CAP. XXVI.

An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the Study and Practice of Physic and Surgery therein.

[28th July, 1847.]

WHEREAS the laws now in force in Lower Canada, Preamble.
for regulating the Practice of Medicine, Surgery
and Midwifery, require amendment; And whereas
it is highly desirable that the Medical Profession
of Lower Canada aforesaid be placed on a more
respectable and efficient footing, and that better
means should be provided for the conviction and
punishment of persons practising the same with-
out license: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's
Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice
and consent of the Legislative Council and of the
Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada,
constituted and assembled by virtue of and under
the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament
of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and
Ireland, and intituled, *An Act to re-unite the Pro-*
vinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Go-
vernment of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by
the authority of the same, That from and after
the passing of this Act, the Act or Ordinance of
the Legislative Council of the late Province of
Quebec, passed in the twenty-eighth year of the
Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third,
and intituled, *An Act or Ordinance to prevent per-*
sons practising Physic and Surgery within the Pro-
vince of Quebec, or Midwifery in the Towns of Quebec
and Montreal, without license, except so much there-
of as relates to the vending or distributing of

Medecines by retail,—and all other Acts or parts of Acts in any manner relating to the Practice of Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada, or in any manner relating to the mode of obtaining licenses to Practice Physic, Surgery or Midwifery therein, shall be and are hereby repealed, except in so far as relates to any offence committed against the same or any of them before the

passing of this Act, or any penalty or forfeiture incurred by reason of such offence : Provided always, that the Act of this Province, passed in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to enable persons authorized to practice Physic or Surgery in Upper or Lower Canada, to practice in the Province of Canada*, shall not be

repealed or affected by this Act: Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall have the effect of repealing any law or part of law in force in Lower Canada, relative to Druggists and Apothecaries and the vending of Drugs by them in Lower Canada.

II. And whereas it is expedient that the Médical Profession of Lower Canada, be empowered under certain restrictions to frame its own Statutes for the regulation of the study of medicine in all its departments, and By-laws for its own government : Be it therefore enacted, That Daniel Arnoldi, Wolfred Nelson, M. junior, A. T. Michaud, F. Poulin, L. S. J. Sinclair, L. S. Tremblay, and their successors, to be named and appointed as hereinafter described, shall be and are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of *The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada*, and shall by that name have perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to change, alter, break or make new the same; and they and their successors by the name aforesaid may sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto in all Courts and places whatsoever, and by the name aforesaid shall be able and capable in law to have, hold, receive, enjoy, possess and retain for the ends and purposes of this Act and for the benefit of the said College, all such sums of money as have been or shall at any time hereafter be paid, given or bequeathed to and for the use of the said College; and by the name aforesaid shall and may at any time hereafter, without any Letters of Mortmain, purchase, take, receive, have, hold, possess and enjoy any lands, tenements or hereditaments, or any estate or interest derived or arising out of any lands, tenements or hereditament for the purposes of the said College and for no other purposes whatever; and may sell, grant, lease, demise, alien or dispose of the same, and do or execute all and singular the matters and things that to them shall or may appertain to do; Provided always that the real estate so held by the said Corporation shall at no time exceed in value the sum of one thousand pounds.

III. And be it enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, the persons who compose the College of Physicians and Surgeons shall be called "Members of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada."

IV. And be it enacted, That the affairs of the said College shall be conducted by a Board of Governors, thirty-six in number, fifteen of whom shall be elected by the College generally from among its Members in the Districts of Quebec and Gaspé, fifteen from among its Members in the

District of Montreal, and six from among its Members in the Districts of Three Rivers and St. Francis.

V. And be it enacted, That the said Board of Governors shall be, and they are hereby constituted "The Provincial Medical Board," in which capacity they shall meet for the examination of candidates not less than twice in each year at such time and place as to them shall be deemed most fit, and on wick occasions seven shall be a quorum for the transaction of business.

