CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS

ONTARIO.

It would be hard to conceive of more satisfactory conditions than those which prevail in the white pine trade of Ontario. Manufacturers who have any stock of the upper grades are in a position to fix their own prices, knowing that if these prices are not accepted by the buyer, the probablity is that higher prices will be realized before spring. Numerous inquiries are being received from the Eastern States for small lots of stock, apparently for evening-up pur poses, while there is a disposition on the part of dealers to contract for the coming season's cut that is not often exhibited at this season of the year. Building operations in the leading cities of the province are likely to be of a satisfactory volume, and better prices for building lumber are expected. It is a question, however, whether it would be in the interest of the lumber trade that there should be a marked advance in the price of lumber, as it might restrict the volume of builling. A satisfactory car trade in hardwoods is reported, with prices stiffening in a moderate degree. The returns from the production of hardwood lumber last year were not very satisfactory. This has caused some manufacturers to turn their attention to pine and hemlock, and the production of hardwoods during the coming sawing season promises to be very light.

There are practically no shingles on the market, and if the demand was more active, a sharp advance in prices would be experienced. Lath is more plentiful than shingles, although by ro means in large supply. Prices remain steady.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

It is learned that the total stock of spruce deals wintering at the port of Quebec is slightly below 7,000,000 feet. At the close of 190 the wintering stock was 25,000,000 feet. These figures confirm the prediction that was made by some shippers early in the fall that the wintering stock would be exceptionally small. The condition of the spruce market is, on the whole, very satis factory, and it is the opinion of the trade that the spring will witness considerable activity and a strong deniand. Inquiries are being received by manufacturers almost daily for spruce clapboards, the supply in the Eastern States having become short. On Boston rate of freight they are selling at \$35 to \$36 for extra spruce, and \$33 to \$34 for clear. Shingles remain firm on the basis of the previous quotation of \$3.25 to \$3.35 for extras.

UNITED STATES.

An indication of the trend of white pine prices is found in the heavy buying for future delivery that has taken place in the Lake Superior district. The conditions so strongly favor higher prices that dealers and consumers are satisfied that they will make no serious mistake by buying at the present mail et price. A sale was made at Duluth last week of 4,000,000 feet of No. 3 and better at \$18, or about \$2.50 per thousand more than the same company realized for its lumber one year ago. There is a decided shortage in dry lumber, and those who have stock on hand have no difficulty in disposing of it at their own figures. In Buffalo and Tonawanda a large business is doing. Uppers have advanced during the past two months fully \$3 per ibousand. selects \$4, and fine common and No. 1 cuts \$2. There has been no advance in barn boards and box lumber, although these have shown more strength of late and may follow in the path of the higher grades as soon as the spring demand develops. As far as can be estimated the volume of building this year will be heavy, as the architects universally are busy. Logging conditions in the white pine district have been favorable, although a greater supply of snow would facilitate hauling.

A steady improvement in both demand and inquiry for hardwood lumber is reported. The cautious buying policy that has been pursued by factories has brought their stocks down to a point where they must be replenished. Maple is likely to improve, since Michigan manufacturers have taken united action towards obtaining a more remunerative price. Black ash is in good demand and some elm and basswood is moving, though prices of the latter show no improvement.

GREAT BRITAIN.

British importers are pursuing a cautious policy, and while there has been increased activity since the first of the year, the feeling seems to be strongly in favor of a very gradual recovery rather than a sharp advance in prices. At the recent auction sales Canadian pine and spruce showed a distinct improvement. Second quality Quebec spruce brought 19 5s for 3x9 inch and third quality L9 55. Third quality battens also sold well at £7 15s for 3x8 and £7 10s for 3x7. For best quality pine deals as high as \$28 per standard has been realized by private sale, the supply being comparatively light. Prices of second and third qualities are less firm and the stock heavier. Red pine deals have recovered to some extent. During the summer months 9 inch sold as low as £8 55 per standard, whereas the current quotation is about fro. In timber, waney pine is in light supply and selling at advanced prices, while elm and ash are held in large quantities and are slow of sale.

