THE FIRST ENGLISH COPY OF THE NEW TESTAMENT.

The first complete copy of the New Testament in English was printed at Worms, and not at Antwerp, as stated by Mr. Froude and Mr. Smiles. It appeared in 1525, in octavo, without note or comment, and was executed in the press of Schoffer, son of the associate of Faust and Guttenberg, the inventors of printing. The title page did not give the name of either the translator or printer, and, with the exception of a brief epistle "To the Reder" at the end, the book contained nothing but the sacred text. Three thousand copies of it were printed, and these were immediately followed by an equal number of the quarto edition, with marginal glosses and a preface. They were all sent to the coast and shipped to England; but the news had gone before. The Romish hierarchy condemned the book and all in whose possession it should be found. Not content with this, active emissaries were sent by Cardinal Wolsey to various towns on the coasts of England and Holland to search out and buy up copies. These were collected and burned in the presence of the Cardinal and his clergy, before the gates of St. Paul's Cathedral, on Sunday, February 11th, 1526. So successful was the work of destruction, that, at the present time, of the quarto edition only a fragment is known to exist. It is in the Grenville collection of the British Museum. Of the octavo edition, there are but two copies known, both imperfect—one in the Baptist College, Bristol, complete, with the exception of the title-page; the other in the Library of St. Paul's, London. The former was

re-printed in 1836, with a valuable memoir of Tyndale, by G. Ofor. It is a literal copy of the original, and has *fac-similes* of the wood-cuts and ornaments. The epistle "To the Reader" is appended, and is very interesting. After speaking of the difficulty of the work, and of the rudeness of a first attempt at translation, Tyndale says: "Count it as a thynge not havynge hys full shape, but as it were borne afore hys time, even as a thynge begunne rather than fynneshed."—*Quarterly Review*.

Canadian and Domestic.

THE following articles, and a few editorial notices, which were in print for the last number of the *Recorder*, were unavoidably crowded out. Under such circumstances, our readers will kindly bear with us. We endeavour to make the most of our limited space.

LONDON AUXILIARY.—As we were going to press, we received the subjoined satisfactory statement of another year of successful operation of this Western Auxiliary. The annual meeting was one of deep interest, though the evening on which it was held was one of the most uninviting of the season. Our Canadian people love the precious volume, and in proportion as they personally value it, are they desirous to send it to others.

The annual meeting of this Society was held on the evening of May 8th, 1873, in the North Street Wesleyan Church—the Rev. J. Scott, 1st Vice-President, in the chair. The President, the Bishop of Huron, being called away to attend the funeral of the worthy Bishop McIlvaine, in Cincinnati.

The report being read by the Secretary, Mr. J. Natrass, the meeting was addressed by the Revs. Messrs. Richardson, Keefer, Cooper, Medicraft, Warden, and Tilley, in excellent speeches, and with good effect. On account of the wet evening, the attendance was small; still, a good and hearty interest was manifested, and the new year of effort in the Bible work commences under auspicious circumstances. We subjoin a summary of the Report of the Auxiliary.

From foregoing it will be seen that the Cash Receipts are \$500 in advance of last year, and over \$1000 in advance of the year previous, while the issues of Scripture have been over 1000 more than last year, and more than 1800 copies in advance of the year previous.

The Auxiliary has had to mourn the loss by death of the venerable Archdeacon Brough, one of the Vice-Presidents of the Society, and of Mr. Joseph Oats, one of ten members of the Managing Committee, both zealous, hearty supporters of the Bible work in this Western Ontario.

BIBLE SOCIETY, VICTORIA, VANCOUVER ISLAND, BRITISH COLUMBIA.

In our last number our readers were placed in possession of an interesting report of the first public meeting of the "New Westminster Branch," since its "connection with the Upper Canada Bible Society," we have now the pleasure of communicating additional gratifying intelligence from the Pacific Province. The Victoria Society has held its first anniversary. We feel under an obliga-

tion to the Rev. Mr Pollard for his prompt compliance with our request to confer with friends of the Bible cause in the organization of a Branch Society in the above city. From the accompanying full extract, taken from the report in the *Daily British Colonist*, Victoria, of April the 8th, we learn that the meeting was of a most encouraging character, and that a deep interest is felt in the prosperity of the Society by clergymen and other gentlemen of all denominations. His Excellency the Lieut.-Governor is the President of the Society.

"The public meeting held at the Mechanics' Hall last evening was both large and influential. His Excellency the Lieut.-Governor presided. On the platform were the Very Rev. Dean Cridge, the Rev. Messrs. McGregor, Pollard and Thompson, and Justice Crease. The proceedings were opened with prayer by the Rev. Mr. Thompson. The Chairman addressed the meeting at some length, and much to the purpose, expressing the pleasure he felt in presiding on such an occasion.

