Atone time these stamps were looked upon with considerable favor but at the present time they are condemned by classes of collectors and are viewed as worthless and but little if any better than counterfeits.

Of course when speaking of the above class of reprints I mean only such as those of Hamburg, Roman States, Haligoland etc. Government reprints such as the re-issue of the 1867 issue U. S. are as collectable in my equipped as any stamps and nearly all collectors would be greatly pleased to get sets of government reprints.

Dealers, in selling replats of Hamberg etc., should sell them entirely alone and exclude them from your stock if you are a dealer and from your collection if you are a collector.
