## CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The past week has been characterized by a steady trade in lumber at the lower basis of prices which has been established. That there has been no further cutting o any account is regarded as a recognition of the healthy conditions underlying the market. The stock of white pine held at the mills at the beginning of the summer season was by no means large, and the consumption promises to make heavy inroads upon the season's production. One or two Michigan dealers have recently purchased considerable blocks of white pine in the Georgian Bay district. Building operations are responsible for a large local consumption of lumber. In Toronto, for mestance, the building permits issued during the first half of this year exceeded all previous records, being valued at \$2,629,102 and including 728 dwellings, 25 factories and 23 warehouses. Reener competition is being experienced from yellow pine, but there is now some hope that the Government will protect the Canadian industry by an import duty on United States lumber.

Michigan hardwoods are being shipped into Western Ontario, and with a decreased consumption, the demand for the product of the Canadian mills is slow. Prices, however, are not showing much weakness, and there is a fair demand for soft elm and birch. Hemlock is still held at \$12.50 at the mills.

## QUEREC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The spruce lumber market shows no signs of becoming more active in the near future. Shipments from St. John, N.B., HULL, QUE to the United Kingdom are exceptionally light, while there has been a falling off also in the shipmenor of provincial lumber to the Eastern States. The prices offered by dealers reflect the easier tone which characterizes the United States market. Spruce clapboards continue to show some strength, prices for Biston delivery being \$41 to \$42 for Fatras and \$38 to \$40 for Clears. Spruce lath are offered freely at \$3 to \$3.10 for 13, inch and \$4.15 to \$3.25. for 134 inch. Very few codar slungles of Extra grade are selling above \$3.25 on Boston rate of freight while there are large offerings of the lower grades at recessions from the prices ruling a fortnight ago. The tendency does not seem to be upward.

## UNITED STATES.

An analysis of the lumber situation in the United States leads to the conclusion that there has been a slight improvement. The shipments from the head of the lakes during the month of fune were 62,000,000 feet, of which 57,000,000 feet were from Duluth. Several transactions are reported for stock for future delivery and there is an increase in the number of enquiries Business in the Eastern States 13 quiet, but dealers are doing a fair trade. The recent decline in prices has not stimulated buying to any extent, but orders for small lots are more numerous, which is another indication that dealers are not overloaded with stock. The call is chiefly for common and low grade pine, the better grades being hard to move. In Chicago concessions on prices have been mostly on dimension, shop lumber and better stock. No. 3 and No. 4 boards have not yielded in price, the demand being sufficient to absorb all offerings. Random spruce has declined 75 cents a thousand during the just two weeks and occasionally a sale has been made at \$1 less than the spring prices. There is a lessened inquiry for hardwoods which is not easily explained, but it is probable that the vacation season is having its effect and that consumers are still pursuing a policy of curtailment Even birch is not as active owing to a falling off in the furniture demand, bu prices are held fairly firm. Thick maple is the strongest of the northern hardwoods with the demand comparatively brisk.

Change reports a good demand for white pine fath. Price, range from \$3.10 to \$3.25, with \$2.25 for No. 2. Mixed lath are held at \$2.90 for No. 1 and \$2 for No. 2, and Norway at \$2.00 for No. 1 and \$1.85 for No 2

## LINEAL BRITAIN.

The approvement in the British market mentioned last week has become a little more pronounced, with huyers showing a greater disposition to meet the demands of shippers. The latter, on the other hand, seem unwilling to give further concessions and it is probable that prices have touched bottom for the near future at least. The recovery is likely to be slow, but it would be greatly stimulated by an increase in building operations. The receipts of Canadian lumber at the leading ports this year show a decline as compared with the previous two years, but the stock on hand in most lives is still large. Prices for the better grades of pine deals and boards are firm, but the lower qualities are still offered at prices which must leave no markin of profit for the importer. Spruce is not offerw in large quantity and there is not like ty to be much pressure on the market during the summer months, as shippers will hold their stock in the hope that later developments will be of a favorable character. Birch planks are in good demand and prices are a little better.

## STOCKS AND PRICES.

Jobbers at Buffalo quote elm flour barrel staves at \$11.50 to \$12 for first-class and \$8 to \$8, so for second; basswood heading, 8 to 81/2 cents for first-class and 6 cents for second; coiled hoops, \$9.50 to \$10 for 6 foot and \$9 to \$9.50 for 5½-foot.