VI. And be it enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, no person shall receive a license to practise Physic, or Surgery, or Midwifery, in Lower Canada, unless he shall have obtained a certificate of qualification from the said Provincial Medical Board; and which license the Governor of this Province shall grant upon the production to him of such certificate of qualification.

VII. Provided always and be it enacted, That every person who has obtained or may hereafter obtain a Medical Degree or Diploma in any University or College in Her Majesty's Dominions, shall be entitled to such (certificate) without examination as to his qualification.

VIII. And be it enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, no person shall be admitted as a student of Physic, Surgery or Midwifery, unless he shall have obtained a (certificate) of qualification from the said Provincial Medical Board.

IX. And be it enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act, no person shall practise Physic, or Surgery, or Midwifery in Lower Canada, unless he be a person duly licensed so to practise, either before or after the passing of this Act, unless a penalty of five pounds currency, for each day on which any person shall so practise, contrary to the provisions of this Act: And such penalty shall be recoverable on the oath of any two credible witnesses, before any Justice of the Peace for the District in which the offence shall have been committed, and in default of the payment of such penalty on conviction, the offender may

To regulate the Study of Medicine Surgery, Midwifery and Pharmacy, by making rules with regard to the preliminary qualification, duration of study, curriculum to be followed, and the age of the candidate applying for a (certificate) to obtain a license to practise : Provided always that such rules shall not be contrary to the provisions of this Act.

To examine all credentials purporting to entitle the bearer to a (certificate) for license to practise in this Province, and to oblige the bearer of such credentials to attest (on oath to be administered by the Chairman for the time being) that he is the person whose name is mentioned therein, and that he became possessed thereof honestly.

To cause every member of the profession now practising or who may hereafter practise in Lower Canada, to enregister his name, age, place of residence, nativity, the date of his license and the place where he obtained it, in the books of the College.

To fix the period of probation which persons must undergo before being eligible for election as Members of the College, which period shall not be less than four years, and to make all such rules and regulations for the government and proper working of the said Corporation and the election of a President and Officers thereof, as to the members thereof may seem meet and expedient, which said rules and regulations shall, before they shall come into effect, be sanctioned by the Governor of this Province after the same shall have been submitted to him for approval and by him allowed.

XI. And be it enacted, That the qualifications to be required by the Board of Governors from a person about to commence the study of Medicine in this Province, shall be : A good moral character, and a competent knowledge of Latin, History, Geography, Mathematics and Natural Philosophy; and that from and after the end of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty, a general knowledge of the French and English languages shall also be indispensable.

XII. And be it enacted, That the qualifications to be required from a candidate for examination to obtain a (certificate) for a license to practise shall consist in his not being less than twenty-one years of age ; that he has followed his studies uninterruptedly during a period of not less than four years under the care of one or more general practitioners duly licensed ; and that during the said four years he shall have attended at some University, College or Incorporated School of Medicine within Her Majesty's Dominions not less than two six month's Courses of General Anatomy and Physiology—of Practical Anatomy—of Surgery—of Practise of Medicine—of Midwifery—of Chemistry—and of *Materia Medica* and Pharmacy,—one six months' Course of the Institutes of Medicine,—one three months' Course of Medical Jurisprudence,—and one three months' Course of Botany, if obtainable in Lower Canada ; also, that he shall have attended the general practice of an Hospital in which are contained not less than fifty beds, under the charge of not less than two Physicians or Surgeons for a period not less than one year, or two periods of not less than six months each ; and that he shall also have attended two three month's or one six month's Course of Clinical Medicine, and the same of Clinical Surgery, and to remove all doubts with regard to the number of Lectures which the Incorporated, at Quebec and Montreal are bound to give yearly : Be it enacted and declared, that it is and shall be sufficient that the said Schools of Medicine, respectively, shall yearly cause to be delivered one hundred and twenty lectures on the subjects by law provided, in the

English language or in the French language, without its being necessary that any lecture should be delivered in both languages, and each lecture, in whichever language delivered, being reckoned as one of the one hundred and twenty.