Theannual timber circular of Churchill & Sim turnishes interesting statistics of the import of timber into the United angdom during the past seven years. The quantity of Celonial deals and battens imported last year was the

ssince 1896. The total quantity of timber imported from all countries was 9,193,934 loads, a decrease of 700,000 loads as compared with 1900, and of 250,000 loads as compared with 1889. No complete figures of the stock on hand are obtainable, but the public docks in Loradon show a decrease in deals and battens of 1,600,000 pieces. The figures of London consumption make a very satisfactory showing, being 60,200,000 pieces in 1901, as against 55,000,000 pieces in the previous year.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The schooner Congo is loading lumber at Weymouth, N. S., for Buenos Ayres, George Morrow, of Murillo, Ont., has

just commenced work on a contract to get out 30,000 ties.

Dickey & McGrath, Tucket, N.S. shipped 12,000,000 feet of deals last year, and will operate about as extensively this sezason.

W. H. Crowe, of Welland, Ont., has purchased 250,000 feet of pine and hemlock lumber from John Good willie.

Milne & Plott have sold their timber limits and saw mill at Jack Lake to William Train, of Burk's Falls.

Mr. Collwell is taking out 2,000,000 feet of logs in the vicinity of Jerusalem, N. B., which have been sold to Andre, Cushing & Company, of St. John.

At a meeting of the shingle manufacturers held in Seattre, Wash., on January 15th, prices of red cedar shingles were advanced to \$3 for Clears, \$2.55 for Stars, and \$1.90 for Standards on 50-cent rate.

The government of British Columbia is asking for tenders up to February 1st for a license to cut timber on a timber limit situated north of the Strait of Georgia and west of Howe Sound, and containing 14 squ ire miles.

J Willis & Company, of Sackville, N. L., have been given a contract to supply 65,000 ties for the electric railway to be constructed in Sydney, N.S., by the Cape Breton Eleciric Company. Col. Granger, of Beechmont, N.S., will supply 10,000 ties for the same purpose.

Prices quoted by jobbers at Buffalo continue on a basis of \$7.75 to \$8 for elm flour barrel staves, 51-2 to 5 34 cents for basswood heading, and \$8.50 to \$8.75 for 6. foot coiled hoops. Tight stock is quiet with lierce staves \$30, hoops \$14 and heading to cents.

The following shipments of lumber were made from the port of Pictou, N. S., last year: W. M. Mackay, 423,000 feet; P. A. & J. D. McGregor, 1,259,000 feet; Primrose Bros., 1,179,000 feet; Road & McGregor, 1,059,000 feet; Geo. MacKay, 3,075,000 feet; W. J. Kent, 796,000 feet.

Two lumber-laden vessels which sailed recently from Vancouver, B.C., are reported to have put into Honlulu in distress. The American barque Benjamin Sewell loaded at Moodyville and cleared for Sydney, Australia, on December 29th. The barque Hesper was bound for Fremantle, Western Australia.

A Detroit company who owns St. Ignace and other Islands in Nipegon Straits is about to commence the cutting of the timber. It is estimated that the land contains 500,000 cords of woods, of which 440,000 cords is spruce. The intention is to cut about 10,000 cords this season. The manager of the company is J. S. Bishop, of Detroit, who will make his headquarters in Port Arthur.

The Cleveland Saw Mill & Lumber Company last week sold to Ralph Gray its entire stock of lumber at Cleveland, consisting of white pine; Norway, hemlock, fir and vellow pine, in all about 14,500,000 feet. The company also sold to W. S. Olds, of Cheboygan, Mich., its remaining pine holdings, comprising about 10,000,ooo feet, located on the shore of lake

Michigan. The consideration for the latter was \$40,000.

Joseph Waish, Inte of the Delta Lumber Company, Detroit, is this winter taking out 1,000,000 feet of spruce logs and 1,000.000 feet of pine logs which will be watered in Lake Joseph and go down the watered in Lake Joseph and go down the Moon river to Georgian Bay; also 2,500,000 feet of pine logs which will come out of the Seguin river. The timber being cut on deeded lands, will be exported to the United States. Mr. Walsh is making his headquarters at Parry Sound.

Musson, Son & Company say: The only arrival of white pine and spruce is the "Elma" on December 23rd, with 227 ooo feet spruce and 103,000 feet shippers and second quality pine. We sold the and second quality pine. We sold the former at \$18 round, boards 7 inches and up wide, 10 feet and up long, shippers quality; and the latter at \$20 round, without deductions for shippers, and \$17 for second quality. Other cargoes are on the way and the market is amply supplied. There have been no receipts of cedar shippers. shingles.


