The lumber yard of Arthur Paquet, corner Notre Dame and Harbor streets, Montreal, was partially destroyed by fire last week. The loss is estimated at \$7,000.

CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The demand for lumber has shown a slight falling off during the past week. Considerable building is in progress throughout the province, but as most of the required lumber has been purchased, the demand is largely dependent upon the requirements for consumption during the late fall and winter. There seems to be a disposition on the part of consumers to defer purchasing in the hope that prices may decline. There are some who think that with the cessation of building operations will come a reduction in the price of lumber, but general conditions seem to be against such a result. The white pine mills in the Ottawa valley and Georgian Bay district are carrying com paratively light stocks, while the scarcity and high cost of labor and the possibility of interruption from small-pox is likely to reduce the log production of the coming winter very considerably. When these facts are given consideration, there does not seem to be much ground on which to base a prediction of lower prices. Of course, the market will be governed by the law of supply and demand, but there is no reason to expect any marked falling off in the consumption of lumber. At the present time pine prices are going through a process of adjustment, after which they will settle down to a winter basis. The grades above common are being marked up about \$1 per thousand, while a slight reduction is being made in the price of some of the lower grades. For 1x12 mill culls from \$11 to \$12 at the mills is being asked. No. 1 pine lath range from \$2.25 to \$2.50, and No. 1 hemlock lath from \$1:50 to \$2. For best quality pine shingles from \$2.25 to \$2.40 at the mill is asked.

Hardwoods are moving more freely, and apparently consumers are replenishing their supply for the winter. Prices are steady. Inch mill run elm and maple are held by manufacturers at \$13, birch at \$16 and oak at \$20.

MANITOBA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.

Wet weather and recent labor troubles in Winnipeg have caused a failing off in the demand for lumber throughout the Northwest Territories. Wholesale dealers and manufacturers report less activity, and while prices are unchanged, it is possible to purchase lumber on terms more Javorable to the buyer. Almost any length of time can be had on a good order. Finishing material is being called

for quite largely, on account of the number of buildings in Winnipeg nearing completion. British Columbia spruce flooring has been advanced to \$31 and \$27 for No. 1 and No. 2 respectively. In hardwood lumber the only change is an advance of \$1.50 per thousand in the price of maple flooring.

UNITED STATES.

The demand for white pine lumber has shown no abatement, although the lumber market as a whole is a trifle unsettled on account of the uncertain conditions governing vellow pine. That lumber has shown evidences of weakness east of the Mississippi river, where the expected demand has not developed, and it is feared that dealers in this lumber may endeavor to get it into the white pine territor; and that a policy of price-cutting may follow. The conditions in the Lake Superior district are most favorable to white pine. The shipments from Minneapolis during the month of September were 2,000,000 feet greater than during the same month in 1900, while those from Ashiand, Wis., show an increase of 16,000,000 feet. At Duluth it is estimated that there is not over 10,000,000 feet of No. 3 and better lumber unsold on the docks. Prices there are unchanged excepting that No. 4 and No. 5 boards have stiffened up. Piece stuff and No. 1 and 2 boards are in the greatest demand in Chicago. The east is buying very liberally, and there is a dearth of boats to carry lumber from Buffalo and Tonawanda to the eastern market. Dealers at Tonawanda report that orders are being received in com paratively large numbers, and that stocks are still broken, despite the efforts of dealers to get consignments from the west as quickly as possible. Hemlock is showing more strength and one or two Buffalo dealers are making an effort to advance the price owing to the heavy orders. Spruce lumber is firm with light offerings. In Boston 10 and 12-inch dimension is selling at \$20, in New York at \$18 to \$21, and in Bangor the market is strong on the basis of \$15 for randoms. There continues to be a good demand for lath and shingles. Lain is scarce and is worth from 32.25 to \$2.75 at Duluth. No. 1 18-inch white pine shingles bring \$4.25 at Buffalo.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The future course of the timber market of Great Britain is still uncertain, although the prospects are brighter than they have been during the past six months. A disturbing factor is the

possibility of a scarcity of money and the neivousness which is shown at some of the leading financial centres of Europe. In England the consumption of wood continues large, and as the import of the past month has been light, stocks are becoming reduced. There promises to be a very light import during the fall month. Last year at this time there were 101 cargoes affoat for London, but this year the number 15 only 28. Importers are watching with much interest the action of manufacturers and shippers, as it is admitted that a cuitailment of production is necessary in order that prices may move up to a proper basis. The Scandinazian shippers have taken a firm stand and universally agreed to reduce the log production of the coming winter by at least 28 per cent. If this agreement is adhered to it should go a long ways, towards restoring confidence. There has been a further improvement in the price of spruce deals. A large cargo from St. John, N. B., has been sold at £6 123 6d per standard c.i. f. Sharpness, and other contracts at corresponding figures are said to be pending. There is a shortage of the best deals in 9 and 11 inch, and at recent auction sales these sizes have brought high prices. Pine deals have also shown a tendency to advance owing to the strong position taken by shippers.