XIII. And be it enacted, That all persons obtaining the (certificate) for license to practise from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, shall be styled Licentiates of the said College, and be consequently in due course of time eligible to be elected members of the same, and such persons so elected shall be at once eligible for election as Governors, and the said election, either as member of the said College or as Governor thereof as aforesaid, shall be made under such rules and regulations therefor, and in such manner as the said Corporation shall make therefor, to be sanctioned by the Governor of the Province in manner aforesaid: Provided always, that it shall be lawful for the Governor of this Province by Proclamation, to fix the time and place for the holding of the first meeting of the said Corporation and the *first President* thereof.

XIV. And be it enacted, That the Board of Governors aforesaid shall regulate the fees to be paid by all candidates about entering on the study of medicine, provided the amount of such fees do not exceed the sum of one pound five shillings currency; and also by all persons who obtain from the said Board a (certificate) for licence to practice medicine; provided that the said fee do not exceed the sum of two pounds and ten shillings currency; which fees the Governors shall have the power to dispose of in such manners as they shall deem most proper for the interests of the College.

XV. Provided always, and be it enacted, That nothing in this Act contained shall be construed to prevent or prohibit any competent female from practising Midwifery in Lower Canada, such female proving her competency before any two members of the College of Physicians and Surgeons and obtaining their certificate to that effect: Provided that such certificate and proof shall only be required in the Cities of Montreal

and Quebec and the Town of Three Rivers.

XVI. And be it enacted, That so much of any law heretofore in force in Lower Canada, as may have fixed the period of prescription with regard to claim (*demande*) of any person duly licensed to practice Physic, Surgery or Midwifery, for professional services, attendance or medicine, shall be and is hereby repealed; and any such claim shall be prescribed by the lapse of five years from such attendance, service or medicine furnished, without any act having been done to interrupt the prescription, and not before: Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to revive any such claim actually prescribed before the passing of this Act.

XVII. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Act, and taken and received as such in all Courts of Justice, and by all persons in this Province.

CAP. LII.

An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the study and practice of Physic and Surgery therein.

[30th May, 1849.]

WHEREAS it is expedient in the manner Preamble hereinafter mentioned, the Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years, of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the study and practice of Physic and Surgery therein*: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, *An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the government of Canada*, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That for and notwithstanding any thing in the second section or in any other part of the Act cited in the Preamble to this Act, *all persons resident in Lower Canada, and licensed to practise and actually practising Physic, Surgery or Midwifery therein at the time of the passing of this Act, shall be and are hereby declared to be Members of the Corporation of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada.*

II. And be it enacted That upon, from and after the next election of the Board of Governors mentioned in the fourth section of the said Act, three of the six Members of the said Corporation who under the said section are to be elected Members of the Board of Governors, shall be taken from As to Members of the Board of Governors after the next election.

among the members of the Corporation resident in the District of Three-Rivers, and three from among those resident in the District of St. Francis; and that of the Members of the said Board of Governors, neither more nor less than eight shall be resident in the City of Quebec, and neither more nor less than eight in the City of Montreal; and that at each election of the Board of Governors, every Member of the said Corporation shall have the right of voting by proxy.

Proxies.

Licenses to be given by the Board and not by the Governor.

III. And be it enacted, That after the passing of this Act, it shall not be necessary that a license to practise Physic, Surgery and Midwifery in Lower Canada be granted in any case by the Governor of this Province, but that from and after the passing hereof no person shall practise Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada, unless he shall have obtained a license from the Provincial Medical Board, who are hereby authorized to issue such license.

Sect. 7 & 8. amended.

IV. And be it enacted, That after the passing of this Act, the seventh and eighth sections of the said Act shall be interpreted and have effect as if the words "certificate," and "certificate of qualification," were struck out of the said sections wherever they occur, and the word "license" were inserted instead thereof.

Graduates of the U. S. may be licensed on certain conditions.

