CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

Lumber of all kinds is being called for to an extent that is regarded by the trade as satisfactory, particularly when consideration is given to the unfavorable weather conditions. There has been a steady movement of stock from the mills by rail, chiefly for local purposes, although some shipments have been made to the Eastern States. It seems, however, that there is still an impression on the part of consumers that prices are too high, and that by waiting they are likely to be able to effici purchases at lower figures. This opinion presents a striking contrast to that held by the lumber trade generally. The position of white pine particularly is in favor of a continuance of present prices, with a pos-sible advance in certain sizes which are none too plentiful. Two inch common lumber is now quoted by some dealers from fifty cents to one dollar higher than a fortnight ago. Ten and twelve inch widths are also scarce and very firm. Hardwoods are moving only in small lots. Birch, elm and maple are very du'l of sale, with a better demand for basswood and oak. These woods are scarce and almost certain to sell at higher prices before mid-summer. There is a scarcity of dry hemlock, for which \$9 is asked at the mill. Lath is strong, with indications of higher values. At the mill \$2.75 is being asked for No. 1 pine, and \$2.25 for No. 1 hemlock and spruce, and \$1.50 for No. 2. Shingles are quiet but steady, \$2.20 for XXX at mill being the average quotation.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

No important change in the spruce market has taken place since last issue. As might be expected at this season of the year, the volume of orders is increasing, which is reflected in firmer prices. Clapboards are quoted at \$30 to \$31 for extra spruce and \$28 to \$20 for clear, on Boston rate of freight. New Brunswick cedar shingles are selling on the basis of \$2.90 to \$3.00 for extras. Laths are in good to \$3.00 for extras. request. Logging operations are now nearing an end, after a satisfactory season. The cut of logs on the St. John river has been about 95,000,000 feet, which is about equal to last year's production, but on the Miramichi the output has been Lumbermen are somewhat apsmaller. prehensive regarding driving operations. There is only about two feet of snow in the woods of the upper St. John and the Miramichi rivers, as compared with an average of five feet in other years. Unless there are unusual heavy rains this spring, it is feared that many logs will be hung

UNITED STATES.

From a wholesale point of view the lum-

ber market of the United States is showing more strength. Some large purchases at upper lake points have been made, and it is estimated that about one-third of the cut of the Duluth Superior mil s has been sold, while there is not more than 25,000,000 feet of dry lumber remaining on the docks at the head of the lakes that is still unsold. No. 3 boards are held at \$12.75 and No. 2 and better log run at about \$17. The Buffalo and Tonawanda markets appear to be somewhat unsettled, cutting of prices having been resorted to by one or two dealers. Without exception, however, all agree that the out-look for the season's trade is quite promising, and that with more favorable weather orders will be placed quite liberally. It is generally admitted that there will be a large volume of building during the year. Statistics of building operations for Feb. ruary in twenty one of the principal cities show an expenditure of \$20,000,000, as compared with less than \$10,000,000 for the corresponding month one year ago. The outlook has already caused an advance in the price of spruce randoms. In Boston 10 and 12 inch dimensions are selling at \$18 to \$19, 9 inch and under at \$17, to and 12 inch random lengths at \$18, and 2x 3 to 2x 7, 10 feet and up, at

\$15.
There has been a slight revival in the consumptive demand for hardwoods, but the volume of trade is still small. Basswood and oak lead, with ash, elm, maple, and birch following in the order named. Figures presented at the meeting of the Wisconsin Hardwood Lumber Association held on the 12th inst. showed that the stock of hardwood jumber at the mills in Wisconsin was about 130,000,000 feet, as against 125,000,000 feet one year ago.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The news from the United Kingdom are not of an encouraging nature. The high price of lumber and other materials is retarding building operations, and un-til the consumption improves the lumber market is not likely to show a materially stronger tone. Importers seem to be afraid to venture upon forward buying until the stocks on hand have become further reduced. On March 1st of this year the stock of deals, boards, battens, etc., in the Surrey Commercial Docks, London, were 37,000 standards, or about 70,000,000 feet, greater than at the corresponding period one year ago. In Liverpool there is an excessive stock of pitch pine, and a supply of birch timber much larger than the requirements demand. The stock is 114,000 cubic feet, as compared with 52,000 feet last year and 43,000 feet in 1809. Birch planks are also plentiful, 178,000 feet, as against 13,000 feet one year ago. Elm and ash timber have improved slightly during the past month. Ash is quoted at 15. 8d to 3. 3d. per cubic foot, and elm at 2s. 9d.

to 3s. 3d.
Sales of spruce deals for summer ship. ment are being made on the basis of 18
15s. per standard c.i.f. for 3×9 second quality. A quantity of Oregon pine plank was recently sold by auction at £9, but it

wasa consignment cargo of inferior quality. Quebec pine at the same sale made fair prices, and spruce showed a little more strength. There appears to be a large demand in London for manufactured stuff, such as doors and mouldings.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

In Michigan \$10 is being paid for elm logs and \$10.50 for basswood.

