And from thence continued by feveral prorogations, to TUESDAY the SIXTEENTH February 1798; being the THIRD Seffion of the FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY convened in the faid Province.

CAP II.

An ACT in addition to and in amendment of an Act intituled " An Act for " the REGULATION of SEAMEN." Paffed the oth Day of February, 1708.

THEERAS, in and by the third fection of an act made and paffed in the twenty fixth year of HIS MAJESTY'S reign intituled " An Act for the Regulation of Seamen" it is enacted " that if the mafter or commander of any ship or vessel " fhall fhip any Seaman, knowing him to be first entered and " fhipped on board of any other fhip or veffel, or after notice " thereof given him, shall not forthwith difmifs him, every " fuch mafter or commander to offending and being thereof " convicted shall forfeit and pay the fum of ten pounds to the " use of the city or county where such offence shall be commit-" ted, to be fued for in any Court of Record proper to try the fame; " and fuch Seaman fo fhipping himfelf, being under the obli-" gation of a former contract, shall forfeit and pay the value of "" one month's wages that he shall io agree for, to be deducted ..•• from

" from fuch wages as he may have due, or may afterwards be " due unto him, for the use of the party aggrieved." AND WHEREAS the faid third fection has hitherto been found defective and not to answer the purpose intended :---

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council Third (action of and Affembly, That the above recited fection be, and the fame repealed. is hereby repealed; and instead thereof.---

II. Be it enacted, That from and after the paffing of this act, Any perfon hiif any mafter or commander of any thip or veffel, or any o- ring or contealther perfon or perfons, shall hire or engage, harbour, or con- or other perfon ceal any Seaman, Mariner, or other perfon who shall have figned figned any forany former contract or articles, knowing him to have deferted knowing him from any thip or veffel within the province, every fuch mafter, to have deferted commander, or other perfon or perfons fo offending, and being to forfait sweetthereof convicted, shall forfeit and pay the fum of twenty pounds to the use of the city or county where such offence shall be committed to be fued for in any Court of Record proper to try the fame ; and fuch Seaman, Mariner, or other Perfon who fi:all Any Seaman detering during defert at any time during the voyage on which he is engaged by the royage to written contract or articles, thall, over and above all penalties and above the forfeitures to which he is now by law subject forfeit all the wages which he is by he may have agreed for, or be entitled to during the voyage from haw fubjet, all " durent in gas the mafter or owner of the thip or veffel on board of which he maybe initiate a shall with shall have entered after such defertion, to the use of the owner or during that varyage, owners of fuch thip or veffel as he thall have deferted from, to to the ufe of the be fued for and recovered in the manner, before directed.