V. And be it enacted, That the said Provincial Medical Board shall have power to grant licenses without examination to such Graduates of Universities in the United States as may have been practising in Lower Canada, for a period of not less than ten years, provided such Graduates prove to the satisfaction of the said Board that they are of good moral character, and apply for such license, and produce the necessary testimonials and proof within one year from the passing of this Act.

And be it enacted, That the penalty imposed by the ninth section of the said Act shall be recoverable with costs, and that the same may be sued for and recovered by the said College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, by its Corporate Name, and being recovered shall belong to the said Corporation for the uses thereof;

AMENDED

RULES AND REGULATIONS

OF THE

COLLEGE OF PHYSIANS SURGEONS

OF

LOWER CANADA.

AS AMENDED JULY 1850.

Board of Governors.Amended
in 1865.

I. The affairs of the College shall be conducted by a Board of Governors, thirty-six in number; fifteen of whom shall be elected from among the members of the College, resident in the Districts of Quebec and Gaspé; fifteen from among its members resident in the District of Montreal, three from among its members resident in the District of Three Rivers and three from among its members resident in the District of St. Francis, and of the said Board of Governors neither more nor less than eight shall be resident in the City of Quebec, and neither more nor less than eight in the City of Montreal.

II. The above Board of Governors shall be elected every three years, on the second Wednesday of July. The Meetings for this purpose to be held in the Town of Three Rivers, after at least one month's notice of such Meeting having been published in the Official Gazette, in one Medical Journal of each District (if published), and in at least one English and one French newspaper, in each District.

III. The election shall take place by ballot, those members being elected who have received the majority of votes.

IV. All ties, whether in cases of election or ordinary business of the College, to be decided by the casting vote of the Presiding Officer, and this shall be his only vote.

V. All vacancies in the Board of Governors, whether arising from death, resignation, removal from the District, or otherwise, shall be filled up by the Board of Governors, from among the Members of the College in the District where such vacancy shall occur, by an election by ballot, at the next ensuing Meeting subsequent to the occurrence of such vacancy.

VI. Any Governor who shall absent himself from the regular Meetings of the Board twice consecutively, without assigning for such absence a cause satisfactory to the Board shall be considered as vacating his seat, and the Board shall ballot for a member in his place.

VII. Extraordinary Meetings of the Board may be summoned at any time, by the President, on the requisition of at least twelve Members belonging thereto. One month's notice of the said Meeting to be sent to each Member of the Board, specifying the date and object of such Meeting.

VIII. All Extraordinary Meetings shall be held alternately at Quebec and Montreal.

IX. Every Governor attending the semi-Annual Meeting, shall be allowed his traveling expenses, which are in no instance to exceed ten dollars, and for which purpose, the funds, (so far as they will go,) accruing from Candidates' Licenses alone, shall be set apart. But no Governor shall be entitled to travelling expenses unless he shall have faithfully attended to the business of the Meeting until it shall have been duly closed.

Officers of the College.

I. The Officers of the College shall consist of a President, a Registrar and Treasurer, and for each of the Districts of Quebec and Montreal, of a Vice-President and Secretary, who shall be elected by ballot, by the Governors, from among their own body, the said Officers to be actually residing in the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and they shall continue in office until the ensuing Triennial Meeting; it being understood that when the President resides in either city, the Vice-President may be elected from among the Governors residing out of the city, and vice versa if the Vice-President resides in either of the cities, the President may be elected from among the members of the Board not resident within the cities, and should the President be absent at any meeting, the senior Vice-President shall exercise his duties, and in the event of both Vice-Presidents being absent, then a chairman shall be elected pro tem.

II. The President shall preside at all the Meetings of the College, and sign all vouchers for the payment of money.

III. In the absence of the President, the Vice-President of the District shall possess all his powers.

Registrar and Treasurer.

I. The Registrar shall keep in his possession, the Books of Enregistration, one of which shall be for Students entering

upon the Study of Medicine, and the other for the enregis-
tration of the Members of the College, and he shall have
charge of the Seal of the College.

