### CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The lumber situation in Ontario calls for no lengthy review, as in few respects does it differ from last week. Business is of an average volume. In Toronto trade is keeping up remarkably well and all the dealers are busy, but some dissatisfaction is expressed with the country demand. The approach of the time for cold weather is operating to curtail the consumption of lumber in the country, and, remembering the cold winter experienced a year ago, dealers are taking every precaution against having to carry a burdensome stock through the winter. Ottawa prices have been shaded in a few instances, but the strong undertone has not been impaired. The stocks at the mills are larger than might be desired, but there are no evidences of more than ordinary anxiety to realize.

Lath prices at the mills are now firmly established at \$2.60 for No. 1 white pine and \$2.50 for No. 2, this being an advance of 10 cents as compared with the prices at which lath could be purchased one month ago. Shingles are unchanged, although a few of the smaller manufacturers are offering B. C. red cedars a little below \$2.60 for XXX. At this price there is no profit, and it is only a matter of time until higher prices will rule.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Lumber market conditions in the Eastern Provinces are gradually getting into better shape. Prices are firmer than they

have been for some time and on all sides there is shown a remarkable degree of confidence and a feeling that the bottom has been reached in spruce values. Local and United States trade is improving and there is more inquiry for British specifications. For the American market all of the larger sizes are in strong demand and many of the mills will go into the winter season with a comparatively small amount of unsold stock. No doubt the intention of the operators to greatly curtail work in the woods this winter has had a strengthening effect upon the market. Following the action of the New Brunswick lumbermen, the Maritime Lumbermen's Association of Nova Scotia, at a meeting held at Truro last week, passed a resolution agreeing to reduce the cut this winter by at least one-half, while some of the members announced their intention to suspend operations entirely until prices improve.

New Brunswick cedar shingles are more active but are still selling on the basis of \$3.75 for Extras and \$2.65 for Clears, Boston delivery. Stocks are not large and some manufacturers are inclined to hold for an advance of 5 to 10 cents.

MANITOBA AND BRITISH COLUMBIA.

The recent fire in Winnipeg has further increased the demand for lumber, which was previously of large proportions in that city. All the dealers are busy and are anticipating a continuation of activity well into the winter months. There has of late been very little change in values, although there is less complaint of price-cutting than was the case a few weeks ago. The situation in British Columbia has not improved to any extent, and most of the interior mills are still carrying heavy stocks. Foreign shipments, however, have been fairly good, as during the first nine months of this year forty seven cargoes were loaded at Vancouver and Chemainus. Exports to Japan have been larger than usual.

UNITED STATES.

The developments of the past week have been favorable to a stable market and to a gradual enhancement of values. From almost every district comes the report of a steady trade at firm prices, while in some instances sharp advances have taken place. White pine lumber is from \$1 to \$2 higher at the mills than during the summer months, and this is expected to lead to some advance at least by retailers, who up to the present time have been slow to profit by the improved conditions. At Buffalo and Tonawanda cuts and better are selling more actively than at any time this season and the lower grades continue to be in urgent request. Yellow

pine lumber is decidedly stronger. At Kansas City a new list took effect on October 14, which made a general advance of about \$1 a thousand over the August list. Uppers were advanced from \$1 to \$2, Nos. 1 and 2 dimensions \$1, and all common lumber 50 cents. Similar action has been taken by the manufacturers in the vicinity of St. Louis. Hardwoods have likewise improved as the result of an increased volume of business. Plain white and red oak is still in very light supply and it is predicted that there will be no surplus of this class of lumber at least before next summer. There is a larger movement of basswood, but so far prices have not improved on account of a comparatively heavy stock. Soft elm is much enquired for.

Practically all varieties of shingles are exhibiting a stronger tone. Red cedars have advanced in the eastern markets from 10 to 15 cents, and white cedars have been benefitted slightly by an increased demand. The firm tone of the lath market has not been broken. There is a scarcity of white pine at Chicago as well as in the Lake Superior district. Eastern dealers have taken advantage of the situation and have advanced prices 10 cents during the past week. Nos. 2 are now selling in the Tonawanda market at \$2.85.

#### GREAT BRITAIN.

It is the general opinion that the next move in the British lumber market will be upward, but whether the improvement that has recently taken place will extend further at the present time is questionable. There is, therefore, a feeling against heavy purchases of lumber lest the expense of carrying the stock should be greater than the recovery in prices. In other words, buyers feel reasonably certain that prices will not be materially higher during the winter months. The past season has been so unsatisfactory that it is likely to influence buyers in their action towards the market next season. The tone at the present time is better than one month ago. A number of transactions in pine are taking place and holders seem satisfied that they will have no difficulty in disposing of their stocks at a profit. Spruce is again reported to be firmer. A sale was recently made at £6 10s c.i.f.

Liverpool for a cargo with about 60 per cent narrows and only a small percentage of 11 inch. From the shippers' stocks 3x9 inch third spruce is selling at £8 5s c.i.f. London, and from the dock stock at £9 per standard.

#### STOCKS AND PRICES.

The Seaman-Kent Company, of Meaford, Ont., are reported to have purchased 2,000,000 feet of maple lumber in Michigan, to be delivered at once.

