PHILATELIC TERMS DEFINED.

By J Sydney Dalton

There are some terms in our catalogue that are like "double Dutch" to the beginner and he often gets disgusted with it, owing to the fact that he can't understand it. At other times he might lose money by selling a stamp which is catalogued—for example, 5c on wove paper, 50c on laid, neither of which he understands and therefore he sells it for 5c, thinking it must be the cheap variety. In order to avoid these mistakes we will endeavor to explain some things from the catalogue which would puzzle the beginner and we may prevent him from getting discouraged. The first thing we will deal with will be paper.

WOVE PAPER is smooth and when held up to the light will not show light and dark parts but will be even in shade.

LAI D PAPER is the contrary to wove paper, and is of a light and dark shade alternately. The shades are in lines and will appear in light and dark lines. The lines will be close together immediately following one another.

RIBBED PAPER consists of rough

lines appearing on both back and front.

WATERMARKS. A watermark is a figure, such as a crown, star, anchor, letters, etc., impressed in the paper the stamp is printed on. It appears of a light shade when held up to the light. If it is difficult to distinguish what it is, or if the stamp is heavily cancelled drop the stamp face downwards in some benzine and the mark will appear of a dark shade. Or again, apply a little benzine to the back of the stamp having the face laid on a piece of black paper.

REPRINTS. Reprints worry the beginner also, he being not able to tell them from the originals. It is impossible to give any advice on these but by consulting the catalogue and some other advanced collector or dealer the beginner will generally be able to tell them.

EMBOSS ED STAMPS are stamps which have the paper pressed into little "square lumps" which can be seen generally on the back.

SILK PAPER very often troubles him also, such as in some of the U. S. Revenues. It consists of small colored fibres pressed into the stamp, so to speak. They can be seen on the back.

PART PERFORATED worry more than the beginner. This is a variety which should not be in the catalogue, and, slowly but surely they are falling from the line of distinction. It will not be long before they will be an unknown thing, and the sooner the better for all parties, for they are unnecessary.

DIES are hard to distinguish sometimes and some are so ridiculous that they—like the part perforated stamps—should not be noticed.

WATCH ENERGY GROW.

EDITORIAL COMMENT.

Now is the time the stamp fever strikes the schools.

What have you done towards organizing a stamp club in your town?

Dealers would do very effective advertising by giving packets of cheap stamps to schoolboys. That would start the stamp fever and as the "disease" is contagious the pennies paid the dealer by the boys will in the aggregate amount to a very considerable sum. Try it.

It wouldn't be a bad idea to "Punch" those space fillers who have been quarrelling over the spelling of that Native Indian State, spelled by different writers Puntch, Poontch, Pountch, etc. So long as the stamps are not punched what does it matter?

The Native Indian States of Dhar,

Nabha, Jhind, and Kishengarh, have new stamps. They seem to have a bad attack of stamp issuing over "Dhar". How would you like to "Nabha" few.

The Canadian Philatelic Magazine has been resurrected and we note therein the old Guatamala cut which was wont to appear in numbers of this paper years ago. The C. P. M. has had a spasmodic existence but we hope that it will settle down now and appear regularly.

The Philatelic Post, monthly, has been changed to "Redfield's Weekly Philatelic Post." We wish it all success.

C. E. Cooley's "Exchange" for September is a very creditable number.

The initial issue of the Canada Stamp Sheet, issued from Quebec, has reached our desk. It is one of the very best "first issues" we have ever seen. Long life to it.

The Twin-City Philatelic Association will re-organize for the season some time this month.

Only a "bright man" could write delightful nonsense like Edgar S. Brightman's storiottes, under the heading, "By the Sad Sea Waves" in the September Adhesive.

All German local posts have been abolished.

It is now possible to send letters of an ounce and under in weight to the Philippines, Porto Rico, Hawaii, Cuba, and Guam for two cents each. This ruling was recently made by the Canadian Postmaster General.

New Zealand has adopted penny postage. The Australian colonies are

the only parts of the British Empire which have not adopted penny postage.

OUR OPINION ON RATES.

There has been some discussion of late as to the right and wrong of a paper demanding cash in advance from advertisers. Some denounce the "cash with copy" rule enforced by Energy, the Philatelic Advocate, the Alleghany Philatelist, and other papers, saying that it protects only the publishers. We have tried both systems and under the old system have had enough experience with dead beat advertisers to last a lifetime. Now we demand cash in advance and thereby protect ourselves and our readers. We can assure our readers that we will never knowingly insert the ad. of a fraudulent dealer. We have on different occasions returned money to persons whom we believed to be doing dishonest advertising. But on the whole we have found the cash in advance principle very effective in warding off unprincipled advertisers. With all precaution however, it is possible for parasites to find their way into philatelic or other newspapers. If any of Energy's advertisers are found doing crooked work we will consider it a favor if notification is given us.

CONTEMPORANEOUS PHILATELIC LITERATURE.

There's a bright philatelic paper being issued monthly from the State of Michigan. It is the Philatelic Chronicle, published by H. E. Williams.

This paper is only a year old but ranks with the leading philatelic monthlies of the day. For originality it is equalled by few; almost every page glistens with things original which gives the Chronicle a distinction from all other stamp magazines. With originality it combines neatness and enterprise and these three excellent qualities have made the paper one of the brightest extant. As proof of its originality I refer you to Numisma's "Splinters" published from time to time; Chapman's "Monthly Philatelic Chaff" and other equally original contributions, some very sensible and others with that ever welcome "vein of humor." As to neatness, it can be truly said that its typographical appearance is very creditable, and the publisher's originality seems to be shared by the printer, for the cover designs are different from the ordinary cover designs of magazines and present a most pleasing appearance. This brings us to the third of the Chronicle's good qualities: enterprise. It has this in quantity else the paper would not occupy the proud position in the philatelic literary world which it does. To make a paper a leader in the short space of time which Mr. Williams has taken shows that he has plenty of "go" and where he succeeded in his ambition probably nine out of every ten who might have tried to do as he did, would have failed.

But through all, there peeps the amateur. It does not take a connoisseur to see that the paper is managed by one who has not had a careful training in the work. As the publisher grows in the work we can look forward to better things still.