II. As Treasurer he shall receive all moneys due to the
College, whether from its Members, Licentiates or otherwise,
and forthwith deposit the same in one of the legally institu-

Of Members.

I. No one who has obtained a License since the passing of

Of Licentiates.

I. The Licentiates are entitled to the appellation of " Licentiate of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada. "

II. After the expiration of four years such Licentiate may apply for Membership, subject to the regulations in that behalf.

III. The Diploma for Licentiates shall be signed by the President and Registrar, and by the Vice-President and Secretary of the District in which the Meeting is held, and have the Seal of the College affixed thereto.

Of the Meetings.

I. The Regular and Stated Meetings of the Board of Governors shall be held on the second Tuesday of May and October, in each year. The May Meetings in the City of Montreal, and the October Meetings in the City of Quebec.

All Candidates for License or Students proposing to pass their preliminary examination, shall deposit with the Secretary at the time they hand in their credentials, the amount of fees which would become due to the College in the event of successful examination, which fees will be returned to unsuccessful Candidates.

Regulations, &c.

I. Any person possessing a Diploma, &c., from British Universities, wishing to obtain a License to practice in this Province, is required to present himself in person, and prove to the satisfaction of the Board that he is the person whose name is mentioned in said Diploma.

II. Candidates for Provincial License commencing their studies subsequently to the passing of the Act of Incorporation of this College, (July 28, 1847,) will be required to submit to a Literary and Classical Examination on entering upon their Studies, and a Professional one at their close.

III. At the Preliminary Examination the Candidate must furnish proof of his possessing a good moral character, and a competent knowledge of Latin, History, Geography, Mathematics, and Natural Philosophy, and from and after the year 1850, he must also possess a general knowledge of the French and English languages.

IV. The Professional Examination shall be held after the completion of the Curriculum hereinafter enjoined, and shall consist of an inquiry into the scientific attainments of the Candidate, based upon the course of study he has pursued.

V. Before his examination be entered upon, the Candidate for License must submit to the Board satisfactory testimonials as to his moral character—of his being of the full age of twenty-one years, and that he has pursued his studies uninterruptedly during a period of not less than four years, and that he has been regularly indentured during the said period of four years to one or more general Practitioner or Practitioners duly licensed.

VI. He must further furnish proof that he has attended at some University, College, or Incorporated School of Medicine, within her Majesty's dominions, the following branches of Medical Education :—

An Act to amend Chapter Seventy-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting the Medical Profession and the sale of Drugs.

[Assented to 30th June, 1864.]

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient to amend chapter
 Con. Stat. L. seventy-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower
 C. cap. 71. Canada, intituled : " *An Act respecting the Medical Profession and the sale of Drugs,* " and to make better provision for the granting of licenses for the sale and distribution of Medicine by retail in Lower Canada : Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

New section substituted for sect. 16. **1.** Section sixteen of chapter seventy-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, is hereby repealed, and the following shall be substituted therefor, and read in lieu thereof :—

What persons only shall sell medicines in Lower Canada. " **16.** Except such persons as may lawfully practise Physic in Lower Canada, no person whatsoever shall carry on the business of Apothecary, Chemist and Druggist, in Lower Canada, who shall not have obtained a license from the Provincial Medical Board, which license the said Board are hereby authorized to grant to any person applying for the same who shall have passed such examination in pharmacy as the Board may deem satisfactory, and such license shall be entered in the Books of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada. "

Licenses granted by the Provincial Medical Board declared valid. **2.** And whereas persons desirous of obtaining licenses to sell or distribute medicine by retail in Lower Canada, have from time to time presented themselves before the Provincial Medical Board, and on passing satisfactory examinations have obtained such licenses, and doubts arisen as to the validity of such licenses, it is enacted that all licenses to sell and distribute medicines by retail in Lower Canada which may have been heretofore granted by the Provincial Medical Board, shall be held to be valid and sufficient, to confer and to have conferred on the grantees thereof all the rights and powers conferred by any license that might have been granted under the sixteenth section of the Act above cited.

