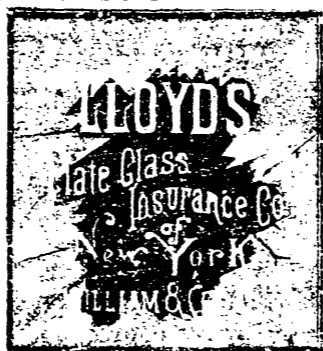

Letters for Registration must be posted 15 minutes previous to the time of closing the mails by which they are despatched

The Mails for Newfoundland will leave Halifax 7th and 21st.

The Mails for Australia, Tasmania, New Zealand and Fiji Islands, will leave San Francisco on the 26th.

The Mails for China and Japan leave Vancouver on the 17th,

The Mails for China and Japan leave San Francisco on the 8th, 19th and 31st.

The Mails for Hawaiian Kingdom will leave San Francisco on the 28th and 29th.

The Mails for Cuba will leave Tampa, Fla., every Mon. and Thurs.

The Mails for the West Indies, Central and South America, will leave New York as follows: Bermuda, 3rd and 17th; the Windward Islands, 2nd, 16th, 23rd and 30th; Venezuela and Curacoa 9th and 22nd; the Bahama Islands, 3rd, and 17th; Central America and the Pacific Ports of South America, 1st, 10th & 21st; Jamaica, 2nd, 4th, 12th, 16th and 29th; Trinidad and Tobago, 11th and 25th; Hayti, 3rd, 12th, 17th, and 31st; Brazil, the Argentine Confederation, Uruguay and Paraguay, 22nd. Letters, &c., should be posted two days before the departure of the above named Mails from New York.

## Registration.

All Classes of matter addressed to places in Canada the United States, Newfoundland, Great Britain or any Postal Union Country may be registered for a fee of 5 cents for each article in addition to the Postage, and letters may be registered to most of the countries not included in the Union.

Every article intended for registration must be handed in at the wicket, and a receipt obtained therefor; on no account must it be dropped into a letter box. The registration fee should be paid by registration stamp.

The sender of a registered article addressed to Canada or to any Postal Union Country may entitle himself to a certificate as to the disposal of said article by the Postmaster at the office addressed, on prepayment of an additional fee of 5 cents.

Registered articles cannot be forwarded unless the postage and registration fee are paid in full.

Registration stamps cannot be accepted in payment of postage.

## Post Bands and Stamped Envelopes.

One cent post bands for newspaper or book packet wrappers, and one and three cent stamped envelopes are issued by the Department, and may be had from the stamp vendors.

## Street Letter Boxes.

Letters are collected from the various Letter Boxes throughout the City three times daily (Sundays excepted) at 9 a.m., 1.30 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. and on Sundays at 8.00 p.m.

## Letter Carriers' Delivery.

There are four deliveries: at 8.30 a.m., 2 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. to all parts of the city, and at 10.30 a.m. to central business portions only. Change of residence should be promptly notified to the Postmaster in writing. The Postmaster is desirous that complaints should be made without delay.

## Matter which cannot be Forwarded by Post.

Any explosive, dangerous or destructive substance, or anything likely to injure the mails or the person of any officer or servant of the Post-Office.

## Post Office Savings Bank.

Deposits from \$1 upwards, on which  $8\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. interest is allowed, will be received for transmission to the Central Office of the Post Office Savings Bank. Pass Books, and every information to be had on application.

## Money Order Office.

In sending money by mail it is always best to transmit by Money Order, if possible. If sent by letter, it should always be registered.


