CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS

At a meeting of the Lumbermen's

ONTARIO.

Association of Ontario, held in Toronto last week, a resolution was adopted by the members present agreeing to curtail their operations in the woods during the coming winter. This action does not imply that the lumber market is weakening, but is simply an indication that the lumbermen recognize the advantages to be derived, in view of the high cost of labor and supplies, in curtailing the output of lumber next season. Such a course is to be commended, and it is hoped that operators will strictly adhere to the resolution. The statement was made by one large operator present that it was his intention to curtail 50 per cent, as compared with last winter, and by another that he would reduce his output 25 per cent. The pine market continues to show strength, the higher grades being particularly strong A ready market can be found for 10 and 12 inch boards, and bill stuff is also a good seller. The average price of mill culls is between \$10 and \$12, depending upon the location of the stock. A quantity of mill culls at John's Island, which would demand a high freight rate, was lately sold for \$9.50. The demand for hardwoods is improving, and it is believed that the large consumers are about to enter the market

to stock up for their fall and winter requirements. Hemlock is in good demand at an average price of \$9.50 to \$10, although it is possible to obtain from \$11 to \$12 for long lengths. Lath are holding up well, the mill price being about \$2.50 for No. 1 and \$2 for No. 2.

OURBKC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The shipments of lumber from Montreal during the past week have been light, and it appears that the shippers on this side are sending forward only as little lumber as possible, Considering the depression in the British market, the price of spruce deals keeps up remarkably well. Some of the large mills on the St. Lawrence are shut down for want of logs, the drives on the St. Maurice river hoving become stranded, with the possibility that they may not be gotten out until next spring. It is reported that the Laurentide Pulp Company at Grand Mere has been closed from this cause. A few weeks ago it was predicted in this column that cedar shingles were about to advance. This prediction has been realized, as some of the large manufacturers are now asking \$3 for extras, on Boston rate of freight Clears are quoted at \$2.70, and second clears at \$2.30.

UNITED STATES.

During the month of July the shipments of lumber by the members of the Mississippi Valley and Wisconsin Lumbermen's Associations Valley were 37 per cent. greater than for the same month in 1900. Crop conditions are more satisfactory than was expected, and as the wheat harvest is . practically over farmers are turning their attention to the buying of lumher for new buildings and improvements. Prices of white and Norway pine remain very firm, with an upward tendency, especially in Norway. At Ashland, Wis , short lengths have sold at \$11 for 2x4 and 2x8, and \$12 for 10 inch stuff. Six inch strips in common grade are selling at \$15.50, and 4 inch at \$14.50. The conditions in the Saginaw Valley are equally satisfactory. Log run is held at \$18 to \$24, box at \$14 to \$16 and mill culls at S12. Several cargoes of piece stuff have been sold to Chicago, at \$14, while common inch brings \$17. Buffalo and Tonawanda dealers are getting in large stocks and are purchasing freely, but the demand is such that they are not able to increase their stocks materially. It is generally believed that while there is not

the great buying that existed in July, there is likely to be a brisk demand throughout the fall. Bill stuff is selling comparatively low and an advance is predicted. The buying of hardwoods has been more noticeable of late. Apparently the large consumers have begun to make purchases in order to replenish their stocks, which are thought to be low. Considerable ash is moving. Satisfactory conditions prevail in the spruce trade, and as the stocks are not heavy, present prices are likely to hold, if they do not advance.

GREAT BRITAIN.

It seems necessary that shippers must make up their minds to carry the balance of their British specifications over till next year, and follow this action by curtailing their production. It is said that there is still half the production of Scandinavia unsold, as well as the entire summer and autumn production from the White Sea. With large stocks unsold and on the docks at London and Liverpool, buyers are of course loath to cuter into new contracts, fearing a further drop in prices. There has been more activity of late in spruce, and the improvement referred to in last issue has been continued. The Timber Trades Journal reports the purchase of a large cargo of Quebec sprace at £6 109, c i l Liverpool Several large cargoes of spruce have lately arrived, but they have been mostly sold in advance. There is no question as to the better qualities of spruce finding a market at a reasonable price, but it is very advisable not to overstock the market with the lower grades The white pine market is a little sluggish; however, stocks are held in strong hands and in all probability present prices will be maintained. Waney board pine is in good demand, and birch logs have been moving more freely, but large receipts have removed the possibility of any improvement in price.