III. The registrar shall receive as remuneration, the sum of (£12 10s. 0d.) twelve pounds ten shillings currency annually out of the Contingent Fund.

Secretaries.

The Secretaries shall keep correct minutes of the transactions at all Meetings, and as soon as possible after each Meeting, communicate to each other a copy of such minutes, which shall be regularly entered in books provided for that purpose, and in consideration of their services shall each receive annually the sum of (£12 10s 0d) twelve pounds ten shillings currency, to be paid them out of the Contingent Fund.

Of Members.

I. No one who has obtained a License since the passing of the amended Act 12 Vict. chap. 52, (May 30th, 1849,) shall be admitted a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons until after the expiration of four years.

II. All applications for membership must be accompanied by a document signed by two members of the College, testifying as to the moral qualifications of the applicant, which document must be handed to the Secretary at least ten days before the day of Meeting.

III. Immediately on admission as a Member, the applicant shall sign the rules and regulations in possession of the registrar, thereby binding himself to fulfil all regulations provided in this behalf.

Moved by Dr. Marmette seconded by Dr. Marsden that the committee on preliminary examination be composed of three members, and that two members shall receive or reject the candidate. Adopted 9th October 1866.

Moved by Dr. Blanchet seconded by Dr. Robillard that no licenses or certificates shall be delivered to candidates until after the business of the college is finished. That the result of the examinations whether successful or otherwise shall not be communicated to the candidates until after all the candidates have been examined ; after which all the successful candidates shall be brought in before the whole Board and receive their licenses or certificates from the President, who shall when presenting them make a few remarks on the high position they are about to assume in society and the responsible duties they are about to undertake. Adopted 10th October 1866.

The following report of the Committee on examination was adopted the 14th May 1867. Candidates for practice shall be examined by three separate committees, each composed of three members. Each member of these three committees shall examine on one subject, which shall be assigned to him by the President of the meeting, and which he will not be allowed to change, every candidate who shall present himself during the meeting of the Board. The questions on each subject shall be varied as much as possible with the candidates.

Each member of these committees should pay the strictness attention to the answers given to the other members of

the same committee (and their vote shall be registered, with their initials immediately after the examination on each of these branches.) The majority of the three committees will be necessary for the admission or the refusal of candidates. But the candidate will be rejected, if he receives a contrary vote on one of the following branches, Midwifery, Internal and external Pathology. Therefore the examination may be closed as soon as such a vote has been given.

The committees will be named by the President assisted by &c., &c., &c.

The President shall assign to each member of the Committees (six months in advance) that subject on which he shall examine each of the candidates who shall come up before them at the next session.

The committees shall divide the subjects of examinations in the following manner.

