should be provided for the conviction and punishment of persons practising the same without license: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, An Act to re-unite the Fro-Ordinance of vinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Go- L. Tremblay, and their successors, to be named and appointed as hereinafter described, shall be and are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, and shall by that name have perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to change, alter, break or make new the same; and they and their successors by the name aforesaid may sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered uuto in all Courts and places whatsoever, and by the name aforesaid shall be able and capable in law to have, hold, receive, enjoy, possess and retain for the ends and purposes of this Act and for the benefit of the said College, all such sums of money as nave been or shall at any time hereafter be paid, given or bequeathed to and for the Holding pro-use of the said College; and by the name aforesaid shall and may at any time hereafter, without any Letters of Mortmain, purchase, take, receive, have, hold, possess and enjoy any lands, tenements or hereditaments, or any estate or interest derived or arising out of any lands, tenements or hereditament for the purposes of the said College and for no other purposes whatever; and may sell, grant, lease, demise, alien or dispose of the same, and do or execute all and singular the matters and things that to them shall or may appertain to do; Provided always that the real estate so held by the said Corporation shall at no time exceed in value the sum of one thousand pounds.

College. Regulations as to studies.

1. To regulate the Study of Medicine Surgery, Midwifery and Pharmacy, by making rules with regard to the preliminary qualification, duration of study, curriculum to be followed, and the age of the candidate applying for a (certificate) to obtain a license to practise: Provided always that such rules shall not be contrary to the provisions of this Act.

2. To examine all credentials purporting to entitle the hearer to a (certificate) for license to practise in this Province, and to oblige the bearer of such credentials to attest (on oath to be administered by the Chairman for the time being) that he is the person whose name is mentioned therein, and that he became possessed thereof honestly.

Provided always, and be it enacted, That qualified may nothing in this Act contained shall be construed to prevent or prohibit any competent female from practising Midwifery in Lower Canada, such female proving her competency before any two members of the College of Physicians and Surgeons and obtaining their certificate to that effect: Provided that such certificate and proof shall only be required in the Cities of Montreal

among the members of the Corporation resident in the District of Three-Rivers, and three from among those resident in the District of St. Francis; and that of the Members of the said Board of Governors, neither more nor less than eight shall be resident in the City of Quebec, and neither more nor less than eight in the City of Montreal; and that at each election of the Board of Governors, every Member of the said Corporation shall have

III. And be it enacted, That after the passing of this Act, it shallnot be necessary that a license to practise Physic, Surgery and Midwifery in Lower Canada be granted in any case by the Goverthe Governor, nor of this Province, but that from and after the passing hereof no person shall practise Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada, unless he shall have obtained a license from the Provincial Medical Board, who are hereby authorized to issue such license.

IV. And be it enacted, That after the passing of this Act, the seventh and eighth sections of the said Act shall be interpreted and inverselect as if the words "certificate," and "certificate of qualification," were struck out of the said sections wherever they occur, and the word "license" were inserted instead thereof.

V. And be it enacted, That the said Provincial Medical Board shall have power to grant licenses may be licen- without examination to such Graduates of Universities in the United States as may have been practising in Lower Canada, for a period of not less than ten years, provided such Graduates prove to the satisfaction of the said Board that they are of good moral character, and apply for such license, and produce the necessary testimonials and proof within one year from the passing of this Act.

VI. And be it enacted, That the penalty imposed by the ninth section of the said Act shall be recoverable with costs, and that the same may be sued for and recovered by the said College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, by its Corporate Name, and being recovered shall belong to the said Corporation for the uses thereof;

and neither in any such suit or in any other civil Members or criminal action to or in which the said Corpomay be witration may be a party or interested, shall any member of the Corporation he deemed incompetent as a witness by reason of his being such Member.

OF THE

COLLEGE OF PHYSIANS SURGEONS

OF

LOWER CANADA.

AS AMENDED JULY 1850.

Board of Governors.

I. The affairs of the College shall be conducted by a Board of Governors, thirty-six in number; fifteen of whom shall be elected from among the members of the College, resident in the Districts of Quebec and Gaspé; fifteen from among its members resident in the District of Montreal, three from among its members resident in the District of Three Rivers and three from among its members resident in the District of St. Francis, and of the said Board of Governors neither more nor less than eight shall be resident in the City of Quebec, and neither more nor less than eight in the City of Montreal.

