An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the Study and Practice of Physic and Surgery therein.
[28th July, 1847.]
Wheneas the laws now in force in Lower Canada, Preamble. for regulating the Practice of Medicine, Surgery and Midwifery, require amendment; And whereas it is highly desirable that the Medical Profession of Lower Canada aforesaid be placed on a more respectable and efficient footing, and that better means should be provided for the conviction and punishment of persons practising the same without license : Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the adriee and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Irelind, and intituled, An Act to re-unite the Fro. rinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Go- Ordinance of vernment of Camada, and it is hereby enacted by 3 , c. 8 , repeathe anthority of the same, That from and after led, except so the passing of this Act, the Act or Ordinance of much as rethe Legislative Council of the late Province of latesto DrugQucbec, passed in the twenty-nighth year of the gists. VI. Any Governor who shall absent himself from the regnlar Meetings of the Board twice consecutively, without assigning for such absence a canso satisfactory to the Board shall be considered as vacating his seat, and the Board shall batlot for a member in his place.
VII. Extraordinary Meetings of the Board may be summoned at any time, by the President, on the requisition of at least twelve Members belonging thereto. One month's notice of the said Meeting to be sent to each Member of the Board, specifying the date and object of such Meeting.

VIII All Extraordinary Meetings shall be held alternately at Quebec and Montreal.
IX. Every Governor attending the semi-Annual Meeting, shall be allowod his traveling expenses, which are in no instance to exceed ten dollars, and for which purpose, the funds (so far as they will go, accruing from Candidates' Licenses alone, shall be set apart. But no Governor shall be entitled to travelling expenses unless he shall have faithfully attended to the business of tho Meeting until it shall have been duly closed.

## Oflicers of the College.

What persons only shatl seli medicines in Lower Canada.

Licenses granted by the Provincial Medical Board declared valid. practise Physic in Lower Canada, no person whatsoever shall carry on the business of Apothecary, Chemist and Druggist, in Lower Canida, who shall not have obtained a license from Ure Provincial Medical Board, which license the said Board are hereby authorized to grant to any person applying for the same who shall lave passed such examination in pharmacy as the Board may deem satisfactory, and such license shail be enregistered in the Books of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Camada."
2. And whereas persons desirons of obtaining licenses to sell or distribate medicine by retal in Lower Canada, have from time to time presented themselves belore the Provincial Medical Boart, and on passing satisfactory examinations have obtained such licenses, and donbts arisen as to the validity of such licenses, it is enacted that ali licenses to sell and distribute medicines by retail in Lower Canada whith may have been heretofore granted hy the Provincial Medical Board, shall be hed to be valid aud sufficient, to confer and to have conferred on the gamatees thereof all the rights and powers conferred ly any lirense that might have been granted under the sixteenth section of the Aet abore cited.

An Act to amend Article 2260 of the Civil Code as respects Fees due Physicians.
[Assented to 5th April, 1869.]
Her majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quobec, enacts as follows:

1. Subsoction seven of article two thousand two hundred and sixty of the Civil Code, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:-"For visits, services, operations and medicines " of physicians or surgeons, reckoning from each service or "thing furnished. The oath of the physician or surgeon " makes proof as to the nature and duration of the service."