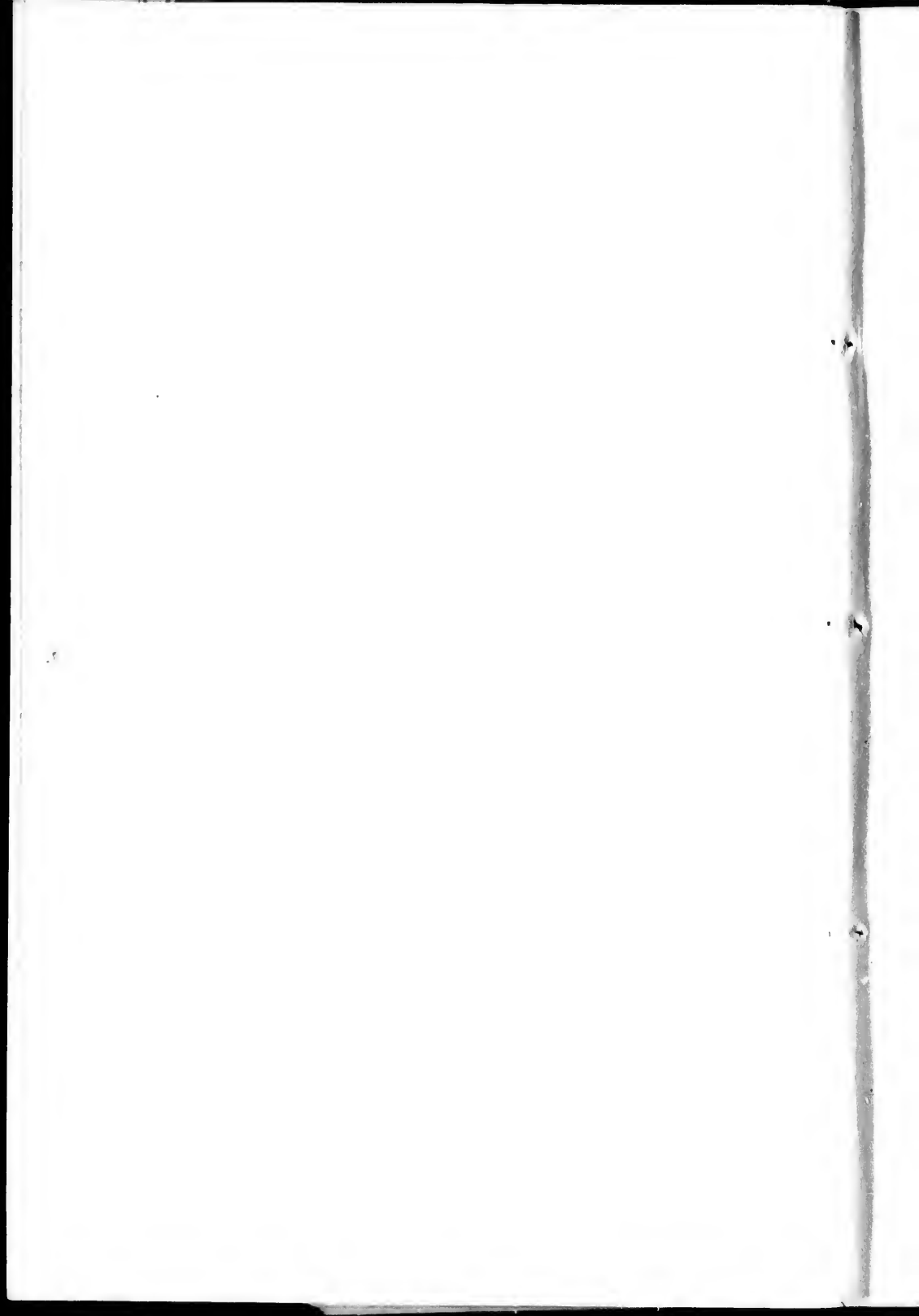

On motion of Dr. Gilbert the President was authorized to take the necessary steps to sue all individuals practising without license, and that the expenses would be paid by the Board of Governors.

At the triennial meeting of the month of July 1868, Dr. Marsden seconded by Dr. Smallwood proposed that the section of the By-laws concerning the fees of licentiates be altered by erasing the following words, Parchment—\$5.00. Adopted



An Act to amend Article 2260 of the Civil Code as respects
Fees due Physicians.

[Assented to 5th April, 1869.]

