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Montreal Stock Market.

SOME PRICES UP TO-DAY—PRETTY LARGE NUMBER OF SHARES SOLD.

Montreal, July 18.

As business has been going of late, this day's market in the Stock Exchange was strong, and mirrored, as it were, the vigor apparent in New York and London. The Royal Electric Annual Meeting this afternoon was the great subject of local interest. The Annual Statement was looked at by some as showing the Company's business to be on lines leading logically to destruction, and by others as proving it to be characterized by the combined daring and wisdom which always succeed. Detailed sales to-day were:

Canadian Pacific shares, to the amount of 470, were sold to day at 97½-97, a slight improvement on yesterday's closing price. London quotations showed a greater advance on this stock's price, and seem to reflect a little upon the want of local appreciation. C.P.R. stock went up to-day in London, while N. Y. Central went down, and ought to have risen further than it did. This security, on sentimental grounds, as well as for more substantial reasons, deserves to be selling at or above par. Sellers wanted 97 at the close, buyers offering 76½.

Montreal Gas—At 201, 75 shares of this high priced security were transferred. This price was the same as Friday's highest. The offer being made was 200½, with 201½ wanted.

Dominion Cotton Bonds—At 1½ advance on last transaction, 500 shares were sold to-day. Since a fortnight ago 110½ has not been reached. Business closed with 110 wanted and 108½ offered.

Twin City—This lowest priced security on the local Exchange pressed forward ¼ point to-day, when 125 shares were traded in at 67½. Better than this will follow, as the Twine break for a dividend in August, and then in January will likely raise its

market price. The sellers' price was 67½, while the buyers' was 67 at the close.

Montreal-London witted to-day, losing three points in two transactions of 2,362 shares at 46. Price wanted at close, 48, the offered price being 44.

Payne at 135 is below last week's highest by five points. The closing price on Thursday last was, however, 135. Since then, this is the first transaction in Payne. As one of the medium class of securities, one would like to hear of its ascension rather than the opposite. Some 750 shares were sold. With 136 asked and 132 offered, business in this terminated.

Halifax Heat & Light appeared to-day for the first time this week. Fifty shares were sold at from 21½ to 20½, a very marked depreciation from 25, the final sale last week. Sellers wanted 25, but no offers were made.

Royal Electric was out again with 120 shares, which sold at from 184½ to 185½, which is an advance on yesterday. The price asked at close was 184½, with 184½ offered.

Can. Col. Cotton Bonds—1000 at 101, which is lower by ½. Wanted, 101, offered 100.

Merchants' Bank—6 at 170; no change in price. 171 asked, 169 offered.

Bank of Commerce—1 at 148; price last week, 149½; 152 wanted, 149½ offered.

Bank of Montreal—34 shares at 257, which is ½ higher than yesterday's price. 256 offered, with no shares for sale.

Though inactive the market showed signs of a demand for shares of the medium class. Virtue and Golden Star were in fair request at better prices than of late. The former selling at 39 and 40 with more bid for broken lots. Mr. Thurston's report on the Cumberland mine is more glowing than that of Mr. Jenkins.

California was on the weak side, but should be bought, for reasons already given in these columns.

Star refuses to make any marked improvement, but the news from the mine is encouraging. With depth the mine has so far improved and there is said to be good reason for expecting it to continue to do so.

Big Three has declined as much as it is likely to do. The sales this morning were at 14½. Any small demand would advance the price a few cents.

The balance of the trading was confined to small lots, but prices on the whole were on an improved basis over those of the last week. It looks as if any improvement in business would lead to an advance. Short-waisted holders are pretty nearly sold out.

NEW YORK EXCHANGE.

SUGAR STRONG, WITH RAILS RISING AGAIN—NEW YORK CENTRAL DOWN IN LONDON—PLENTY OF WESTERN MONEY.

New York, July 18.

Special cables from London state that the market for Americans opened firm with an improving tendency.

The news with regard to the crops and the statements of earnings of the more prominent systems is resulting in an increasing interest for investment account abroad.

The news from the strike is reassuring, and it is practically broken. Nearly the full schedule of cars are said to be running, and the elevated roads are running as usual. There is no fresh news with regard to development of expected labor trouble on the New York City traction lines, nor on the New England railroads, where the men are reported to have grievances which may lead to trouble.

The St. Paul earnings for the 2nd week in July make a very handsome statement, and are by far the largest in the history of the Company, for the same period, for the last seven years. Money yesterday showed an easier tendency, but this was due as much to a lack of demand as anything else.

The news, on the whole, may be regarded as favorable, and we are inclined to advise purchase on declines.

New York, Noon, July 18.

The opening of the market was even more uninteresting and apathetic than yesterday. There was some activity in B.R.T. as a consequence of more encouraging reports in regard to the operation of the different lines. It appears that the number of strikers is dwindling, and that there is consequently less interruption than either on Sunday or Monday.

The Nassau system continues to be the centre of the strike, but it is confidently believed that by the end of the week the whole system will be working as smoothly as a week ago.

The defeat of the unscrupulous stock-jobbers who were mainly responsible for this strike, is the cause of general rejoicing in Wall Street.

The reports that a strike is imminent in M.R. is not believed. There has been some short selling in this stock in the hope that more of the employees were dissatisfied, but there has been no indication of any alarm on the part of the inside interests.

One of the weakest spots on the list is Man. The Street and commission houses are heavily long of this stock. It is being freely offered in the loan crowd at rates somewhat above the current money rate. The principal manipulator in the stock appears to have taken advantage of this to withdraw his support, the result being considerable liquidation on a market not over strong.

The tendency of money seems to be slightly easier than yesterday. The first loans were made at 4 p.c. and subsequently a good many were made at 3½, the borrow-

ing demand at 3½ is fairly large. Great interest has been taken in the Sterling Exchange situation.

There are rather more bills offering than there were yesterday and the tendency is said to be towards lower rates, although so far, no changes have been made in quotations. Foreign houses almost unanimously predict an advance in the bank of England rate on Thursday to 4 p.c. with the result that some shifts of gold will be made.

A rather significant feature in the loan market is that money is being offered by one of the most prominent exporting firms.

The deduction is drawn that they are accumulating money with a view to making shipments on Saturday.

Naturally there was some buying of St. Paul owing to its extraordinary showing for 2nd week in July, all previous records have been broken and advices from the West lead to the belief that this road will continue to break records. The movement of grain last week was exceptionally heavy and in addition to this, prosperity of the people in the West means of course an enormously increased buying power and consequently a large trade in all sorts of merchandize carried by the Western roads.

Crop reports are favorable, more especially from the sections tapped by the Atlantic and the R. I. Good information indicates that the insiders in R. I. are extremely sanguine over the prospects of this road.

From Atlin comes good news of amicable settlement of past troubles. Skagway papers say: "Honest Judge Irving's dealing out of justice in Atlin is giving utmost satisfaction to all law-abiding citizens and putting the fear of God into the hearts of claim jumpers. Americans who staked claims prior to the passing of the alien law are allowed full privileges and title to same."

Vancouver, B.C., July 17.—Van Anda smelter on Texada Island, in which New Yorkers and Toronto people are interested, has started up. There are about 2,000 tons of ore on the dump, and the property is capable of producing enough ore to supply the smelter all the time, even if no custom ore is taken from the surrounding properties.