NEW BRUNSWICK CEDAR SHINGLES.

Owing to the long continued drouth in castern Quebec and New Brunswick, and resultant closing of a large number of mills from inability to get their logs, shingles are scarce and daily growing scarcer. So far as we can learn there are very light stocks on hand, and the going mills are all loaded with orders. It is absolutely a seller's market, and those manufacturers who are lucky enough to have unsold any shingles in two best grades, and more especially in Extras, can get almost any price in reason. The manufacturers are now asking an almost uniform price of \$3.00 for Extras. However, for well and favorably known brands and for immediate shipment sales are being made at 10 and 15 cents above this price. The prospects are for an exceedingly stiff market the balance of the season for both Extras and Clears. While low grades are not comparatively as strong, there is no large amount on hand, and the movement is quite steady.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The steamer Puelva is loading deals at St. John, N. B., for the United Kingdom.

The steamer Salfordia is loading lumber at the Hastings mill, Vancouver, B.C., for a foreign port.

It is reported that I. A. Ellis, of Fencion Falls, Ont., has sold his drive of logs to S. Parkin, of Lindsny.

J. J. Thompson and John Leggat, both of Humilton, have formed a partnership for the purpose of working a large timber limit near Huntsville this winter.

During September two cargoes of lumber were shipped from Ashland, Wis., to Canada, one boat taking 75,502 feet and the other 153,000 feet.

Of the hemlock situation a New York dealer says: "The Pennsylvania mills are sold ahead fully 25,000,000 feet, of which 5,000,000 feet are boards, which are scarce and high. As for our own particular firm, we have sold fully four times as much hemlock this month as we did all September last year."

At an auction sale in London last week Miramichi spruce deals, $2\frac{1}{2} \times 7$ 1st, 2nd and 3rd sold at £6 15s. to £7 5s., per standard; Quebec 2nd white, 2 x 7-11 spruce, £7 15s.; 1st white spruce, 3 x 9 to 3 x 11. £11 15 s.; 1st Quebec bright white pine, 3 x 11 and 3 x 12 to 21 in., £19 5s.; Miramichi 4th bright white dry pine, 3 x 11, £9 158., and other sizes in proportion.

ST. JOHN RIVER LOG PRODUCTION.

Men are now well at work in the woods in New Brunswick, and in a few weeks the operators expect to have reasonably large forces at their command. There is much difficulty in getting the required number of men, although wase are higher. The average rate of wages last year was \$21 to \$22 per month. This year the average is \$25 to \$26. Supplies too are costing more this year than last. Pork, for instance, which cost \$18 a barrel duty paid, last year, is bringing \$24 a barrel this year. Beans cost \$1.60 per bushel last fall, this year the price is \$2.25. Oats brought 35 a bushel last year; this year 40 cents, and hay is more expensive because it is scarcer than last year. The cut on the St. John river last fall and winter was from 140,000, 000 to 145,000,000 feet. It is estimated that this winter the cut will be about 125,000,-000, and for the following parties:

Western pine is in fair demand at full to 2 in., \$63 and \$64; 3 and 4 in., \$68 and \$62; 134 to 2 in., \$63 and \$64; 3 and 4 in., \$68 and \$72; selects, 1 to 4 in., \$52 and \$64; fine common. 1 to 3 in., \$42 and \$60; sheathings, \$38 and \$54; barn boards, \$25 and \$62; coffin boards, \$22 and \$24. \$30 ; coffin boards, \$23 and\$25.

Hardwood lumber is in quiet demand at unchanged prices: One inch, whitewood, \$38 and \$40; thicker, \$39 and \$42; \(\frac{1}{2} \) mch, \$30 and \$34; saps, inch, \$25 and \$30; common, \$23 and \$25; quartered oak, \$65 and \$70; fancy, \$80 and \$90; plain oak, \$35 and \$45; ash, \$38 and \$45; cherry, \$90 and \$130; maple, \$30 and