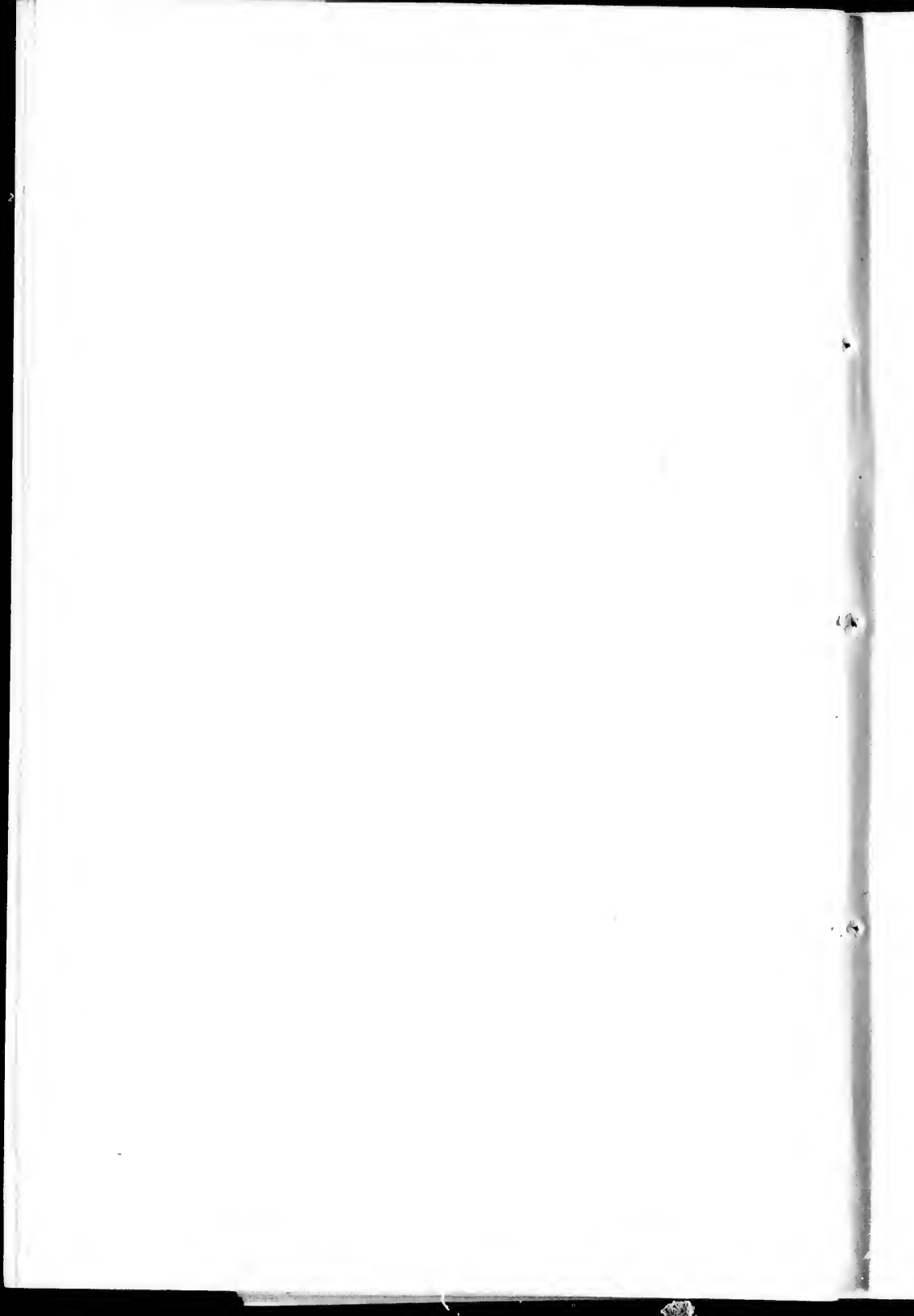
HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Subsection seven of article two thousand two hundred
and sixty of the Civil Code, is hereby amended so as to read
as follows :—“ For visits, services, operations and medicines
“ of physicians or surgeons, reckoning from each service or
“ thing furnished. The oath of the physician or surgeon
“ makes proof as to the nature and duration of the service.”

At the triennial meeting of the College held in the town of
Three Rivers, on the 12th of July, 1871, the By-laws were
amended as follows :

Moved by Dr. Scott seconded by Dr. Peltier that in future
the second semi-annual meeting in the year, shall be held

At the same meeting it was moved by Dr. Howard
seconded by Dr. Scott, that the Board of Governors shall have
power to exempt candidates for the practice of Pharmacy
who were in practise as such prior to the passing of the Act
27-28 Viet. : chapt. 51, from the curriculum prescribed for
candidates under the By-laws, who commenced their studies
subsequent to the above act. Adopted.