II. The above Board of Governors shall by elected every three years, on the second Wednesday of July. The Meetings for this purpose to be held in the Town of Three Rivers, after at least one month's notice of such Meeting having been published in the Official Gazette, in one Medical Journal of each District (if published), and in at least one English and one French newspaper, in each District.

III. The election shall take place by ballot, those members being elected who have received the majority of votes.

IV. All ties, whether in cases of election or ordinary business of the College, to be decided by the casting vote of the Presiding Officer, and this shall be his only vote.

V. All vacancies in the Board of Governors, whether arising from death, resignation, removal from the District, or otherwise, shall be filled up by the Board of Governors, from among the Members of the College in the District where such vacancy shall occur, by an election by ballot, at the next ensuing Meeting subsequent to the occurrence of such vacancy.

VI. Any Governor who shall absent himself from the regular Meetings of the Board twice consecutively, without assigning for such absence a cause satisfactory to the Board shall be considered as vacating his seat, and the Board shall ballot for a member in his place.

VII. Extraordinary Meetings of the Board may be summoned at any time, by the President, on the requisition of at least twelve Members belonging thereto. One month's notice of the said Meeting to be sent to each Member of the Board,

specifying the date and object of such Meeting.

VIII All Extraordinary Meetings shall be held alternately

at Quebec and Montreal.

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IX. Every Governor attending the semi-Annual Meeting, shall be allowed his traveling expenses, which are in no instance to exceed ten dollars, and for which purpose, the funds (so far as they will go,) accruing from Candidates' Licenses alone, shall be set apart. But no Governor shall be entitled to travelling expenses unless he shall have faithfully attended to the business of the Meeting until it shall have been duly closed.

Officers of the College.

I. The Officers of the College shall consist of a President, a Registrar and Treasurer, and for each of the Districts of Quebec and Montreal, of a Vice-President and Secretary, who shall be elected by ballot, by the Governors, from among their own body, the said Officers to be actually residing in the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and they shall continue in office until the ensuing Triennial Meeting; it being understood that when the President resides in either city, the Vice-President may be elected from among the Governors residing out of the city, and vice versa if the Vice-President resides in either of the cities, the President may be elected from among the members of the Board not resident within the cities, and should the President be absent at any meeting, the senior Vice-President shall exercise his duties, and in the event of both Vice-Presidents being absent, then a chairman shall be elected pro tem.

II. The President shall preside at all the Meetings of the College, and sign all vouchers for the payment of money.

III. In the absence of the President, the Vice-President of the District shall possess all his powers.

Registrar and Treasurer.

I. The Registrar shall keep in his possession, the Books of Enregistration, one of which shall be for Students entering

upon the Study of Medicine, and the other for the enregistration of the Members of the College, and he shall have

charge of the Seal of the College.

II. As Treasurer he shall receive all moneys due to the College, whether from its Members, Licentiates or otherwise, and forthwith deposit the same in one of the legally instituted Savings Banks of the Province, and make a full Statement of all Receipts and Disbursments, at each Semi-annual Meeting, (exhibiting at the same time his Bank Book,) and also, at any other time he may be called upon to do so by the President, and must furnish security to the amount of (£100) one hundred pounds currency.

III. The Registrar shall receive as renumération one half

of the enregistration fees.

The Secretaries.

The Secretaries shall keep correct Minutes of the Transactions at all Meetings, and as soon as possible after each meeting, communicate to each other a Copy of such Minutes, which shall be regularly entered in books provided for that purpose, and in consideration of their services shall each receive annually the sum of twelve pounds, ten shillings currency, to be paid them from out of the contingent fund.

Of Members.

I. No one who has obtained a License since the passing of the nended act, 12 Vict. chap. 52, (May 30, 1849), shall be admitted a member of the College of Physicians and Sur-

geons until after the expiration of four years.

II. All applications for Membership must be accompanied by a document signed by two Members of the College, testifying as to the moral qualifications of the applicant, which document must be handed to the Secretary at least ten days before the day of meeting.

III. Immediately on admission as a Member, the applicant shall sign the Rules and Regulations in possession of the Registrar, thereby binding himself to fulfil all regulations pro-

vided in this behalf.