Nearly a million feet of lumber was burned last week in the yard of Hon. J. K. Ward at St. Cunegonde, a sub-urb of Montreal. The loss is placed at \$15,000

Three cargoes of Oregon pine have left Vancouver, B.C., for the United Kingdom since April 1st.

The Saginaw Lumber & Salt Company, of Saginaw, Mich., last week sold 2,700,000 feet of pine lumber to Buffalo parties

R. E. Lallane is loading a barque at Bonaventure, Que., for the English market. This is the first vessel to be loaded at that point.

Gilmour & Company, of Trenton, Ont., are busy on a large order for 5,000 hardwood doors. They report an increase in demand for their patent doors.

It is reported that Adams, Burns & Company, of Bathurst, N.B., have sold thei saw-miling property at Burnsville, including 100 miles of timber limits, to John Robertson, of Bathurst.

C. II. Witthun & Company, of Wiatton, Ont., last week completed the saving of 3,000,000 feet of pine for Munro & Ebert, of Pembroke. The raft of timber was received late last fall, and about 700,000 feet was cut before the mill was closed down

Of the Barbadoes lumber market Messrs. S. P. Musson, Son & Company say: "There have been two arrivals of white pine during the fort-night; the "Evelyn," from Liver-pool, N.S., with 79,000 feet shipping and 97,000 second quality, which was placed at \$24.50 and \$17.50 respectively; and the "Kipling," from Liverpool, N.S., with 23,000 feet shipping and 102,000 second quality white pine, 13,000 feet spruce, and 34,000 feet hemlock. The white pine was sold at \$24 for shipping and \$17.50 for second quality, the spruce at \$17.50. The dealers are now fairly well supplied, and lower prices may be expected. Dimension codar shingles would be saleable at late quotations, but Gaspe shingles would not bring more than \$3 to \$3.25.

LONDON TIMBER IMPORTS.

Messrs. Churchill & Sim, in their last report regarding the imports in to London, say

Of pine deals from the St. Lawrence the import has been 1,005,000 pieces, against 408,000 pieces in 1900; and of against 408,000 pieces in 1900; and of spruce deals 1,443,000 pieces, against 1,159,000 pieces in 1900. From New Bruhswick the import of pine deals has been 176,000 pieces, while last year there were no imported. Spruce deals have been imported to the extended of the continuous and high planks tent of 244,000 pieces, and birch planks to 108,000 pieces, against 404,000 and 51,000 pieces respectively last year

The stock of pine deals has accumulated somewhat, and while prices of the lower qualities are still high, those obtainable for first quality have greativ loctuated The fact is that a great many shipments have found their way to this country which have not been too carefully culled for quality and much trouble has resulted with buyers in consequence. What is called the new culling of pine deals may eventually be understood by buyers, but meanwhile those shippers who have kept to the recognized standards of quality will have less competition to face than formerly.

Spruce deals have been in good demand, and the importation has been a light one. Hardwoods generally have heen slow of sale.

ANNUAL LOG SALB.

The annual sale of mixed and unmarked logs rafted by the Fredericton Boom Company was held at Frederic. ton, N.B., last week. There was a large attendance of lumbermen.

The Boom Company has rafted about 81,500,000 superficial feet of lumber this season, of which 827,680 feet, about I per cent., were not marked or the marks were not recognizable. This is the usual percentage.

The logs sold were made up of 33,-640 feet of hemlock, 22.820 feet of pine, 102,750 feet of cedar, and 758,

471 feet of spruce, of which 69,922 feet was condemned, 310,948 feet was battens and 377,610 feet was merchantable.

Spruce, J. E. Moore, at \$11.90 a thousand.

The price paid by Mr. Moore is the highest known to have been paid for spruce logs. Towage to St. John will cost 60 cents a thousand, so that Mr. Moore's logs will stand him \$12.50 a thousand feet at his mill, for merchantable. He gets the battens at two-thirds the price paid for the merchatable, and the condemned for nothing except the cost of towing. Spruce deals are selling at about \$10 a thousand feet.