J. D. McLean, Secretary of the Department of Indian Affairs, is asking for tenders until Friday, November 11th, for 25,000 cedar railway ties and 10,000 cedar posts which the Indians of Manitoulin Island are taking out during the coming winter, to be delivered on the shore of Lake Huron, also for 5,000 cedar ties and 10,000 cedar posts to be made by the Indians of Shesheganing Band.

Messrs. S. P. Musson, Son & Company's market report of October 8th contains the following particulars of B. Bados lumber condition: "We have to report the arrival of the schooner F. B. Wade, with 24,000 feet of merchantable and 67,000 feet of second quality white pine to our neighbors, which they placed to some dealers who were very bare of this at \$26.77 for former and \$21.77 for latter, but we do not think next arrival will do so well. The brigantine Dixon Rice from Weymouth, N.S., arrived on the 6th with 176,000 feet of shipping spruce, 17,000 feet second quality and 14,000 feet hemlock, for which we obtained \$22, \$19 and \$19 respectively. This has supplied present requirements, and with two cargoes which we advised in a previous issue as expected in a few weeks, we expect next arrival will meet with lower values. The steamer Oruro brought 1,608 bundles Laying shingles, principally clears and second clears, which had been previously contracted for. These with recent arrivals by the Success have supplied dealers, and the Bravo about due will bring further supplies of both Long Gaspé and Cedar Laying."

**NEW BRUNSWICK LETTER.**

(Correspondence of the CANADA LUMBERMAN)

ST. JOHN, N. B., Oct. 19th, 1904. The lumber market is slowly but surely recovering from the effects of the depression which existed in so marked a degree earlier in the season. While the results of the improvement have scarcely begun to be felt in the volume of shipments, the prospects are that the estimates of the stocks of manufactured lumber to be wintered at this port will now have to be materially reduced.

An air of optimism is plainly apparent in all those who have lumber of any kind to sell, and that this cheerfulness is justified is indicated by a change in the demeanor of buyers in the United Kingdom and their representatives on this side of the water; enquiries are plentiful and instead of the indifferent attitude of a few months ago, the brokers now show a readiness to do business. This is so especially in regard to the American markets. Contrary to all expectations, the trade in the Eastern States in all lines is very brisk, has improved materially during the last month and is still improving. This being a Presidential election year, a quietness was confidently expected, but this expectation, in spite of all precedents, has proven unfounded.

The probabilities of the market for lath as mentioned in last letter have been fully borne out. Lath are now selling in New York at \$3.50 per M. as against \$3.00 two months ago. This would mean \$2.35 at

St. John for the American product and \$2.10 for the Provincial. The demand during the last month has been exceptionally heavy and the receipts were far short of supplying it.

The market for boards in United States has not shown any improvement, but is at least holding its own, and the demand for spruce scantling is only moderately brisk.

The demand for spruce deals in the Eastern States is decidedly strong and promises to continue so for the balance of the season. Receipts have been light and stock on the other end are reported to be greatly depleted.

Wide deals are particularly good and their scarcity causes an anxiety to obtain them that is having a corresponding effect on prices.

Stocks of American lumber at this port and on the St. John River are comparatively light and will continue so for the next six or seven months at least, as several American manufacturers are making English sizes and have no American logs in stock. Merchantable spruce lumber can be sold in New York at prices that will leave the following figures at St. John:

Boards: American spruce, \$12 per M.; Provincial spruce, \$10.

Scantling: American spruce random, \$11.25 to \$11.75 per M.; Provincial spruce random, \$9.25 to \$9.75.

Deals: 20 per cent 6's, 80 per cent. 8's, \$14.50 to \$17.50 per M.; 25 per cent. 9's, 65 per cent. 10's, 10 per cent. 12's,

\$17 to \$17.50, all tens and twelves, \$18 to \$18.50.

Since last writing freight rates have advanced 25 cents per M. They are now quoted at \$1 on deals to New York and there is a prospect of their being advanced to \$3.25 in the next week or two.

Mr. John E. Moore, lumber manufacturer of this city, was advised on Friday last of the wreck at Gloucester, Mass., of one of his fleet of three-masted schooners, namely, the "Annie M. Allan." She was on her way to New York with a cargo of plaster. The vessel was only partially insured.

**MARITIME LUMBERMEN'S ASSOCIATION**

The Nova Scotia Lumbermen's Association held a special meeting at Truro on October 19th, Mr. Alfred Dickie, of Lower Stewiacke, presiding. It was decided to change the name to the Maritime Lumbermen's Association. Amongst other discussions, the subject of the log output for this year was considered and the following resolution adopted:

"Resolved, that in view of the depressed condition of the foreign market, and in the endeavor so far as we are concerned to permit it to return to a living basis, we hereby, as members of the Maritime Lumbermen's Association, agree to reduce our cutting this winter by at least one-half. Some of us agree to suspend operations entirely until markets recover."

The above motion was presented by

Mr. Dickie and copies of same were ordered to be forwarded to all members. It was decided to take up the matter of railway freights at the annual meeting in December.