Mr. Brown, of Barrie, has over 18,000 cubic feet of square timber lying at the Bradford Station for shipment to Liverpool,

Log run pine is a little stronger in the Saginaw Valley, being quoted at \$17 to \$21. Box lumber is held at \$15 and mill culls at \$12 to \$13.

J. P. Newman, of Wiarton, has purchased from the Hepworth Hunting Club the timber on 1,600 acres of hunting reserve at Murray Harbor, Lake Huron.

At Saginaw River points hemlock boards are held at \$10, piece stuff at \$9 and mill culls at \$7 and \$8. In New York City No. 1 hemlock boards are quoted at \$17.

The contract for supplying the city of Toronto with cedar and norway pine scantling has been let to Reid & Company, of the Esplanade, at \$14.97 per thousand.

The Rathbun Company have secured the contract for supplying lumber for the Board of Works, Kingston, the price being \$17.70 for boards and 216 cents for cedar scant-

J. A. Gregory, of St. John, N. B., has

secured a contract to supply 30,000 pieces of birch props, for shipment to Bristol, England, to be used in making brush

It is reported that the Quebec Government has decided to offer for sale on June 4 next 7,000 square miles of timber limits in the Upper Ottawa, St. Maurice, Rimouski, Lake St. John, and other districts.

Messrs. S. P. Musson, Son & Company report the arrival at Barbadoes of the "Herbert Rice," with 16,000 feet white pine and 10,000 feet spruce, which were sold at \$22 and \$19.50 respectively. The market for white pine shippers is in good position, and second quality would also bring fair rates. A small lot of spruce laying shingles has been sold at \$2.05, and hemlock shingles at \$1 50.

CONCERNING MAPLE LUMBER

The largest body of maple to be found in the United States is in the northern part of the lower peninsula of Michigan. This of the lower peninsula of Michigan. This district contains the largest amount of standing timber of good quality, and consequently is the chief source of supply for dealers in and consumers of maple. Canadian lumbermen will therefore be interested in some figures regarding maple presented at a recent meeting of the Michigan Hardwood Lumber Association, which represents about 70 per cent. of the mills manufacturing Michigan maple for the

The president expressed the belief that log run maple ought to be worth \$16 at the mill. The secretary reported the following sales of lumber since the previous meeting: 3,650,000 feet of maple at \$7,12 and \$17; 50,000 feet of long run maple at \$12,000 feet of maple. maple at \$13; 100,000 feet of maple, 1/2 and 2 meh, at \$14.50 delivered at Milwaukee; 100,000 feet of hemlock at \$5.50 for short and \$9 for the 18 and 20-foot, f.o.b. mills; 100,000 feet long run black ash at \$18 at the mill; 3,500,000 feet of hemlock at \$8.50 and \$9.50 f.o.b. mill; 1,500,000 feet of hemlock at \$8 and \$9 f.o.b. mill; inch mill culls at \$5.50, and 2 inch mill culls at \$5. A sale was reported of shipping cull and common maple at \$6 and Sir, respectively, the buyer not wishing firsts and seconds. One of the members stated that he could have sold all of his cut of 1901 of common and firsts and seconds at \$12 and \$17 respectively. Another member stated that he had refused an offer to sell his entire cut of shipping culls, common and firsts and seconds at \$7, \$13 and \$17.

Inquiry was made as to how much of this season's cut had been sold. Several members announced that they had sold over half of their cut. A canvass of conditions revealed the fact that something

like 50 per cent, of the 1901 cut of maple

had been already sold.

As to the quantity of maple that would be reduced this year, it was concluded that there would be a reduction of about 40 per cent, as compared with last year. The output of the association last year was 70,000,000 feet, and the total of the district about 100,000,000 feet. With a reduction of 40 per cent, the total northern Michigan cut this year would be 60,000,ooo feet. Of last year's cut 20,000,000 feet is still on hand, which with 30,000,000 feet of the coming season's cut still unsold, leaves 50,000,000 feet of Michigan maple yet available for purch ise. It developed that at Traverse City maple manufacturers were paying above \$7 per thousand for logs delivered at their mills by farmers, but a member from Boyne City stated that he was paying \$8. The feelstated that he was paying \$8. The feeling of the meeting seemed to be that there would be an advance in the price of maple this spring.

TIMBER BERTH SOLD.

Only one berth was sold as a result of the offer by the Ontario Department of Crown Lands of several limits in Victoria and Haliburton countie, on the Ottawa River, which had been forfeited or abandoned. This was the abandoned berth on the Ottawa River. The highest bidder was the Hawkesbury Lumber Co., of Ottawa, which got it for \$30,195, or \$1,220 per mile. In the cases of the forfeited berths in Digby, Lutterworth and Sherbourne townships, no tender was high enough to be accepted.

The Barbadoes market, according to S. P. Musson, Son & Company, is fairly well supplied with second quality white pine, but there is no shipping quality in dealers' hands. First quality spruce has been sold at \$21.50, and second quality at\$17.50. There have been no late arrivals of shingles, for which the demand is light,