"Mr. J. Robson, as Secretary, gave a brief account of the circumstances connected with the movement for the organization of the Society.

"The Rev. Dean Cridge moved the following resolution, in a very interesting speech, in the course of which he referred to the duty of the clergy to unite in the great work of circulating the Scriptures :

"*Resolved*, that this meeting, in view of the scarcity of the Word of God in this country, approves of the steps which have been taken in the establishment of a Bible Society in this city, and hopes that Branches will be founded in other parts of the Province, where not already existing, for the purpose of supplying such want."

"Mr. A. R. Robertson seconded the resolution in a speech, which was much to the point and was well received.

"The following resolution was moved by the Rev. Mr. Pollard in an able and eloquent speech, which elicited much enthusiasm :

"*Resolved*, that this meeting expresses its grateful acknowledgements to Almighty God for the success which from the beginning has attended the operations of the British and Foreign Bible Society and kindred institutions, and pledges itself to increased exertion and liberality in aid of the diffusion of the Holy Scriptures throughout the world."

"Mr. J. F. McCreight seconded the resolution in a few excellent remarks.

"The Rev. Mr. McGregor moved the following resolution, in an exceedingly practical and evangelical speech, which was frequently applauded.

"*Resolved*, that the cordial thanks of this meeting be tendered to the Upper Canada Bible Society for their liberal donation in aid of the formation of this Society."

"Mr. J. E. McMillan seconded the resolution in a few suitable observations.

"His Honour Judge Crease moved the fourth resolution, referring to the influence of the Bible in lessening and lightening the duties of the Judges.

"Mr. J. Finlayson seconded the resolution in a few appropriate remarks.

"The officers and managing committee of the Society for the ensuing year were then appointed. A vote of thanks to the President of the Institute for the use of the Hall, was moved by Mr. B. W. Pearse and seconded by Mr. R. Williams, M.A.

"The Rev. Mr. McGregor moved a vote of thanks to His Excellency the Governor for his conduct in the Chair. The resolution was seconded by Judge Crease, and fittingly acknowledged by His Excellency.

"The very interesting proceedings were brought to a close by singing the Doxology, and the Benediction, pronounced by the Rev. Dean Cridge."

QUARTERLY MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.—*The First Quarterly Meeting* for the present year was held in the usual place on Tuesday evening the 8th inst., beginning at 7.30 o'clock. There was a large attendance and the meeting was one of great interest. The Hon. G. W. Allan, President, was present at the hour for commencing, but was unable to remain owing to the serious illness of a personal friend. The Hon. Senator McMaster, Treasurer, occupied the chair. The Permanent Secretary read the 61st Psalm and led in prayer. Minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed. The Depository's Financial statements for the quarter ending 30th June, were presented and shew the following comparative receipts. For 1871—\$2702.11; 1872—\$1,818.27; 1873—\$2,413.16. The last amount includes \$93.00 interest on "daily balances" in the Bank of Commerce. From these statements it may be noted that the income for 1873 is in advance of that in 1872. but less than the total of the corresponding quarter in 1871. The gratuities for June amounted to \$20.51 and were sanctioned. Messrs. Kerr and Anderson, Accountants, having fully completed their audit of the books of the Society, furnished their *written report*, which the Secretary presented and read to the Board. The Report was quite satisfactory to all concerned. It very becomingly remarks that they "received every attention and assistance required, from Mr. Young, (the Depository) and from Mr. Tyner, (the Book-keeper) and wish to express their thanks to them for their courtesy." The Report concludes as follows: "The Books of the Society are very neatly and regularly kept, and the vouchers and other papers produced were in excellent order." A request from the Rev. S. N. Jackson, M. D., Toronto, Secretary of the Congregational Missionary Society, for a grant of Scriptures for the use of the Indians in the missions of his Church was presented; also one from the Rev. Alex. Stewart, "Baptist Missionary on Grand River" for a grant for the Indians in his Mission, and for needy Sunday Schools of white settlers under his ministerial care. *All were cordially assented to by the Board.*

The Scriptures on Railroad Cars.—The subject of placing—as is done in many instances in the United States—copies of the Word of God in Railroad cars, has on several occasions been brought before the Board, but heretofore nothing definite has been done. We are now indebted to the laudable exertions of Dr. C. B. Hall, Director, for the prospect of an arrangement which will ultimately result in placing portions of the Bible in every Railroad car in Ontario at least. The co-operation of the respective managers is all that

is required, and this, we are confident, will be given. As a commencement 200 copies of the Scriptures have been granted, and Dr. Hall, J. McBean, Esq., and G. M. Evans, Esq., Directors, have been appointed a Committee to take steps to carry out this benevolent and most essential undertaking. *It is quite time that some decisive steps should be taken in this direction.*