Inder date of July 2nd, Messrs, S. P. Ausson, Son A. Company submit the following report of the Barbadoes market: The arrive's during the fortnight consist of the schooner. Pacific with 15 M. of the schooner "Pacific" with 15 M. white pine, 15 M. spruce, and 70 M. hom lock, which being all seconds brought \$19. \$10 and \$14 respectively, and the schoole "Harry Troop" with 58 M. spruce and 20 M. white pine, which brought \$19.60 and \$18.50 respectively. Our market is now fairly supplied with all descriptions, and as demand after the crop is very small, ook for better prices in the During the period until rewe cannot look for better near future. view, besides the "Bravo" which we advised in our last, the bulk of whose Long Cedar shingles realized in the neighbourhood of \$5.55 and \$6.50 for extra quality, with \$4.15, \$5.80, \$7.25, \$7.80 for 4, 5, 6, 7 inch Dimension respectively, the "Nimrod" has arrived with 680 M. Cedar Laying and 97 M. Long Cedar, which we placed at \$2 o8 for former and \$5.82 for latter. The "Dawn," with 200 M., and the "Utility" with 905 M. Laying to neighbours, have since arrived and prices obtained are about the same as advised above. The "Harry Truop" also had 1,500 M. Cedar Laying which had been previously contracted for by dealers at \$2.25, being guaranteed as better quality than the general run, and a cargo of had than the general run, and a cargo of his M. offered to arrive is supposed to have been fixed at \$2.09, or thereabouts. The market therefore is well supplied especially with Cedar Laying, and we must look for lower prices for future arrivals.

## THE GLASGOW MAGKET.

Messrs. Edmiston & Mitchel's' Monthly Timber Circular contains the following information in respect to the Glasgow lummarket:

White Ping. -The important month has been 1,000 loads waney pine. WHITE PINE. - The import during the The stock now consists of "bout 7,000 floads wancy and square, and in view of the reduced consumption and none to rose outlook, seems more than ample for all pros-

pective requirements.

RED PINE.—Stock is very low but quite ample, there being now hardly any enquiry for this class of timber.

CAK. - There has been no ignort, and 3,700 loads in Quebec and Southern States wood. Enquiries during the month bave been of a trivial nature, and prices are

El.M.—The stock amounts to 1,663 loads, and shows a satisfactory reduction on the two pravious years. This almost wholly consists of second-class and soft elm, there eing practically no first-class rock of good size at present in stock. First-class rock is being enquired for, and fresh shipments should meet with a ready market.

QUEBEC BIRCH.—The import during June amounts to about 60 loads, consisting of large wood, which was disposed of from the ship's side at, it is understood, 2s. 1d. for 18-inch average. The stock on hand is triffing, and a few ship neats should meet with a ready enough sale, though at the ame time there is nothing like an active demand existing.

LOWER PORT BIRCH -The total im-

port so far this year only amounts to 230 loads, and seems to have been ample for the trade's requirements, as there is still ome 86 loads of Pictou wood in the pub lic yards. Values are round about 16%d. for 15-inch average.

QUEBEC ASH.—The import this year has

been on a very meager scale, but not withstanding this there has been little or no enquiry, which indicates that this once popular wood has good pretty much out or use. In States ash mout 1850 logs have been imported during the six mouths, a considerable proportion of which is still lying in story unsold. There are only

## BRITISH COLUMBIA LETTER.

Correspondence of the CAHABA LUMBERNAH )

Vancouven, Jely 4th, tena.—There is a little improvement in trade with the Northwest Territories this month, though nothing to have any perticular effect on the depressed conditions. The Victoria Lumber and Manufacturing Company is one of the companies doing a good business in that market and is shipping upwards of 100,000 feet per day. It is aggravating to humber manufacturers to 'nink what trade might be done if Canada were preserved for the Canadans instead of allowing Americans to use our markets for their own convenience.

One article in which Vancouver manufacturers should do a brisk business with settlers in the Territories is that of knockdown houses. Mr. E. Mahoney, manager of the Royal City Mills, one of the large local establishments of the 3. C. Mills, Timber and Trading Company, patented a model knock-down house a short time ago, and Mr. H. A. Bell, of this city, has gone to Winnipag where he will attend the Dominion exhibition and set forth the advantages of a structure of tais kind. The model is ingenious, and when set up can hardly be told from the ordinary house of carpenter build. It is a fine thing for settlers just starting up in a new

country where material and builders are

Railway building in the North-west, where many hundreds of miles will be laid this vect, and also in the southern part of this province, is bringing good business to East Kootenay, as many ties are needed. Many comps have been started up this year in addition to lose suich have been operating. W. H. Griffith, of Cranbrook, is putting in a plant at Fort Steele Johetton: R. O. Johnings and G. Lawrie, both of Fort Stele, have each contracts for 50,000: the East Kootenay Lumber Company, which last year supplied the C.P.R. with 1,000,000, has over 150 men are working near Kimberley at the same occupation.

The loggers have not yet presented their petition to the government praying for the abrogation of the order-in-council prohibiting export of logs, but the r does not seem to be much chance of their wish being acceded to. Some of the millmen would like to see the embargo lifted for a short period anyway to allow the surplustical to be disposed of, but governments are very conservative and slow to adapt themselves to circumstances, until, perhaps, damaging effects bring the matter prominently to their attention.

The only encouraging feature in the

whole situation is the large number of applications for licenses to cut timber on government lands, there being lifteen in last week's Gizette. John Murray, Provincial Government Limber Inspector, has returned from a trip to the interior. He was collecting dies from mills in view of the closing of the fiscal year on lane 30th, and reports that returns were prompt and better than be expected.


