## PHILATELIC TELRMS DEFINED.

## By J Eyducy Dalton

There are some terma in our catalngue that are like "double Dutch" to the beginner and ho often gets disgusted with it, owing to the fact that he can't understaud it. At othor times he might lose money by selling a stamp which is catalogued-for example, 5 c on wove paper, 50 c on laid, neithe. if which he understands and therafore he sells it for 5 c , thinking it must be the cheap varioty. In order to avoid these mistakes wo will endea. vor to explain some things from the catalogue which would puzzle the beginner and. Te may prevent bim from getting discumraged. The first thing we will deal with will be paper.

Wore paper is smooth aud wien held up to the light will not show light and dark parts but will bo oven in shade.

Lamp paper is the contiary to wove paper, and is of a light and dark shade alternately. Tho shades are in lines and will appear in light and dark lines. The lines will bo closo together immedintely following one another.

Ribbed Paper consists of rough
lin's appearing on both back and front.

Watermarks. A watermark is a figure, such as a crown, star, anchor, letters, etc., impressed in the paper the stamp is printed on. It appears of a light shade whon held up to the light. If it is difficult to distinguish what it is, or if the stamp is heavily cancelled drop the stamp face downwards in some benzine and the mark will appear of a dark shade. Or again, apply a little benzine to the back of the stamp having the face laid on a piece of black paper.

Reprints. Reprints worry the beginner also, he being not able to tell them from the originals.. It is impossible to ci:re any advice on these but by conslilting tlio catalegue and some othor adranced collector or dealor the beginner will generally bo able to tell them.

Embossed stamps aro stamps which have the paper pressed into little "square lumps" which can be seen geverally on the back.

Silk paper very ofien troubles him also, such as in some of the U. S. Ferenues. It consists of small colored fibres presised into the stamp, so to speak. Thoy can be seen ou tho back:

Part perforated worry more than the beginner. This is a variety which should not be in the catalogue, and, slow:y but surely they are falling from the line of distinction. It will not be long before they will be an unknown thing, and the sooner the better for all parties, for they are unnecessary.

Dies are hard to distinguish sometimes and some are so ridiculous that they-like the part perforated stamps -should not be noticed.

## OUR OIPINION ON RATES,

There has been some discussion of late as to the right and wrong of a paper demanding cash in advance from advoittisers. Some cenounce the "cash with copy" rule onforced by Energy, the Philatelic Advocate, the Alleghany Philatelist, and other papers, saying that it protects only the publishers. Wo have tried boith systems and under the old system have had enough experience with dead beat advertisers to last a lifetime. Now we demand cash in advance and thareby protect ourselves and our readers. We can assure our readers that we will never kuowingly insert the ad. of a fraudulent dealer. We have on different occasions returned money to persons whom we believer to be doing dishonest advertising. But on the whole we have found the cash in advanco principle very effective in warding off unprinciplea advertisers. With allprecaution however, it is possible.for parasites to find their way into pbilatelic or other newspapers. If any of Energy's advertisers are found. doing crooked work we will consider it a favor if notification is givon us.

 TELIC LITERATURE.'Thore's is uright philatelic paper being issued monthly from the State of Michigan. It is tho Pbilath:lic Chronicl:, published by H. E. Williams.

This paper is only a year old hut ranks with the leading philatelic monthies of the day. For originality it is equalled by fow; almost every page glistens with things original which gives the Chronicle a distiuction from all othre stamp masazines. With originality it combines neatness and enterprise and these three excellent qualities have made the paper one of the brigitest extant. As proof of its originality I refor you to Numisma's "Splintars" published from time to time; Chapman's 'Monthly Phi'atelic Chaff" and other equally original contributions, some very sensible and others with ihat over welcome "rein of hủmor." As to neatness, it can bo truly said that its typographical appcaranse is very creditable, and ino publisber's originality seems to bo sbared by the printer, for the covor designs are different from the ordinary cover designs of magazines end present a most pleasing appearanco. This brings us to the third of theChronicle's gond qualities: enterprise. It has this in quantity elso the paper would not occupy the prond position in the philatelic literary world whish it dres. To make a paper a leader in the short space of t me which Mr. Willians has taken shows that le uns plonty of "go" and where he succeeded in his ambition probably nine out of ero! y ten Nho might have tried to do as the did, whould havo failed.

But through all, there peeps the amateur. It does nat take a connois. scur to see that the paper is managed by one whn has not had a careful training in tho trork. As the publisior grows in the work we can look forward to better things atill.