THE KETCHUM BEQUEST.—The Joint Committee of the Bible and Tract Societies, appointed some time ago, by the respective Boards of these Societies, to make arrangements for the equitable disbursement of the legacy of the late Jesse Ketchum, Esq., presented their Report. Dr. Green, the Chairman of the Committee, stated, that in the performance of the duties assigned them, they found many difficulties. The Report of the Committee was presented and read by J. K. Macdonald, Esq., the Secretary of the Committee. It was a most exhaustive and invaluable document, and was deservedly commended by the Board. Mr. Ketchum contemplated three objects in his will. *First.* "Gifts to the scholars attending the Day Schools of Toronto." This Trust has been carried out by the Venerable Bishop Richardson, who will continue the undertaking. *Second.* "Gifts to the scholars attending the Sunday Schools of the City," and the following is the *tabulated statement* which the Report exhibits :*

The amount to the Sabbath Schools is to be appropriated, "as far as circumstances will admit, as prizes or rewards."

A *third* object is the bestowal of "gift books amongst the scholars attending the Yorkville Public School."

A very gratifying incident of this meeting was the presence of two deeply interested friends of the Bible Society from Winnipeg, the Rev. Geo. Young, Secretary of the Manitoban Branch Society, and Professor Bryce. Mr. Young spoke most encouragingly of the value and efficiency of the exertions of their colporteur—from whom a gratifying report of labours performed would soon reach Toronto. The Committee in Winnipeg had been exceedingly fortunate in procuring the services of one who had proved himself emi-

nently fitted for this important work. He is an elder in the Presbyterian Church, and has been a great blessing to many.

Mr. Young very cordially thanked the Board for the interest they had taken in the New Province, and for their cordial liberality in the inauguration of the Bible work there. Professor Bryce very heartily endorsed the sentiments of Mr. Young, and further added that the Manitoba Society, while grateful as the recipients of the bounty of their generous and reliable friends in Ontario, would soon become by their contributions, sharers in the grand work of the world-wide distribution of God's Holy Word. He thought that were this a public meeting had been held in Winnipeg, the financial results of which would soon be placed in the hands of the Treasurer of the Upper Canada Bible Society. It was regretted that the Rev. Mr. Black, the President of the Manitoba Society, who had been in Toronto, was compelled to leave the city before the date of this Board meeting. The Chairman called on the Rev. Mr. Young to offer prayer, after which the meeting closed at 9.30 p.m.

The monthly meeting for June was held on the 2nd day of the month, in the Board Room, commencing at 7.30 p.m. The President occupied the Chair, and the Secretary conducted the devotional exercises. The gratuities reported for May by the Secretaries, and confirmed by the Board, amounted to \$81.31. It having been intimated that H. Knolleke, Esq., who has been for many years one of the faithful and indefatigable Foreign Secretaries of the Parent Society, and whose courteous correspondence with the officers of the Upper Canada Bible Society for many years, is held in most grateful remembrance, had been compelled by indisposition to retire from the active duties of the Secretariat, the Board expressed its deep regret at the loss of his services, and their sincere sympathy with him in his affliction. The Secretaries were advised to communicate these sentiments to the Secretaries of the British and Foreign Bible Society. The meeting closed with prayer by the Rev. John Gemley.

FEROUS, May 26.—To-day, at 11 o'clock, Mr. A. D. Fordyce, Secretary of the Bible and Tract Societies of this place, was the recipient of a beautiful easy chair, a Davenport, and lamp, accompanied by an address, which was replied to in suitable terms by Mr. Fordyce. The presentation was made in St. Andrew's Church, Revs. Messrs. Mullen, Smellie, Laird, Fessenden, and Barker, and Mr. Geo. Monger, making short addresses. Mr. Fordyce has held the position of Secretary of the Bible Society for some twenty-one years, and of the Tract Society thirteen years.—*Toronto Globe.*

ELORA BIBLE SOCIETY.—On Wednesday evening, April 9th, a special meeting of the Committee of the Elora Branch Bible Society was held, on the call of the Secretary, to consider the disposal of the depository of books held by Mr. J. W. Hele; that gentleman having announced his intention of disposing of his business and removing from Elora. The Committee resolved to place the Depository in the hands of Mr. Perry, druggist. A resolution was unanimously adopted, expressive of the high appreciation by the Committee of Mr. Hele's services, he having held the appointment during the past ten years and performed the duties in a most satisfactory manner. A subsequent resolution was adopted for the presenting Mr. Hele with a Bible, on the fly-leaf of which should be written an expression of the motives which induced the presentation.—*Elora Observer.*
