MARKET AND GENERAL REPORT.

Since our last issue no improvement has taken place in the trade and commerce of the port.

As is usual at this festive season there is more activity amongst retail dealers, but with the wholesale merchants stocks continue large with little or no demand, and those who can hold are determined to do so rather than submit to a sacrifice.

Although we have been and still are passing through a period of unusual commercial depression, yet we believe there is good hope for the future and "a good time coming." The newly discovered gold fields at Big Bend, on the Columbia river, may be said to be an established fact. Should these mines prove to be even within fifty per cent. of what is credibly reported of them in richness, and our government institute promptly an efficient system of steam and postal communication, this will go far to dispel the present commercial gloom and depression, and give a new and more healthy stimulus to our trade and commerce.

With all the present outcry of "bad times," nothing has happened to us but what is common to all new colonies; and experience, that severe but most wholesome instructor, is now applying to the country at large those lessons which will ultimately, and we believe is now, laying the foundation of our future prosperity at no distant date.

Freight on all goods to be paid, or secured to the satisfaction of the Captain or consignee of the vessel prior to the delivery of the goods.

After delivery to the purchaser of goods sold no claims for damage, deficiency or other cause, shall be admissible after goods sold and delivered have once left the city.

When Foreign Bills of Lading expressly stipulate that the freight shall be paid in a specific coin, then the same must be procured if required, or its equivalent given, the rate to be determined by the current value at the time at the Banks.