IV. Members of the College are at once eligible as Governors; but no Member shall vote at any of the Triennial Elections for the Board of Governors, unless he shall have previously paid up all his dues.

V. Every person proposed as Member shall be considered elected if he receive a majority of the votes of the Members present, wether it be at the Triennial Meeting or at the Meeting of the Board of Governors.

An Act to amend Chapter Seventy-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting the Medical Profesfession and the sale of Drugs.

[Assented to 30th June, 1864.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend chapter seventy-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Low-Con. Stat. L. er Canada, intituted: " An Act respecting the Medical Profession and the sale of Drugs," and to make better provision for the granting of licenses for the sale and distribution of Medicine by retail in Lower Canada: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Section sixteen of chapter seventy-one of New section the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, is hereby repealed, and the following shall be substi-

tuted therefor, and read in lieu thereof:--"16. Except such persons as may lawfully practise Physic in Lower Canada, no person whatsoever shall carry on the business of Aposhall sell me-thecary, Chemist and Druggist, in Lower Canada, who shall not have obtained a license from the Provincial Medical Board, which license the said Board are hereby authorized to grant to any person applying for the same who shall have passed such examination in pharmacy as the Board may deem satisfactory, and such license shall be euregistered in the Books of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada."

Licenses granted by the Provincial Medical Board declared valid.

And whereas persons desirous of obtaining licenses to sell or distribute medicine by retail in Lower Canada, have from time to time presented themselves before the Provincial Medical Board, and on passing satisfactory examinations have obtained such licenses, and doubts arisen as to the validity of such licenses, it is enacted that all licenses to sell and distribute medicines by retail in Lower Canada which may have been heretofore granted by the Provincial Medical Board, shall be held to be valid and sufficient, to confer and to have conferred on the garantees thereof all the rights and powers conferred by any license that might have been granted under the sixteenth section of the Act above cited.

That the result of the examinations whether successful or otherwise shall not be communicated to the candidates until after all the candidates have been examined; after which all the successful candidates shall be brought in before the whole Board and receive their licenses or certificates from the President, who shall when presenting them make a few remarks on the high position they are about to assume in society and the responsible duties they are about to undertake. Adopted 10th October 1866.

The following report of the Committee on examination was adopted the 14th May 1867. Candidates for practice shall be examined by three separate committees, each composed of three members. Each member of these three committees shall examine on one subject, which shall be assigned to him by the President of the meeting, and which he will not be allowed to change, every candidate who shall present himself during the meeting of the Board. The questions on each subject shall be varied as much as possible with the candidates.

Each member of these committees should pay the strictness attention to the answers given to the other members of

The majority of the three committees will be necessary for the admission or the refusal of candidates. But the candidate will be rejected, if he receives a contrary vote on one of the following branches, Midwifery, Internal and external Pathology. Therefore the examination may be closed as soon as such a vote has been given.

The President shall assign to each member of the Committees (six months in advance) that subject on which he shall examine each of the candidates who shall come up before them at the next session.



An Act to amend Article 2260 of the Civil Code as respects Fees due Physicians.

[Assented to 5th April, 1869.]


HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Subsection seven of article two thousand two hundred and sixty of the Civil Code, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:—"For visits, services, operations and medicines "of physicians or surgeons, reckoning from each service or "thing furnished. The oath of the physician or surgeon "makes proof as to the nature and duration of the service."

At the triennial meeting of the College held in the town of Three Rivers, on the 12th of July, 1871, the By-laws were amended as follows:

Moved by Dr. Scott seconded by Dr. Peltier that in future the second semi-annual meeting in the year, shall be held on the last Wednesday in September, in each and every year instead of, as at present on the second Tuesday in October, with the exception of the fall meeting of the year 1871 which shall be held on the second Tuesday in September in place of the last Wednesday of the month as subsequently. Adopted on division.

At the same meeting it was moved by Dr. Howard seconded by Dr. Scott, that the Board of Governors shall have power to exempt candidates for the practice of Pharmacy who were in practise as such prior to the passing of the Act 27–28 Vict.: chapt. 51, from the curriculum prescribed for candidates under the By-laws, who commenced their studies subsequent to the above act. Adopted.
